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PART II NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During this period the Battalion supported 3/1, 1/7, 3/7, 2/27, 3/27, 1stEng, TFX, ROK's, and the 5th Marines. Technique of employment consisted of two (2) platoons to the ROK's, a platoon (*) to 3/7, 3/27, and TFX; a platoon to 1/7; and a section to 3/1, 2/27, 1stEng, 7thEng, and the 5th Marines. Company "B" Command Group (-) continued their role of direct support to the 2nd Republic of Korea Marine Brigade at Hoi An.

The Battalion had an average of 54 vehicles committed daily in general support of the 1st Marine Division. The mission and frequency of specific tasks were:

Resupply - 126
Patrols and Mine Sweeps - 43
Blocking Forces - 10
MedEvacs - 14
Reaction Force - 36
Search and Destroy - 10
Security - 55
Administrative - 15
Recovery - 7
Troop Movements - 7

Vehicle utilization averaged 6.4 hours per day carrying an average of 5 persons and 394 pounds of cargo per day. In addition, LVTE's fixed fourteen (14) line charges during the month.

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PART III SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. TOPICS

- a. Personnel and Administrative
 - (1) The personnel status as of 31 August 1968 was Category I.
- (2) Five (5) Marine Corps Officers, zero (0) Navy Officers, fifty-one (51) Harine Corps enlisted and zero (0) Navy enlisted rotated to CONUS. Five (5) Marine Corps Officers, zero (0) Navy Officers, fifty-six (56) Marine Corps enlisted and one (1) Navy enlisted replacements were received.
- (3) The Battalion had the following casualties: Two (2) KIA and Twenty-six (26) WIA.
- (4) The Battalion had ten (10) extensions of overseas tours, two (2) new enrollments in USAFI Courses, and maintained a Savings Bonds participation average of 81%.
- (5) Four (4) Navy Commendation Medals and twenty-six (26) Furple Hearts were awarded to members of this Battalion.
 - b. Intelligence
- (1) The Battalion S-2 conducted normal administrative and combat intelligence.
- (2) The Battalion had eighteen (18) vehicles damaged or destroyed by mines during the month of August.
- (3) The Battalion had thirty-six (36) contacts with the enemy. These consisted of the following.
 - (a) Bighteen (18) mined vehicles
 - (b) One (1) sniper incident

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- (c) Two (2) booby traps, which consisted of one (1) punji pit and one (1) punji pit with M-26 Fragmentation Grenade rigged with trip wire. Both booby traps were blown in place.
- (d) During the period 23-30Aug the Battalion remained in constant contact with elements of the Q-14, Q-16 Companies and 402nd Sapper Battalion. In a seven (7) day period this Battalion had fifteen (15) scattered contacts resulting in thirty (30) enemy KIA, five (5) POW's, three (3) enemy crew served weapons, five (5) enemy individual weapons, sixteen (16) satchel charges, twelve (12) Shan portar rounds, forty-three (43) S2mm mortar rounds, and assorted scall arms ammunition and clothing.
- (4) The Battalion apprehended eight (8) detainees. Of these all were classified as innocent civilians. Of the eight (8) detainees seven (7) were turned over to the 5th CIT and one (1) was taken to NSA hospital and interrogated by ITT personnel.
- (5) The Battalion conducted 130 squad size patrols within the AOR. Ninety (90) patrols were conducted during the hours of darkness and forty (40) during Caylight hours.
- c. Fraining. Formal training and OJT were conducted in conjunction with oper tion conmittments. Troops attended classes as follows:

- (a) Minor LVT suspension parts, such as track pins, outboard adapter nuts and bolts, and sprocket ring nuts and bolts are critically short. Also, the lack of OVM and 25 lb. grease guns seriously hampers the 1st echelon maintenance program. Windshields, batteries and tire patches are in short supply for wheeled vehicles.
 - (2) Maintenance Situation
- (a) During August the Battalion averaged five (5) LVT's combat deadlined daily. Most were deadlined for second echelon repair due to mine damages.

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(b) Mining incidents were up considerably from the previous month. Eighteen (18) vehicles were damaged by mines or rockets during this month with the following results:


- (c) LVT's awaiting a Code H Letter of Unserviceable Property includes one (1) LVTE. This will leave the Battalion five (5) LVTE's.

f. Civic Action

(1) During this reporting period there has been 578 (151 female, 81 male, and 346 children) recorded treatments at the dispensary and S-5; all of which were beta-hostile action. Five (5) people were treated for shrapped wounds and one boy was wounded when he tripped a VC/NVA booby trap. One girl died of Cholera. At the time of admittance she had an accute case of diarrhoea; but further tests showed it to be Cholera as the cause of death.

(2) There was a very small amount of ordnance turned in this month although we have distributed a larger amount of leaflets. One (1) boy turned in seven (7) rounds and a M-16 magazine, and another boy turned in a canteen. Both requested clothes rather than money and were given some trousers and shirts.

- (3) The Vietnamese Government has prohibited fishing from the villages boarding the South China Sea in our AOR.
- (4) The Orphanage was given \$115.00 from donations by Battalion personnel, and the following:

g. Communications

(1) Personnel. The overall personnel status still remains adequate with the exception of teletype operators. This problem will be eliminated upon the arrival of three (3) men who are due for transfer from the 27th Regiment. During this period a total of 871 messages were received and 156 messages were transmitted. The shortage of Radio Repairmen was eliminated with the arrival of five (5) Technicians during

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this period. One (1) GySgt., 2539, reported 2 Sep to fill the billet of Communications Chief, 2591.

(2) Equipment. A problem exists in the message center in that our only typewriter was coded. This problem has caused delays in typing and routing messages and reports. A replacement is on requisition - priority 2 RedBall. FSR is in the process of modifying six (6) LVTP5Al tractors with the new FM radios. This will complete our modification programs. On 25 August, one (1) signal generator, AN/URM-48 was damaged by incoming artillery which hit the tech shop. This item is being coded out by FSR and reordered. One (1) Oven-ND-43, one (1) tool kit AN/USM-15, and one (1) electrical table were damaged by same. These items are being Combat Loss and reordered.

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
