PART II NARRATIVE SUMWARY

- 1. H&S COMPANY. The Company remained in the Battalion CP (AT 989711) throughout the month. The reaction platoon conducted forty-seven (47) night patrol/ambushes and twenty-one (21) daylight patrols in the 3d AT Battalion TAOR. These patrols apprehended 7 detainees; found 3 cave/tunnel complexes; and captured 1 frag grenade, 1 Chinese claymore mine, 1 Chinese stick mine, 2 U.S. .30 cal carbines, 2 fourteen inch diameter bear traps. One combat casualty was incurred as a result of a gunshot wound inflicted during a firefight with an estimated 3-5 VC; Enemy casualties were undetermined. Perimeter improvements included the construction of tangle foot wire between the inner and outer rows of concertine and the emplacement of an additional 8 claymore mines. A daylight and night alert drill was conducted during the month. During the TET stand down perimeter security was increased from 30% to 50%. (Ref: Enclosure 3, H&S Co Command Chronology)
- 2. COMPANY "A". Company "A" continued to support the 3d Marines on Operation Prairie II throughout the month. On 1 February the third platoon supported 2/3 on a battalion size search and clear operation in the Cua Vally. No contact was made by the platoon, On 6 February the Ontos platoon from BLT 1/9 was joined as the 1st platoon, Company "A" replacing the old 1st platoon which was attached to BLT 1/3 on 31 January. On 20 February a section of Ontos from 1st platoon conducted an Ontos/Infantry patrol in vicinity of (YD 0245). Twelve 106mm rounds were fired at suspected VC positions with undetermined results. On the 21st and 28th of February two Ontos from the 1st platoon escorted a MED CAP team to THON KHE MEO Village (YD 996480). During the month 510 106mm rounds were fired as H&I with unknown results. (Ref: Enclosure 4, Company "A" Command Chronology)
- 3. CC. PANY "B". On 1 February the heavy section from the first platoon in support of M/3/26 observed and fired on 4 VC (YD 487323) utilizing the .30 cal machine gun resulting in 4 VC KIA (prob). On 5 February two Ontos from the 3d platoon supported a M/3/26 search and destroy operation in vicinity (YD 498275). During the night of 5 February the Company CP and 1st platoon CP received 7 8 rounds of 61/82mm mortar fire. A GP tent and M-49 truck were damaged, but no casualties were incurred. On 6 February 2 Ontos from the 1st platoon in support of K/3/26 fired 18 106MM rounds at an unknown number of VC (YD 575245) and YD 5/37243) resulting in 3 VC KIA (prob). On 10 February the heavy section of the 2d platoon with 3 Ontos were displaced from the Phu Bai Vital area (YD 894143) to the Chinook Operating area (YD 531315).

On 12 February the 1st and 2d platoons and Company Command group were proceeding in convoy to a blocking position (YD 585270 - YD 584275) to support a search and destroy operation to be conducted by I and N Companies 3/26. The lead wehicle with the Company Commander, 2d Platoon Commander, 4 Ontos crewman and one infantryman struck a land mine believed to be a 250% bomb detonated by one or more 155mm rounds at (YD 586269). All personnel were KIA and the Vehicle was completely destroyed. The remainder of th month all platooms were utilized as CP security for 3/26 and Companies of 3/26. During the month 10 H&I missions were fired for a total of 192 - 106MM rounds; results of all missions were undetermined. (Ref: Enclosure 5, Company *B** Command Chronology)

4. COMPANY "C". From 1 through 8 February, Ontos C-23 and C-25 from the heavy section of the 2d platoon participated as part of blocking force for Operation Independance at (AT 865573). These two vehicles then reverted to the direct support of H/2/4 (AT 876577) on 9 February. On 14 February the light section (2 vehicles) from the first platoon provided a blocking force (AT 874733) for a platoon sweep by E/2/26 with negative contact. On 18 February G-22 from the light section of the second plateon fired 3 - 106mm rounds at enipers while supporting a sweep by G/2/4 (AT 938543) with undetermined results. On 20 February C-23 from the second plateon fired 5 = 106mm rounds at a boat with 4 VC in it at (AT 865570) resulting in 4 VC KIA (prob) and destroying the boat. On 24 February C-21 and C-24 from the light section, second platoon fired a total of 12 - 106mm rounds at VC sniper positions (AT 946642). Two houses were destroyed, enemy casualties unknown. The third platoon remained in direct support of 1/26 throughout the month. No significant fire missions were achieved. (Ref: Enclosure 6. Company "C" Command Chronology)

1. In accordance with reference (a), the following information is submitted:

a. Reaction Force

During the month of February, the Reaction Platoon conducted forty-seven (47) night patrol/ambushes, and twenty-one (21) day light patrols in the 3dATEn TAOR. These patrols netted seven (7) detainees who were inter-rograted and subsequently escorted to the III MAF PW Compound for classification. The results of the classification are not known. The Reaction Platoon also discovered three (3) cave/tunnel complexes, one of which contained one (1) frag grenade, one (1) Chinese claymore mine, one Chinese stick mine, two (2) 30 cal. carbines and numerous documents which were turned over to ITT, also two (2) fourteen inch diamenter "bear" type spring traps were found "set" along a local trail. The Reaction Force suffered one WIA who was help medivaced to 1stNedBn, with serious abdomen wounds, during the month. The Reaction Force was called upon by Smokeroom to act as a blocking force in a combined unit operation four times during the month.

b. C.P. Security

Construction of "tangle foot" wire between the double rows of perimeter defensive wire, was completed during this month and an additional 8 claymores were positioned in the perimeter defensive positions.

One (1) day licht and one (1) twilight training alert was conducted during this month and the Battalian had one (1) emergency 100% alert during the month. During the TET holidays, the perimeter guards were increased 30% with 50% alert at all times and 100% alert for an hour at twilight and dawn.

Due to the anticipated move of the Battalion in the very near future, further construction projects were halted and only repair type work was conducted.

1. Operations

a. The Company (fwd) continued in D/S of 3/26 on Operation Chinook. An investigation was commenced by 1stLt EGAN. On 7 February, PFC SCHUMANN walked into the Company rear CP. The investigation is proceeding. On 5 February during the enemy mortar attack the Platoon suffered over 200 holes in their CP tent - no casualties. 
