





INTELLIGECE

A. ENEMY

1. General During the reporting period contact with the enemy was generally light and limited primarily to snipers and small groups ranging in size from one (1) to ten (10) VC/NVA.

Four instances occurred in which elements of the Battalion and CAG received light to moderate mortar fire, while dispersed in their respective defensive positions during the hours of darkness. Three of the instances included light to moderate fire from RPG rocket launchers.

The most significant contact occurred on 25 August, at approximately 2230H. Elements of Company "K", while setting in night ambush positions were attacked by an estimated platoon size enemy force. The enemy employed 82mm mortors (estimated one (1) tube), RPG rocket launchers, automatic weapons (believed to be light machine guns (possibly RPG's) and AK-47's), and small arms. Enemy force withdrew in an unknown direction under the cover of darkness when friendly reaction forces were sent to assist the unit in contact.

During the reporting period, the Battalion was credited with nirety-seven (97) enemy KIA's. Captured items of equipment and material consisted primarily of six (6) weapons, ammunition, orderate documents, propaganda, food stuffs, clothing, uniform, and a sewing machine.

The Battalian received several intelligence reports indicating platoon to Battalian size units, near or moving through the Battalian TACR. Though reports of enemy missions varied, most were orientated to probable attacks on Danang, Marble Mountain, Air Facility, and friendly positions and interdiction of lines of communication.

Enemy units known to operate within or near the TACR were identified as elements of the 141st NVA Regiment, 31st NVA Regiment, 90th NVA Regiment, and bands of local guarrilles. Units reported, but not confirmed, as workin within or near the TACR included elements of the 60th Battalion, 21st NVA Regiment, Q-83 VC/NVA Battalion, and the 36th NVA Regiment.

2. Items of Significance

On 28 August 1969, at approximately 0730H, a terrorist bombing activity occurred in the market place near the Dai Loc District Headquarters (vic AT 916578). An investigation into the circumstances revealed the following: An unknown woman entered the market place from across the Song Vu Gia River carrying two baskets on the ends of a stick. She placed the carge on the ground and inconspicuously disappeared. Shortly thereafter the mined basket detonated resulting in one (1) civilian killed and eight (8) wounded.

B. WHATHER

The temperature for the month ranged from an average high of ninety-five (95) degrees to an average low of seventy-eight (78) degrees. Precipitation was recorded at less than three (3) inches.

C. TERRAIN

The terrain within the TACR varies from generally flat and interspersed with rice paddies, dikes, and treelines, to gently rolling hills and mountains mountains in the west and northwestern edges of the TACR. Impairment of trafficability (wheeled, tracked, and foot) was negligible except in the areas of flooded rice paddies.





OPERATIONS

A. ORGANIZATION AND DESPOSITION

From 1-18 August, the 3rd Battalion continued it's primary mission of providing defense for the western portion of the 1st Marines TAOR through extensive patrolling activities and cordon and search operations. During this period the 3rd Battalion continued close coordination and cooperation with the ARVN and Regional Forces in the TAOR, conducting joint operations ranging from squadto company in size.


As of 1 August, the disposition of forces under the 3rd Battalion tactical control were as follows:

- 1. Company "I" operated out of the 1st Marines command post (Duong Son 2) and had responsibility for the security of the Ha Dong Bridge.
- 2. Company "K" operated from the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines, CP at Phong Loc (2). Day and night activities included patrolling and ambushes.
- 3. Company "L" had responsibility for the Cau Do Bridge security, patrolling and ambushing activities in that vicinity and in the vicinity of "Christmas Island".
- 4. Company "M" was located on the western portion of Go Noi Island conducting search and clear operations. This area is located south of the Son Tau Bon River and west of the Railroad Berm.

On 4 August, Third Battalion, 1st Marines, (-) cordoned Bo Mong (2) (BT028651). The cordon and following search at first light, resulted in the detention of twenty-seven (27) confirmed VCS. NPFF, S-2, and CIT personnel comprised the searching unit while Third Battalion, 1st Marines held the cordon position.

On 6 August 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines (-) (Rein) conducted a search and clearoperation in Dodge City. With Company "L" on the left flank and Company "T" on the right flank, the Battalion CP in the centerzand Company "K" providing rear security for the Battalion, the Battalion swept north from Highway 4. Boundaries included the French Railroad Berm on the west, the 61 grid line on the north, and the Suoi Co Ca River on the east. This operation terminated on 9 August.





On 10 August, the 3rd Battalion commenced search and clear operations west of the Regimental CP. Boundaries for this operation were south of the Song Cau Do River, west of the 94 grid line, north of the 63 grid line and east of the Regiment Road. Company "I" swept west of the Song Yen River, while Company "K" with Company "L" providing rear security as the Battalion swept south. This operation terminated on 14 August.

On 15 August one (1) platoon from Company "I" operated west of the Song Yen, Company "I" assumed responsibility for the area east of the river and west of the Regimental CP. Company "K" prepared for a land clearing operation in Dodge City. Company "M" continued search and clear operations on Go Noi Island.

On 18 August, Company "K" was moved by truck down Highway 4 to Dodge City and began its assigned mission.


on 18 August, the 1st Marines TAOR was modified and included area extending west and south of the old TAOR. Third Battalion now had responsibility for the defense of the western TAOR. With the Regimental CP located on Hill 55, the Battalion CP was positioned on Hill 37. Company "L" assumed responsibility for the northern portion of the Battalion TAOR. Company "I" was assigned the western/central portion including the Golden Gate Bridge south of Hill 55. Company "K" was moved from Dodge City west to the southern portion of the Battalion TAOR. Company "M" remained on Go Noi Island, continuing their assigned mission in operation "PIPESTONE CANYON".


From 18-31 August, Third Battalion operated in its new TAOR by day and night patrolling and ambushes. One (1) special operation involving elements of Company "K" and Company "I" occurred on 26 August. The 51st ARVN Regiment held an operation in the eastern portion of the 3rd Battalion TAOR. Company "K" and elements of Company "I" were positioned from the Golden Gate Bridge south to Highway #4 as a blocking force for this command operation. On 28 August Company "K" coordinated with Company "D" and Company "C" 1st Battalion, 1st Marines, to effectively conden La Huan and Chau Lau (AT985605 - center of mass). This operation terminated on 29 August and concluded any other significant operations within the Third Battalion's TAOR for the month of August.

B. AIR SUPPORT/DEFENSE

1. Medevacs

During the month of August there were a total of thirty two (32) medevac missions flown for the 3rd Battalion. Included within these missions, thirty four (34) were emergency, twenty three (23) priority, and fourteen (14) routine, for a total of seventy one (71) medevaced personnel. This is a decrease from the eighty seven (87) personnel medevaced in July. The average time for a medevace being completed was approximately 20 minutes.





2. Logistics

Helicopter resupply was necessary for Co. "M" positioned at Go Noi Island throughout the month. There was a Bettqlion sweep in Dodge City and all resupply was initiated and completed from Hill 55.

3. Fixed Wing

During the month of August, there were seven (7) Night Owl Strikes, two (2) Speaky missions, six (6) Basketball missions, and nine (9) flights of air dropping Snake and Napalm. There were five hundred (500) meters of treeline destroyed along with forty-seven (47) bunkers.

4. Reconnaissance Flights

There were fourteen (14) VR flights flown during August.

C. ARTILLERY

Battery "C", 1st Battalion, 1lth Marines provides 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines with artillery forward observer teams and battalion FSCC personnel. During the month of August, direct artillery support was provided by Battery "A", Battery "B", Battery "C", and Whiskey Battery, 1st Battalion, 1lth Marines. General support was provided by Battery "C", 4th Battalion, 1lth Marines and 3rd &" Howitzer Battery, 1st Force Artillery Group.

The Third Battalion, 1st Marines was provided with forward observer teams consisting of an FO, Scout Observer, and Radio operator. These teams held classes on supporting arms for personnel newly arrived in the Republic of Vietnam. Demonstrations in the field were given on call for fire procedure. These procedures proved very successful in demonstrating the availabilty and uses of arbillery support. Squad leaders were supervised in the adjusting procedures for call for fire.

The large increase in artillery rounds expended for the month of August can be attributed to the Battalion's new TACR, its many more target areas and less fire restrictions. In addition to these, information gathered through intellignece reports, activity sighting, infantry unit recommendations and requests have prompted an increase in H&I fires accordingly.







TRAINING

THE BATTALION CONDUCTED THE FOLLOWING TRAINING DURING AUGUST

- 1. A formal Orientation/Indectrination Program was conducted for one hundred sixty nine (169) personnel. Lectures were presented by the Battalion Commander and all staff sections, Air Liason Officer, Medical Section, and Communications Officer. Special emphasis was placed on orders which govern the actions of the individual Marine, the Personal Response Program, the conditions of the area in which the Marines will operate, and the goals, and the missions of the Battalion. One full day of training was devoted to care and cleaning, safety features, familiarization firing, and zeroing of the Marines will firing method was also presented. The companies conducted normal training as operational commitments permitted.
- 2. Familiarination : firing of the M-16 rifle was conducted at the Battalion Rifle Range for one hundred sixty nine (169) personnel of the Battalion.

LOGISTICS

A. ENGINEER ASSISTANCE AND OTHER CONSTRUCTION

The Battalion moved to the Hill 37 Combat Base on 18 August, 1969 and is in the process of submitting engineer work requests to improve living and working conditions. Immediate priority has been given the Battalion Aid Station's Emergency Bunker which at this time is totally unsatisfactory. A TFSC Bunker request for a 201 x 32! x 8! bunker has been submitted to improve this situation. The Battalion shower is operable but the drainage is inadequate and needs repairing.

SE4 Huts and heads have been requested by 1st Marines to improve living areas at this Combat Base. Half of the existing living spaces are strongback tents and should be replaced with SEA Huts. The Battalion continues to improve the Hill 37 Combat Base on a self help program.

B. SUPPLY

1. Classes I, III, and IV supply support have been sufficient during August to meet the Babbalion operational commitments. Class II support continues to be a problem, however, it has improved during this reporting period. DX provides the major portion of deadlined AN/PRC 25's which are a necessity to all combat operations.



COMMUNICATIONS

A. PERSONNEL


As of 31 August, the total strength of the Communications Platoon was one (1) officer and sixty-snine (69) enlisted. A new Comm Chief joined the Battalion on 19 August.

B. EQUIPMENT

Message Center equipment continues to be a problem, primarily due to unstable source power and heat. The generators and wiring mubble to constantly provide the level of power required. Two (2) NSA generator teams have been contacted and conducted extensive repairs and adjustments on the generators themselves. In addition, a Division Survey team has been contacted and will conduct a survey of all exterior wire. New wiring should eliminate the problem of unstable power.

C. OPERATIONS/TRAINING

During August a portion of the Communications Platoon participated in a number of operations. On 6 August, members of the Communications Platoon participated in the move of the Battalion GP from Cau Ha combat base to Buong Sen (2). During this phase the Communications Platoon was supporting four (4) command posts. Upon completion of the move many electrical fixtures and much internal wire had to be reinstalled. On 18 August, the Communications Platoon participated in the move from Duong Son (2) to Hill 37. Since completions of the move 2850 feet of 25 pair cable has been installed throughout the combat base. Normal on the job training continues and the proficiency of the Communications Platoon continues to improve.





MEDICAL/DENTAL AFFAIRS

A. PERSONNEL

I. On 3I August 1969, total strength was two (2) Medical Officers and fifty-two (52) corpsmen. During this period six (6) corpsmen were transferred to other commands: three (3) for duty and three (3) for Duty Under Treatment. There were six (6) WIA:s and one (1) KIA for this period.

B. PATTENT LOAD

- 1 1. For this period four hundred forty-two (442) patients were seen at the Battalion Aid Station Sick Call for an average of fifteen (15) patients per day, a decrease of 49% from last month's total.
- 2. There were six (6) diagnosed with V.D., ten (10) with diarrhea, twenty-six with upper respiratory infection, six (6) with FUO, one hundred eighty (180) with skin disorders. The Battalion had no cases of malaria.

C. MED GAP DENT CAP

- Lo Medical aid was given to one hundred forty-eight (148) Vietnamese civilians by the BAS.
 - 2. No dental patients were treated by the BAS during this period.
- 3, BAS corpsmen held no MED CAP/DENT CAP during the month of August due to the two moves accomplished by the Battalion.

D. SANITATION

- I. Sanitation inspections were held weekly during the month of August. Gradual improvements in the mess hall were noted and drainage problems were corrected. The screening of the billeting spaces have been accomplished and has made a definite improvement. Appropriate rat control measures have shown a decrease in the number of rats observed in the Battalion area.
- 2. On 18 August, the battalion area relocated to Hill 37. Since the relocation, two (2) sanitation inspections have been held. Mimor and major discrepancies have been noted in the mess hall. The mimor errors are those of personal neglect in routine procedures. Major discrepancies have been material ones such as inadequate drainage and water supply. Most mimor discrepancies are improving; however, major ones need engineering assistance which has been requested. Other areas have non-functional or improperly maintained urinals and heads. Soli has provided new urinals for the areas which need them, and measures are being taken to install them. Showers in the area have inadequate drainage due to hard rocky soil. Engineering assistance will be required to delete this problem. A definite rodent problem exists in the area and appropriate measures are being taken by the Medical Department in obtaining poison bait. Screens and doors are needed in living quarters in many areas and personnel concerned have been advised.

OB1950H. While India was enroute to their ambush site, they spotted three (3) VC/NVA, they engaged enemy with small arms. Results were: one (1) VC/NVA KIA, one (1) AK-47 with (2) magazines, one (1) AM/FM radio and assorted gear captured.

020630H. India spotted one (1) VC/NVA hiding in treeline near body of VC/NVA killed the night before. Engaged with small arms killing one (1) VC/NVA. The enemy KIA had one M-26, a cartridge belt, and assorted documents in two (2) wallets.

0221215H. Mike activity found C-4, time fuze pliers, blasting caps in an NVA pack.

021315H. Mike found one (1) PRC/10 radio with hand set while searching tunnel.

020800H. Kilo, while setting into 360° perimeter detonated an SFD on a mound resulting in seven (7) WIA's. SFD believed to be an 82mm mortar round.

031200H. VN boy turned in a boxmine with pressure type firing device. Box was filled with glass, gun powder, and rocks. India activity destroyed Mine with C-4.

Ohlion. 3/1(2) completed a cordon and search of Bo Mong (2) BT028651. Results: Twenty seven (27) confirmed VCS detained and sent to 3rd CIT.

Obleson. Mike swept area of the lest two (2) days H&I fires and found one (1) VC/NVA (KBA) in a grey uniform. Canteen and cartridge belt were found on the body.

Oh1935H. Lima reported three (3) VC/NVA while moving to their ambush site, Engaged with small arms and M-79. Results: one (1) VC/NVA KIA with three (3) chi coms and documents captured.

OSISCOH. Mike found one (1) 105 round, one (1) 155 round, nine (9) M-79 rounds, three (3) M-26 grenades, assorted small arms and twenty (20) pounds of grain.

C61230H. Mike found one (1) 250 pound bomb set vertically in a field. It had a pressure type device, assumed it was an anti tank mine. Bomb was destroyed with C-4.

GELECCH. Lima found three hundred (300) to four hundred (400) rounds of AZ-117 ammunition and one (1) LAAW. Ordnance destroyed with C-4.

061930H. While digging in defense push at night, Kilo found five hundred (500) pounds of rice and one (1) 155 round.





070715H. Kilo activity found five hundred pound bomb with charges still intact.

071250H. India unit found a footbridge crossing stream. Dirt around the bridge had numerous footprints indicating probably enemy activity.

071940H. While on sweep, Mike found ten (10) bunkers, an anti-tank mine containing thirty pounds of C-4, eight (8) naval gun rounds (eight inch) and one hundred (100) pounds of grain.

091015H. Scout Snipers spotted one (1) VC/NVA and fired one (1) round. Activity sent to check area found one (1) VC KIA.

101100H. Mike, while on patrol spotted unknown size enemy unit. Unit called 81 mortar mission and observed eleven (11) VC/NVA KIA's.

111230H Mike found seven (7) bunkers and one (1) W/NVA body.

120800H. Mike found a 45 caliber pistel with two (2) magazines while checking bunkers.

121500H. Lima found a VC mine field while on a sweep. Mine field was marked and measured one hundred(100) meters by five hundred (500) meters approximately.

15 1000H. Mike, while sweeping area, found one (1) two hundred and fifty pound bomb, two (2) 60mm duds, two (2) 105 rounds, three (3) 81 mortar rounds and twelve (12) B-40 rockets.

162030H. Lima while, moving to ambush site, saw three (3) VC/NVA moving north to south. Engaged with small arms fire and called Arty mission. Searched area and found one (1) AK-47, five (5) chicoms, six (6) AK-47 magazines/ammo, two NVA belts and one (1) NVA pouch, two (2) NVA bodies.


170830H. Mike found food, utensils, water cans and footprints of twenty (20) to twenty five (25) persons, indicating area was used recently.

171150H, Kilo activity found document in a bunker concerning the B-50th NVA. Sent document to S-2.

172115H. Setting in company perimeter, Kilo received one (1) RPG. Called Arty mission and gunships. The results were four (4) USMC WIA.

Results: eleven (11) USMC WIA.

193220H. Lima, while on patrol, found sign telling civilians not to walk on trails because of mines, sign written in Vietnamese.

101000H. Lima, while on patrol, had Marine detonate SFD (M-26).. While medevacing casualty another SFD was detonated resulting in eight (8) medevacs total.

1916CCH. Mike swept area of last nights contact and found one (1) AK-117 with magazine, NVA uniform, one (1) chi com grenade, NVA pack, and many drag marks with blood pools.

191720H. Kilo, while moving on patrol route, came upon one WC/NVA. Point engaged with small arms resulting in one (1) VC/NVA KIA, one (1) AK-47, two hundred (200) rounds of AK-47 ammo, and six (6) chi com grenades.

TOTALLY. Scouts, attached to Kilo, spotted one (1) VO/NVA and fired one (1) round. Results: One (1) VO/NVA KIA, NVA belt and canteen.

201850H. Kilo activity searched two (2) bunkers and found two (2) VC/NVA bodies (KBA).

201100H, Kilo activity found (3) RPG rounds, one (1) pineapple grenade and assorted gear.

2.0610H. Mike conducted sweep of suspected enemy staging area and killed one (1) VC/NVA, captured one (1) K-54 pistol with two (2) magazines, one (1) chi com and one (1) M-26 grenade, also one hundred twenty (120) piasters and natebook.

2005000. Kilo Scout Sniper fired one (1) round at one VC/NVA approximately five hundred (500) meters away. Observed individual fall, checked area and found bloody patch, helmet and knife sheath, One VC/NVA KIA.



211200H. While on patrol, Mike Company saw one (1) VC/NVA running into ville, pursued and detained mineteen (19) VCS.

211730H. Kilo activity and sniper team observed five (5) VC/NVA five hundred meters north of this position. Engaged with small arms and observed three (3) enemy KIA through starlight scope. After lapse of ten (10) minutes, observed ten (10) to twelve (12) VC/NVA carrying weapons. Called fire mission and checked area. Found two (2) AK-47 and one holster.

220600H. Mike activity found one (1) VC/NVA body, one (1) AK-47, two (2) magazines, from last nights contact.

220349H. Retrieving damaged tank, and returning to Mike Company CP, mine detonated (anti-tank), resulting in six (6) USMC medevacs.

231815H. Kilo activity spotted eleven (11) VC/NVA north of their ambush site. Called fire mission and engaged with organic weapons. Results: three (3) VC/NVA KIA.

21,0800H. Mike activity found two (2) NVA bodies while on sweep of 60mm H&I area of the night before.

2h0800H. Kilo scout sniper spotted one (1) VC/NVA and fired one round. Results were one (1) VC/NVA KIA, two (2) M-26, one (1) AK-47 magazine.

21305H. India unit left behind for observation saw three (3) WC/NVA, engaged with small arms. Results saw two (2) enemy fall, checked area and found no bodies but large poels of blood.

250800H. Scout snipers spotted and observed four (4) VC/NVA digging in west of their position. Fired one (1) round, checked area and found one (1) VC/NVA KIA.

251115H. India, while on patrol, heard loud explosion. Investigated and found one (1) KIA and seven (7) WIA from an SFD, all were male Vietnamese.

252025H. Search of area of last nights contact by Kilo revealed two (2) VC/NVA KIA.

251115H. Kilo, while setting in ambush site received RPG's and small arms fire from an unknown size enemy force. Returned fire and called fire mission. Results were six (6) USMC WIA.

260315H. Mike CP received six (6) RPG rounds and ten (10) 60mm rounds. Called fire mission and spooky. Negative USMC casualties.

253530H. Mike found two (2) Russian made anti-tank rockets and one crimped cartridge for firing from a grenade launcher. Destroyed with C-4.

281030H. Marine from Lima tripped SFD resulting in four KIA and two (2) WIA. SFD believed to be 105 round three (3) feet high on mound.



287815H. India while on patrol, received small arms fire from treeline resulting in one (1) USMC WIA.

291100H. Mike found one (1) 82mm mortar round while on sweep.

201500H. While on sweep, Mike activity set controlled fire resulting in five secondary explosions.

292230H. Kilo, while setting into ambush site saw two (2) VC/NVA and opened fire resulting in two (2) VC/NVA KIA, NVA belt, two (2) chicom granades, NVA pack, three (3) booby traps.

300815H. Lima activity swept area of last nights arty mission and found one (1) strobe light, one (1) AK-47 magazine/ammo, and documents.

310815H. Kilo activity observed four (h) VC/NVA packing gear, engaged with organic weapons, searched area and found, surgical gear, bandages, one (1) wallet with papers and one (1) bloody shirt.

311205H. Scout snipers tripped SFD and were calling medevac when engaged by four (14) to six (6) enemy. Results: two (2) USMC KIA.

311115H. Mike spotted twenty (20) to thirty (30) VC/NVA moving west to east. Called fire mission. Results were twenty (20) VC/NVA KIA.
