## QUANG TRI PROVINCE

1. 4th CAG had negative contact with the enemy during the reporting period.

## THUA THIEN PROVINCE

2. 291235H: (DELAYED REPORT) A combined operation of CAP 3-3-6 and the 59th Land and Clearing Company discovered 2 bunkers containing 100 lbs of rice, assorted civilian clothing, assorted ordnance and 11 M-16 rifle magazines at YD 934184, 4 km NE of Pm Thu District Headquarters. While searching the bunkers, a member of the engineer company accidentally detonated an M-26 grenade booby trap rigged with a trip wire firing device in a bush at the above coordinate. There were no casualties from the exploding SFD. A search of the area for further SFDs was nonproductive. The bunkers and ordnance were destroyed. The rice and clothing were distributed to local villagers. The M-16 rifle magazines were delivered to District Headquarters. RESULTS: 100 lbs of rice, assorted civilian clothing and 11 M-16 magazines captured; 1 60mm HE round, 1 60mm HE illumination round, 4 M-79 HE rounds, 4 one lb satchel charges and 2 bunkers destroyed.

## QUANG NAM PROVINCE

3. 291006H: (DELAYED REPORT) A CAP 2-9-2 patrol called an 81mm mortar fire mission on 10 VC with weapons moving NE at AT 884493, 1.7 km NE of Duc Duc District Headquarters. The enemy fled in an unknown direction without returning fire. A sweep of the area disclosed 3 bunkers, 300 lbs of rice, miscellaneous documents, 1 poncho and 1 helmet. At this time, the patrol received SAF from an USEF at AT 886489, 1.2 km NE of Duc Duc District Headquarters. The patrol returned organic weapons fire and called an 81mm mortar fire mission on the enemy location causing the enemy to flee SE. One PF was WIA in the contact and medevaced by vehicle. A sweep of the area was nonproductive. The miscellaneous documents were delivered to District Headquarters for analysis along with the poncho and helmet. The bunkers and rice were destroyed. RESULTS: 1 PF WIA(E); miscellaneous documents, 1 poncho and 1 helmet captured; 3 bunkers and 300 lbs of rice destroyed.

4. 292020H: A CAP 2-4-3 patrol initiated organic weapons fire on 2 VC with weapons moving SW at BT 168580, 900m SE of Hieu Nhon District Headquarters. The enemy fled N without returning fire. A sweep of the area was nonproductive. RESULTS: Negative.

5. 292130H: An USEF entered Tu Cau (3) Hamlet at BT 052656, 7.1 km N of Dien Ban District Headquarters and threw 1 M-26 grenade in the Hamlet Chief's house. The Hamlet Chief and 3 other VN civilians received minor

fragmentation wounds from the exploding grenade. The enemy fled in an unknown direction. Hearing the explosion, a CAP 2-7-8 patrol base dispatched a patrol to investigate. The patrol discovered the 4 VN civilian WIA, rendered first aid and released them. A sweep of the area was nonproductive. PsyOps was notified. RESULTS: 4 VN civilians WIA(M).

6. 292345H: An RF member of a CAP 2-7-8 patrol accidentally detonated an M-79 HE round booby trap rigged with a pressure type firing device on a trail at BT 052655, 7 km N of Dien Ban District Headquarters. Two USMC and 2 RF were WIA from the exploding SFD. Minutes later, the patrol initiated organic weapons fire on 6 VC with weapons moving W at the above coordinate. The enemy fled N without returning fire. The USMC and RF WIA were medevaced by helicopter. A sweep of the area and search for further SFDs was nonproductive. RESULTS: 2 USMC WIA(E) and 2 RF WIA(E).

QUANG NGAI PROVINCE

7. 291530H: (DELAYED REPORT) A CAP 1-3-8 patrol initiated organic weapons fire on 2 VC with weapons eating and washing clothes at BS 565919, 3.9 km W of Binh Son District Headquarters. The enemy fled W without returning fire. A sweep of the area disclosed 2 VN males and 2 VN females who apparently were standing watch for the 2 VC and cooking their food, 2 lbs of foodstuff and 1 VN document. Unresponsive to questioning by CAP PF, the 4 VN were delivered to District Headquarters for further interrogation. The document was delivered to District Headquarters for analysis. The foodstuff was given to local villagers. RESULTS: 4 VN civilians detained, 1 VN document and 2 lbs of foodstuff captured.

8. 291530H: (DELAYED REPORT) A local force VC guerrilla, age 60, rallied to a CAP 1-3-9 patrol base at BS 473867, 14.2 km SW of Binh Son District Headquarters. The Hoi Chanh was delivered to District Headquarters for processing. RESULTS: 1 Hoi Chanh.



## QUANG NAM PROVINCE

3. 282130H: A CAP 2-4-3 ambush received 4 RPGs and SAF from an USEF at BT 165583, 1 km NE of Hieu Nhon District Headquarters. The ambush returned organic weapons fire and called a helicopter gunship mission on the enemy location causing the enemy to flee W. Two USMC and 1 PF were WIA in the contact. The USMC and PF WIA were medevaced by helicopter. During the contact, the enemy attempted imitative deception in perfect English on the CACO 2-4 primary frequency. A sweep of the area was nonproductive. RESULTS: 2 USMC WIA(E) and 1 PF WIA(E).

4. 282330H: A CAP 2-9-1 patrol base heard an English Language VC propaganda broadcast emanating from the vicinity of Mau Chanh (2) and Thach Ban Hamlets at AT 896497, 2.6 km NE of Duc Duc District Headquarters. The broadcast appealed to the Marines to go back to the United States and said the VC would pay \$100,000 U.S. currency for a USMC rallier. The VC also stated to the local villagers, they would pay \$50 U.S. currency for each USMC KIA and for each USMC weapon captured. A platoon from RF Company 215 located nearest the broadcast called an 81mm mortar illumination mission in an attempt to locate the VC making the broadcast. A sweep of the area by the CAP and RF unit was nonproductive.

5. 291600H: CAP 2-7-9, with a TAOC geographic center at BT 013648, 8 km NW of Dien Ban District Headquarters, was temporarily withdrawn due to the redeployment of the 3rd Company, 59th RF Bn into the CAP TAOC and reassignment of CAP PF Platoon 53.



1. 280115H: A CAP 4-1-1 ambush initiated organic weapons fire on 3 VC with weapons moving S at YD 311476, 6 km SW of Quang Tri City. The enemy disappeared from sight without returning fire. A sweep of the area disclosed 3 VC KIA, 1 AK-47 rifle and a bag containing numerous VN language VC propaganda leaflets. 1. 110500H: A CAP 4-1-3 ambush initiated organic weapons fire on 4 VC at YD 218635, 4.5 km NW of Dong Ha City. The enemy returned fire with ChiCom grenades, SAF and 1 VC was observed fleeing W. Two PF were WIA in the contact and medevaced by helicopter to 18th Surgical Hospital. A sweep of the area disclosed 3 VC KIA, 2 AK-47 rifles, 1 PPS-1943 Submachinegun, 2 NVA gas masks and miscellaneous medical supplies. The captured items were delivered to District Headquarters. RESULTS: 2 PF WIA(E), 3 VC KIA, 3 ING, 2 NVA gas masks and miscellaneous medical supplies captured.

**THUA THIEN PROVINCE**

2. 102035H: A CAP 3-2-3 ambush initiated organic weapons fire on an estimated 25 VC observed by use of a Starlight Scope moving NW at ZD 178029, 8.2 km NE of Phu Loc District Headquarters. 

1. 100058H: The 4th CAG Compound received 3 122mm HE rocket hits at YD 300542, 3.6 km NW of Quang Tri City. There were no friendly casualties. Property damage was negligible.

2. 100150H: CAGO 3-2, co-located with Phu Loc District Headquarters at ZD 095007, received 30 rounds of mixed 82mm mortar, 122mm rocket rounds and RPGs from an USEP. 





The patrol confirmed the report and discovered 35 VN language VC propaganda leaflets at the above coordinate. The leaflets were delivered to District Headquarters. PsyOps was notified. RESULTS: 4 VN civilians kidnapped; 35 VN language VC propaganda leaflets captured.

**THUA THIEN PROVINCE**

2. 070135H: A CAP 3-5-1 ambush initiated organic weapons fire on 7 NVA with weapons moving E at YD 916108, 2.4 km SE of Phu Bai Combat Base. The enemy fled SW without returning fire. A sweep of the area disclosed 1 NVA KIA, 1 AK-47 rifle, 1 AK-47 magazine, 1 NVA pack, miscellaneous medical supplies, 1 watch, 1 wallet and 1 blood trail. The gas mask and rice were delivered to District Headquarters. RESULTS: 1 NVA gas mask, 600 lbs of rice captured; 1 satchel charge, 110 .45 cal cartridges and 60 AK-47 cartridges destroyed.





The propaganda leaflets were delivered to Mai Linh District Headquarters for analysis along with the other captured items. The bunkers were destroyed. A search of the area disclosed 9 SFDs. Three SFDs were ChiCom grenades and 6 SFDs were 1 lb blocks of TNT. All the SFDs were in heavy brush and each SFD was rigged separately with a trip wire firing device. The SFDs were destroyed in place. A further search of the area for SFDs was nonproductive.
