1. 4th CAG had negative contact with the enemy during the reporting period.

THUA THIEN PROVINCE

2. 291235H: (DELAYED REPORT) A combined operation of CAP 3-3-6 and the 59th Land and Clearing Company discovered 2 bunkers containing 100 lbs of rice, assorted civilian clothing, assorted ordnance and 11 M-16 rifle magazines at YD 934184, 4 km NE of Phm Thu District Headquarters. While searching the bunkers, a member of the engineer company accidentally detonated an M-26 grenade booby trap rigged with a trip wire firing device in a bush at the above coordinate. There were no casualties from the exploding SFD. A search of the area for further SFDs was nonproductive. The bunkers and ordnance were destroyed. The rice and clothing were distributed to local villagers. The M-16 rifle magazines were delivered to District Headquarters. RESULTS: 100 lbs of rice, assorted civilian clothing and 11 M-16 magazines captured; 1 60mm HE round, 1 60mm HE illumination round, 4 M-79 HE rounds, 4 one 1b satchel charges and 2 bunkers destroyed.

The enemy fled in an unknown direction without returning fire. A sweep of the area disclosed 3 bunkers, 300 lbs of rice, miscellaneous documents, 1 poncho and 1 helmet. At this time, the patrol received SAF from an USEF at AT 886489, 1.2 km NE of Duc Duc District Headquarters. The patrol returned organic weapons fire and called an 81mm mortar fire mission on the enemy location causing the enemy to flee SE. One PF was WIA in the contact and medevaced by vehicle. A sweep of the area was nonproductive. The miscellaneous documents were delivered to District Headquarters for analysis along with the poncho and helmet. The bunkers and rice were destroyed. RESULTS: 1 PF WIA(E); miscellaneous documents, 1 poncho and 1 helmet captured; 3 bunkers and 300 lbs of rice destroyed.

6. 292345H: An RF member of a CAP 2-7-8 patrol accidentally detonated an M-79 HE round booby trap rigged with a pressure type firing device on a trail at BT 052655, 7 km N of Dien Ban District Headquarters. Two USMC and 2 RF were WIA from the exploding SFD. Minutes later, the patrol initiated organic weapons fire on 6 VC with weapons moving W at the above coordinate. 

The ambush returned organic weapons fire and called a helicopter gunship mission on the enemy location causing the enemy to flee W. Two USMC and 1 PF were WIA in the contact. The USMC and PF WIA were medevaced by helicopter. During the contact, the enemy attempted imitative deception in perfect English on the CACO 2-4 primary frequency. A sweep of the area was nonproductive. RESULTS: 2 non-CAP RF WIA(E).

RESULTS: 1 VC KIA; 2 VN civilians detained; 1 battery tester and miscellaneous documents captured.

GROUP 4 Downgraded at three year intervals. Declassified after twelve years.

6. OllO45H: Responding to a request for assistance from local villagers, CAP 2-3-2 patrol rendered first aid and medevaced by helicopter 1 VN civilian who received multiple fragmentation wounds when she accidentally detonated a dud M-79 HE round while working in a field at BT 051602, 2.2 km NE of Dien Ban District Headquarters. A search of the area for further dud rounds was nonproductive. RESULTS: 1 VN civilian WIA(E).

7. Oll330H: A 155mm HE round booby trap was command detonated by an USEF in a CAP 2-7-4 patrol base at BT 040627, 5 km NW of Dien Ban District Headquarters. One USN and 1 PF were KIA and 2 USMC were WIA from the exploding SFD. While examining the crater, 1 PF and 1 VN civilian were KIA and 2 USMC and 1 KCS were WIA from the explosion of a command detonated 60mm HE round. The 4 USMC and 1 KCS WIA were medevaced by helicopter. A search of the area for further SFDs was nonproductive. RESULTS: 1 USN KIA, 2 PF KIA, 1 VN civilian KIA, 4 USMC WIA(E), 1 KCS WIA(E).

QUANG TIN PROVINCE

8. 312340H: A CAP 1-2-4 ambush initiated organic weapons fire on an estimated 15 NVA with packs, helmets and fifles, observed by use of a Starlite Scope, moving E at BT 448088, 3.8 km NW of Ly Tin District Headquarters. The enemy fled SE without returning fire. A sweep of the area disclosed 1 NVA KIA and 2 AK-47 magazines were delivered to District Headquarters. RESULTS: 1 NVA KIA; 2 AK-47 magazines captured.



9. 311600H: A CAP 1-4-5 patrol discovered 1 bunker containing 1 NVA flag, 1 first aid kit and 3 logbooks at BS 673795, 4.2 km NE of Son Tinh District Headquarters. While preparing to destroy the bunker, the patrol observed 2 VC, one of which was carrying an AK-47 rifle, run into a second bunker 25m to the W of the first bunker. The patrol fired 1 M-79 CS round into the bunker in an attempt to drive the VC out of the bunker. When the VC failed to come out, the patrol destroyed the bunker killing the 2 VC. A sweep of the area disclosed 1 dud 250 1b bomb. The patrol destroyed the dud bomb. The logbooks were delivered to District Headquarters for analysis along with the NVA flag and first aid kit. The first bunker discovered was also destroyed. RESULTS: 2 VC KIA; 3 logbooks, 1 NVA flag, 1 first aid kit captured; 2 bunkers destroyed.

10. Olloooh: A CAP 1-4-6 patrol initiated organic weapons fire on 4 VC, one of which was carrying a rifle, moving S at BS 731770, 8.7 km E of Son Tinh District Headquarters. The enemy fled SW without returning fire. The patrol called an artillery fire mission on probable enemy escape routes. A sweep of the area was not conducted because of an intervening heavily mined and booby trapped area. The bodies of 2 VC were clearly observed through field glasses lying in the open and obviously dead. RESULTS A CAPACITY AND A CAPACITY A

11. Cl1045H: A CAP 1-4-5 patrol received SAF from an USEF at BS 687801, 5.7 km NE of Son Tinh District Headquarters. The patrol returned organic weapons fire causing the enemy to flee in an unknown direction. One USMC was WIA in the contact and medevaced by helicopter to 91st Evac Hospital. A sweep of the area was nonproductive. RESULTS: 1 USMC WIA(E).
