~~CONFIDENTIAL~~**A. INTELLIGENCE**

1. The Intelligence Officer continued to hold nightly briefings for the Battalion Commander, Staff Officers, Company Commanders, and Section Heads. The briefings included reported mine and boobytrap incidents in the 3d Marine Division TAOR, current tactical situation, and VC/NVA order of battle and activities affecting engineer operations.

2. During the month of March, a total of 71 mine/boobytrap incidents were recorded. Of that number 33 were detonated and 38 were found and destroyed. As in past months, the highest concentration of incidents was in the Operation Chinook area, and the common type device has been dud ordnance rigged as AT or AP mines. While this trend has remained consistent, indications are that Russian and Chinese manufactured mines will be employed more.

3. On two occasions Vietnamese turned in live ordnance to Engineer personnel. On 01 March, 24 rounds of clipped .30 caliber ammunition were turned in near CAM LO. A reward of 50 \$VN was issued at that time. On 11 March near CAM LO a live 60mm mortar round was turned in by a Vietnamese youth who was rewarded 200 \$VN. The rewards are administered in accordance with DivO 7230.1.

1. Training during March consisted of GMS training as outlined in Part IV Paragraph D.

2. Classes of the 3d Engineer Battalion Generator Operators School were suspended during March, 1967 due to the relocation of the Battalion at GIA LE.

3. The 3d Marine Division Land Mine Warfare and Demolitions School, conducted by this battalion, continued to instruct both division and non-division personnel in mines, boobytraps, and demolitions. The instruction was conducted by contact teams and by resident courses in the battalion school areas at DONG HA and PHU BAI. The following is a summary of the training conducted by the school during the month of March, 1967.

~~CONFIDENTIAL~~C. OPERATIONS

1. General. During the month of March the 3d Engineer Battalion remained in general support of the 3d Marine Division. Company "C", 3d Engineer Battalion remained under operational control of the 1st Engineer Battalion, 1st Marine Division. Employment of the battalion was in the following two categories: Combat Support and Combat Service Support.

Due to the relocation of elements of the battalion from DONG HA to GIA LE in the latter part of the month, the battalion was forced to curtail its normal activities to expedite embarkation of personnel and organic equipment.

(a) Combat support operations consisted of providing mine detection and demolition teams in support of infantry operations and daily sweeps of MSR's for mines and boobytraps. Companies "A" and "B" supported 9 infantry battalions. The combat support provided involved:

- (1) A total of 149 deliberate mine sweeps of MSR segments.
- (2) A total of 0 visual sweeps
- (3) Daily average distance swept was 6,660 meters.
- (4) Excluding clearance, 2 incidents required engineer effort during sweeps. See Part II, Paragraph A, Intelligence.
- (5) Ordnance and fortifications destroyed by combat engineers during March is documented in Part IV, Paragraph E.

(d) Combat support of infantry operations was provided by personnel from Companies "A" and "B", Support Company, and H&S Company. A task element from 2d Platoon, "B" Company led by Cpl. WITHERUP supported "D" Company, 3/3 and found ninety-six (96) 102mm rockets and eight (8) fuses in the vicinity of Camp Carroll on 20 March 1967. Company "H", 2/26 was supported by an "A" Company team led by L/Cpl SACOVELLO from 7 - 24 March 67. Cpl. WITHERUP and 14 engineers from 2d Platoon, "B" Company gave 3/4 an engineer capability during a search and destroy operation from 7-14 March 67. "L" Company, 3/3 was supported by five engineers led by L/Cpl. IWANTSKI from 15-28 March 67.

Other infantry units in the QUANG TRI TAOR and PHU BAI TAOR were given an engineer capability by the battalion with engineer units at KHE SANH, the Rock Pile, Camp Carroll, the CHINOOK II area, and at PHU BAI.

The most significant undertaking of the battalion during March was the relocation of H&S Company and elements of Support Company from Da Nang to GIA LE and that of moving the battalion CP and major elements of Support Company from DONG HA to GIA LE.

Combat support rendered by the 3d Engineer Battalion during the month of March is documented in Part IV, Paragraph A.

3. Combat Service Support

(a) Roads and Bridges

Work projects in this category were hampered in the early part of the month by rainy weather and in the latter part of the month by embarkation requirements levied on Support Company. As the Heavy Equipment Platoon staged and loaded out from DONG HA to GIA LE the battalion's capability for road and bridge work projects decreased.

During March, however, road repair continued on Route #558 and culverts were installed on Route #561. On Route #9 a number of by-passes were improved in the CAM LO vicinity. The haul road to the CAM LO gravel pit was maintained during the heavy traffic requirements put on it by continuous hauling operations conducted by MCB 5 and the 11th Engineers.

Minor repairs were made during March on Route #1. A portion of decking was replaced on the bridge at (YD 711248) and an abutment at (YD 610313) was repaired.

(b) Field Fortifications. During March the work done on field fortifications consisted of continuous improvement of defensive positions and perimeter wire at the 3d Engineer Battalion CP at DONG HA and extensive wire installation and bunker construction at the new battalion encampment at GIA LE. Bunker construction in the CHINOOK II area continued and at GIO LINE for the 12th Marines and 2d Battalion, 94th Artillery Regiment.

(c) General Construction. The Construction Platoon of Support Company busied itself with a variety of work projects during March. In addition to bunker projects at GIA LE, a shed for a generator and refrigeration unit was built for the battalion. An ammo bunker for "B" Company and a demolitions bunker for LMW School were constructed. Among the most noteworthy projects was the construction of the DONG HA Air Freight Terminal building including counters and benches. A Pot Shack was built for the 4th Marines' messhall, also wind-shield covers and mount-out boxes for 3/4. The DONG HA Base Coordinator was provided a drafting table and speed limit signs were built for 9th Motors. The Division MP's received a much needed confinement compound in HBS. Mount-out boxes were fabricated for the 3d Engineer Battalion Observation Towers for 2/9, spider trap probes for 3/4, and heads for 3d Motors were built, as well as a sentry booth for the main gate of the CHINOOK II area. Work commenced on a helo pad on top of the Rock Pile and the MARS station at DONG HA was completed. Rounding out the month's activities in general construction, a road block was built for 2/9, block and tackle rigging was installed at GIO LINE for the 12th Marines, shelving constructed for the Division G-2 Map Room, and table tops for the 3d Marines were built.

(d) Utilities. The 3d Engineer Battalion Utilities Platoon continued to supply division units with raw and potable water. Three (3) water points were under the operational control of the 1st Marine Division in DA NANG and seven (7) were operational in the PHU BAI and DONG HA TAOR's. Totals for the month at DONG HA and PHU BAI are as follows:

(e) Drafting and Surveying. The Drafting and Surveying section continued to support division units with a survey, layout, and drafting capability. The most notable efforts made by this section during the month were the site plans for the new division CP at PHU BAI and continued survey work projects for the new Battalion area at GIA LE.

D. COMMUNICATIONS

1. Continuous communication was maintained with units located at DANANG, PHU BAI, and DONG HA.
2. L/Cpl DAWLEY passed the Crypto Board Examination and is now a member of the Crypto Board.
3. The reconciliation of the Communication Platoon and Battalion Supply records was completed.
4. Three Radio sets, AN/MRC-83, have become operational through the efforts of the Battalion S-4 and the Division CEO's office.
5. Displaced one switchboard SB-22/PT from DANANG for installation at the new command post site at GIA LE.
6. Displaced one radio operator with radio set AN/PRC-25 to COLCO RAMP in PHU BAI to provide communications for off loading.
7. Displaced two wiremen to commence installing new command post site.
8. Displaced RPS system with two men to the new command post site.
9. The area defense wire system completed at the new command post site and the switchboard installed with two radio relay trunk to division.
10. Closed down DONG HA command post communications on 26 March 1967, and displaced to the new command post site at GIA LE.
11. Commenced installation of the telephone cable for the new command post site.
12. The message guard was established for the 3d Engineer Battalion by the 3d Marine Division at PHU BAI.
13. Liason was established with the 3d Tank Battalion and Division CEO to establish a common message center.
14. A direct cable was established from 3d Marine Division to the GIA LE Combat Base replacing radio relay as a primary means of telephone service.

E. NARRATIVE SUMMARY - LOGISTICS

1. While the Battalion continued its mission of combat and combat service support of the Division, logistic operations were curtailed as preparations were accelerated for displacement of Battalion elements to the new GIA LE cantonment from DONG HA and DANANG. One reinforced engineer platoon was detached to rotational deployment in early March, another joined shortly thereafter, and a third readied for rotation in early April.

2. On 13 March the Battalion (-) was directed to commence immediate displacement. Concurrently plans were put into effect to move from DANANG all elements not disputed by the Commanding General, 1st Marine Division. 21 YFU and LCU amphibious craft were required for the lift from DONG HA. This lift constituted approximately 35% of this organization's supplies and equipment. Another 25% was moved from DANANG, and the remaining 40% was already in place with deployed engineer companies or on deadline in shops of the Force Logistics Command.

3. On 26 March the Battalion Command Post was shifted from DONG HA to GIA LE, located near the PHU BAI combat base. Construction of camp facilities and transfer of cargo inland, started by the Battalion advance party in late February, were continued by H&S and Support Companies. The transfer of cargo proceeded very slowly with only one lowbed and one forklift. One of each were located at DANANG supporting Battalion embarkation there. Such slow progress has reduced the Battalion's ability to quickly resume full operations.

4. Organic supply operations were ceased in DONG HA on 14 March and reopened at GIA LE on 21 March. Supply activities at GIA LE had to be limited to bare office administration, unpacking, and inventory and consolidation of shelf inventories. The last was especially important since this was the first time in six months that the Battalion accounts and stocks have been in one location under full control of the Supply Officer.

5. A more detailed analysis of logistic operations during March is provided in the attached Logistics Summary Report.

F. CIVIL AFFAIRS

1. During the month of March two engineers from the Battalion Utilities section rewired the lighting system in the DONG HA Medical Dispensary. Several rooms were without light and the wire was in poor overall condition. A total of twelve lights were rewired, and a florescent light was reinstalled for the dispensary nurse. Additional lights were installed in the administrative building adjacent to the dispensary.

2. A sanitary inspection of the DONG HA Dispensary by the Preventive Medicine Section of 3d Medical Battalion was arranged by the Battalion Civil Affairs Officer. Tests were performed on a water sample from the dispensary well and a general inspection was made of the building. The results were that the unsanitary conditions existing are due to an inadequate drainage system, an acute problem of flies and impotable water.

3. An engineering estimate was given G-5 forward concerning the requirements for draining and grading an area in DONG HA for a school site. The project is to be sponsored by USAID and performed by PF and ARVN in the area.

4. Two MEDCAP operations were conducted at CAM THAI Village Headquarters during the month. On 16 March, 98 Vietnamese were treated by the Battalion Surgeon and two Corpsmen. The Army PsyOps section supporting 3d MarDiv (FWD) participated in the operation with leaflets, newspapers and Vietnamese music. A second MEDCAP was held on 22 March with a total of 52 persons treated. The village headquarters was used this time as well, and the Assistant Chief, Mr. XANG, was present to help maintain order.

5. Estimates on reconstruction of the school building in DOC KINH Hamlet (YD 095523) were curtailed due to the discovery of a mine field surrounding the school. Local PF units installed the field but are unable to locate the devices.

6. English classes were continued in the CAM LO Public and Private schools. Fifty-five students attended $1\frac{1}{2}$ hour classes on three days each week.

7. On 25 March the 3d Engineer Battalion CP was moved to PHU BAI to the GIA LE Combat Base area. The move resulted in a change of Civil Affairs responsibility. One of the English teachers, L/Cpl HEDGER, remained in DONG HA to continue classes in CAM LO. Lessons are given each day in the public school on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, and in the private school on Tuesday and Thursday. Additional classes have been initiated at the DONG HA public school. On Monday, Wednesday, and Friday evenings, L/Cpl HEDGER teaches Vietnamese teachers English vocabulary and pronunciation. The classes have been very enthusiastically received by the Vietnamese and will be continued until the end of the semester early in June.

In PHU BAI the 3d Engineer Battalion will be employed in general support of Civic Action projects of the 3d Marine Division.

Two LCU's with Battalion supplies were loaded at DONG HA
- 18Mar67: Two YFU craft were loaded with engineer equipment and departed DONG HA with LCU craft loaded the previous day. LCU's encountered difficulty in traversing sand bars in CAM LO River.
Detachment in DA NANG commenced embarkation of organic supplies for PHU BAI.
- 20Mar67: Six YFU and one LCU craft were loaded with engineer equipment and mixed cargo for departure from DONG HA the following day.
- 21Mar67: Two YFU craft loaded with mixed cargo for departure from DONG HA the following day.
Movement of organic supplies from DA NANG was completed.
- 22Mar67: Organic accounts were reopened at GIA LE and consolidation of organic supply commenced.
- 22Mar67: Embarkation representatives reported that unloading ramps in HUE-PHU BAI area are clogged with Battalion supplies and equipment.





1. Supply Situation

a. 3d Engineer Battalion RUC 13400 was closed down at DONG HA on 14 March, and all transactions were shifted to PHU BAI (FLSG-A). By 21 March all stocks held by the Battalion Supply Officer at both DONG HA and DANANG had been embarked for PHU BAI. During the latter half of March both the formal and informal accounts remained closed.

b. A new battalion directive was published on 10 March, setting forth revised, clarified, and simplified instructions for the control of organic property. One of the major effects of this directive is enhanced control over the procurement and control of individual equipment.

c. One major problem confronting this organization is that of providing adequate logistic support to its units deployed to operations beyond effective supporting radius of Battalion elements. Under the present organization logistic support must either be provided centrally from the Battalion's operating base or from supply and maintenance detachments taken from H & S and Support Companies. The former suffers from the disadvantages of time, space, and lack of transportation; the latter, from the lack of personnel and facilities to permit subdivision. The M-series T/O's do not envision separate battalions providing this support to dispersed units. This was to have been the function of the Service Battalion. Supply-wise, it is very impractical and difficult for this organization to maintain proper informal accounts for a unit 40 or 100 miles away, and this is not a peculiar problem. It is common to all separate battalions. Relief in this area is indicated.

d. This report will be sketchy in some areas because of the displacement of major elements of the Battalion late in the reporting period.

2. Not applicable.

3. Classes II and IV

a. Narrative summary follows:

(1) MCO 11300.6 and MCO 11330.2, which govern the introduction of the new Erdlater water purification and distribution equipment were received in March. It is noted that the present equipment will be retained without recourse to a special allowance authorization. My message ~~269818~~ Mar presented certain other problems relating to the new equipment, primarily regarding repair parts provisioning and availability of common hardware in-country. The in-service date for the new equipment will not be met; a date is impossible to predict at this time.

(2) By memorandum the Division Engineer was furnished requisition listings against Division Work Orders 4491, 4547, 4548, and 4576. The lists totalled 449 documents and about \$2 million. About 10% of all outstanding requisitions are for construction materials. (Internal supply procedures for handling receipt and issue of these materials have not been fully formulated at this time.)

(3) My message 2323114 Mar requested special action to obtain two Saws, radial, overarm, woodworking, non-portable, T/A 31240, for the Battalion carpenter shop. Action on this request is urgently required as this organization cannot expeditiously meet its construction commitments otherwise. A special allowance request is forthcoming.

(4) In response to CG 3d MarDiv msg 1204214 Mar, a special allowance of 27 M79 grenade launchers was urgently requested. My message 1608304 Mar applies.

(5) In response to CG 3d MarDiv msg 0914293 Mar, a special allowance of 17 16" oscillating fans was recommended for this organization. My 1304253 Mar applies.

(6) CG III MAF ltr 4C/rjh over 4441 of 13 Mar 1967 disapproved this organization's request for a special allowance of P-153 mine detectors on the grounds that establishment of a maintenance float allowance by BMC ltr AOW-lss/10 of 28 Feb 1967 obviated the hardship. Any further action with regard to a special allowance will be withheld while the effectiveness of the maintenance float is determined. It is noted, however, that the hardship exists now because there are no float items on hand, and the hardship will exist in the future whenever the float becomes depleted.

(7) My ~~0507052~~ Mar provided updated status of new family FM radios. CG 3d MarDiv msg 1101494 Mar requested authority from CG, FMFPac for this organization to requisition the components (less the receiver-transmitter RT-505) lacking for the AN/GRC-125. G-4 further advised that deficiencies of the RT-505 would be made up through internal re-distribution. On 27 March verbal authority was granted for requisitioning the AN/GRC-125 components.

(8) 72 unserviceable tents GP medium were turned-in to FLSU-1 in March, while 54 were drawn for Battalion use in the new GIA LE combat base.

a. Critipak Mine was received by this organization on 13 March. Status was reported on 30 March 1967, and showed a total of 35 out of 47 documents filled. No items of equipment were removed from deadline as a result. The critipak program offers no advantage over properly used priority O2 requisitioning.

b. My ~~070520Z~~ Mar requested assistance from the Division Motor Transport Officer in completing modification of a semi-trailer lowbed M172A1 pursuant to urgent modification MI-1522B-35/1A. No action has been reported, presumably because the modification materials have not been received.

c. My ~~060408Z~~ Mar requested assistance from the Division Communication-Electronics Officer in removing four Radio Sets AN/MRC-83 from deadline. Repairs to two were completed within a week. Radio repairs were completed on the other two, but they remain deadlined for vehicle repairs.

d. This organization has a total of 96 major end items on deadline. Of these, 87 have been evacuated to higher maintenance echelons. It has become obvious over the past six months that the availability of second echelon repair parts is insignificant compared to the problem of third echelon parts. While the key to the preventive maintenance effort is the organization, the key to the repair effort is certainly 1st FSR. One aspect of the problem is illustrated by the critical lack of dump trucks. This organization recommended in the Logistics Summary Report for February that special action be initiated to effect cannibalization of dump trucks presently held by 1st FSR agencies in order to return as many to this organization as possible. The authority cited was CG FMPPac msg 180345Z Feb 67. To date this organization has not been advised whether such action is contemplated, or what results may be expected.
