1. 041530H: (DELAYED REPORT) Acting on information received from the Hai Thuong Village Chief that 1 NVA soldier was at YD 361503, 3.3 km SE of Quang Tri City, a CAP 4-1-2 patrol base dispatched a PF patrol to investigate. The PF patrol captured the NVA at the above coordinate. The NVA had 1 AK-47 rifle, 2 AK-47 magazines, 1 cartridge belt, 1 canteen and a bayonet in his possession. The NVA POW stated he was a member of the K-8 Bn. The NVA POW was delivered to Mai Linh District Headquarters for interrogation along with the captured items. The PF patrol was mutually agreed upon by the District Chief and CACO 4-1 commander in order to evaluate CAP PF proficiency. RESULTS: 1 NVA POW; 1 IWC, 2 AK-47 magazines, 1 cartridge belt, 1 canteen and 1 bayonet captured.
