





#### NARRATIVE SUMMARY

2d CAG ceased combat operations and deactivated during this reporting period. On 1 May, Combined Action Companies 2-7 and 2-4 were deactivated with appropriate ceremonies. The remaining operating unit, Combined Action Company 2-3, had light contact with the enemy. Most contacts were indirect fire incidents occurring in Dien Ban District. On 7 May, CAGO 2-3 ceased operations and was deactivated with appropriate ceremonies. 2d CAG Head-quarters continued to turn in garrison property and organic equipment, prepare final reports and process personnel for redeployment. At 1000 on 11 May 2d CAG was deactivated with appropriate ceremonies attended by Colonel LE TRI TIN, Quang Nam Sector Commander, Colonel G.C. TUCKER, USA, Province Senior Advisor, Lieutenant Colonel T.M. GUNNELS, USAF, OIC of Lopez FAC's, and Father NGUYEN THANH TRI, Catholic priest Cam Ha Village as Honored Guests. The final 100 personnel remaining with 2d CAG relocated to FLG (AT 951805) where final reports were submitted and all remaining equipment turned in to approriate agencies. The final Unit Diary for 2d CAG wee submitted on 17 May 1971.

A sweep of the area disclosed (1) CHICOM grenade. During the contact (1) CAP PF was KIA and (4) CAP PF'S were WIA. RESULTS: (1) PF KIA, (4) PF WIA(E) and (1) CHICOM grenade destroyed.


