## 1. SITUATION

a. Enemy Forces See current intelligence summaries and estimates.b. Friendly Forces

- (1) III MAF conducts military, psychological and civic action operations in coordination with GVN forces within Military Region I.
- (2) 2nd ROKMC Brigade, in coordination with U.S. and GVN forces, conducts operations within assigned TAOR.
- (3) GVN regular forces and assigned Regional Force and Popular Force units conduct operations in Quang Nam Province.
- (4) 11th Marines ROKMC and GVN artillery unit provide fire support as required.
- (5) First MAW provides helicopter and close air support as required.

## 2. MISSION

2nd Combined Action Group conducts operations in support of GVN Pacification Campaign Plan, destroys VC Infrastructure at the village and hamlet level within assigned TAOCs; provides security and helps maintain law and order; protects friendly political infrastructure, protects bases and lines of communication within TAOCs by conducting day and night patrols and ambushes; participates in civic action programs and conducts psychological operations to maximum extent

g. Coordinating Instructions

- (1) Combined Action Companies will effect the necessary coordination of fire support, reaction forces, patrol activities, ambushes and all other combined operations involving the CAPs in their assigned Districts, with the nearest FWMAF or ARVN Battalion Commander.
- (2) Make timely recommendations for the relocation of Marine CAP elements based on continual evaluation of assigned PF units and degree of pacification attained.
- (3) Submit reports in accordance with Annex E (Reports).
- (4) Conduct Civic Action programs within capabilities stressing "Self Help" by the villagers. Projects should be short term, high impact and low cost and completely coordinated with village and district officials.
- (5) Supporting Arms Coordination in accordance with Annex D (Fire Support)
- (6) 2d CAG carries out assigned missions in areas outlined in Annex C (Operations Overlay)
- (7) All Marines and Navy replacements will attend CAP School at Headquarters 2d CAG.

1. MISSION - Paragraph 2 of the basic order

2. CONCEPT


a. The 2d Combined Action Group with 5 Combined Action Companies and a total of 34 Combined Action Platoons remains as the residual force of the III MAF Combined Action Program. 2d CAG under the command of CG III MAF coordinates the combined action program with Quang Nam Province officials, 1st Marine Division (-) (Rein) and 2d ROKMC Brigade. References (a) and (b) provide Standing Operating Procedures and Joint Policies. Appendix (1) depicts command and coordination channels.

b. CACOs will be located at the headquarters of the district in which its subordinate CAPs are deployed unless tactical considerations dictate otherwise. CACOs, under all circumstances, will coordinate assigned CAP activities with the respective district officials (normally the District S-3). Tactical Areas of Coordination for assigned CAPs are outlined in the Operations Overlay (Annex C).

c. Tasks in support of assigned mission include but are not limited to the following:

- (1) Motivate and instill pride, patriotism and aggressiveness in the PF soldier.
- (2) Conduct combined/coordinated day and night patrols and ambushes in assigned area.
- (3) Conduct training in general military subjects, leadership, and language for all personnel of the CAP to increase the proficiency of PF elements so that Marine elements may ultimately be withdrawn, leaving behind PF elements which can continue to perform in an effective manner.
- (4) Conduct combined/coordinated operations with ARVN and FWMAF units within the CAP Tactical Area of Coordination as approved by the District Chief.
- (5) Insure that intelligence information gathered is made available promptly and on a regular basis to the DIOCC at District level as well as to US and FWMAF units.
