INITIAL IMPRESSION REPORT PHIBLEX 6-69, CARBONERAS, SPAIN

1. PHIBLEX 6-69 (23-26 NOV 68) WAS EXECUTED IN THREE PHASES.

A. PHASE ONE - H-HOUR WAS DELAYED FROM 0900A UNTIL 1200A DUE TO UNFAVORABLE SURF CONDITIONS THE MORNING OF 23 NOV 68 (D-DAY).

BLT MARINES WERE LANDED ADMINISTRATIVELY AT 1000A TO ACT AS AGGRESSOR FORCES IN ORDER TO ADD REALISM TO THE EXERCISE. AT 1200A THE BLT COMMENCED AN AMPHIBIOUS RENFJNXEJXKGS/

DGHEGER SAM KACH BLUE. ALTHOUGH SEAS HAD IMPROVED SUFFICIENTLY TO PERMIT LANDING, THEY HANDICAPPED THE TIMELY LANDING OF SOME SERIALS. NO

SERIOUS DIFFICULTIES WERE ENCOUNTERED. COMPANIES 'L' AND 'I' MOVED ON LANDING FORCE OBJECTIVES ALFA AND BRAVO RESPECTIVELY AND SECURED THEM RAPIDLY DESPITE LIGHT TO MODERATE RESISTANCE. WITH FLANKS AND APPROACH ROUTE SECURED BY COMPANIES 'I' AND 'L', COMPANK 'K' MOVED INLAND TOWARDS LANDING FORCE OBJECTIVE CHARLIE REINFORCED BY ARMOR IN DIRECT SUPPORT. COMPANY 'K' ADVANCED AND CONDUCTED NIGHT RECONNAISSANCE OF THE FINAL OBJECTIVE WHILE COMPANIES 'I' AND 'L' SENT OUT PATROLS TO SCREEN THE FLANKS OF THE BLT.

SHORTLY AFTER DAWN, COMPANY 'K' MOVED INTO ASSAULT POSITION AND COMMENCED DESTRUCTION OF OBJECTIVE CHARLIE. ENEMY DEFENDERS, APPROXIMATELY ONE PLATOON (REIN), WERE QUICKLY NEUTRALIZED AND THE ENGINEER DETACHMENT DESTROYED 'STRATEGIC' FACILITIES ON THE OBJECTIVE, THUS COMPLETING MISSION. ASSAULT FORCES PULLED BACK TO BEACH COVERING THEIR WITHDRAWAL WITH PLANNED FIRES (SIMULATED). TACTICAL EXERCISE SECURED AT 241130A NOV 68.

B. PHASE TWO - AN INSPECTION TEAM FROM PREVENTIVE MEDICINE UNIT, NAPLES, CHECKED VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT AS WASHDOWN AND PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE WAS COMPLETED. NEGATIVE INFESTATION WAS REVEALED. REEMBARKATION WAS NOT HAMPERED BY WEATHER AND WAS COMPLETED BY

C. PHASE THREE (SUBSEQUENT TRAINING)- SMALL UNIT TACTICS, SCOUTING AND PATROLLING AND FO PROCEDURES WERE CONDUCTED BY COMPANIES 'K', 'I', AND 'L' ON 25 AND 26 NOV IN SELECTED COMPANY TRAINING AREAS ADJACENT TO THE BEACH. TROOPS WERE TAKEN ASHORE ADMINISTRATIVELY, WITH FIELD RATIONS FOR THE NOON MEAL AND REEMBARKED ADMINISTRATIVELY IN THE EVENING EACH DAY. A SMALL COMMAND GROUP CONTROLLED THE ACTIVITIES OF THE COMPANIES FROM THE BEACH.

2. COMMENTS - CARBONERAS PROVIDED ROUGH HILLY TERRAIN FOR INFANTRY TRAINING BUT PROVED TO BE NOT ENTIRELY SUITABLE FOR TRACKED VEHICLES, OFFERING VERY LIMITED AREAS OF MANEUVER. THE MAPS AVAILABLE, BEING THIRTEEN YEARS OLD, DO NOT SHOW RESULTS OF EXCESSIVE EROSION WHICH ALTERED THE TERRAIN APPRECIABLY. THE BEACH GRADIENT WAS UNEVEN AND DROPPED SHARPLY JUST OFF SHORE AND WAS OF VERY LOOSE GRAVEL WHICH PRESENTED DIFFICULTIES FOR WHEELED VEHICLES. THERE WAS NO OPPORTUNITY FOR CONTACT WITH CIVILIANS DUE TO THE SHORT DURATION OF THE EXERCISE. THERE WERE NO VENDORS PRESENT AT ANY TIME.

3. RECOMMENDATIONS - CARBONERAS, 140-8, 049VIDES AN EXCELLENT TRAINING AREA WHICH SHOULD CONTINUE TO BE SCHEDULED FOR BLT'S AND AMPHIBIOUS EXERCISES.

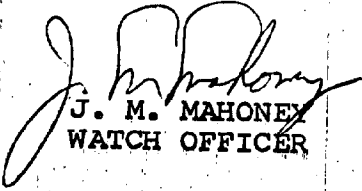
