NARRATIVE SUMMARY

DECLASSIFIED

A. INTELLIGENCE

1. The Intelligence Officer continued to hold nightly briefings for the Battalion Commander and Section Heads during the month of September. The briefings consisted of mine and boobytrap incidents in the 3d Marine Division FAOR, current tactical situation and VC/NVA order of battle. Information pertinent in any way to Engineer Operations was also passed at the nightly briefings. The Battalion Intelligence Chief and Assistant substituted in the absence of the Intelligence Officer.

2. During the month of September there was a noted increase in the number of mine and boobytrap incidents reported. A total of 94 mine and boobytrap incidents for September as compared with a total of 76 mine and boobytrap incidents for August. Of the total mine and boobytrap incidents reported, 45 were detonated and 49 were either found and destroyed or disarmed. Again for the month of September the most common type device used was grenades rigged as boobytraps and also ordinance rounds. The highest concentration of incidents was the area in and around the Con Thien and Gio Linh area.

B. Training

1. Training during the month of September consisted of GMS Training as outlined in Part II, section B.

2. Three Marines from the 3d Engineer Battalion were schooled in the operations and maintenance of 20KW and 30KW generators.

3. The 3d Marine Division Land Mine Warfare School, conducted by this battalion, continued to instruct both Division and Non-division personnel in mines, boobytraps, and demolitions. The instruction was conducted by contact teams and resident courses in the battalion school at PHU BAI.

4. During September the 3d Marine Division Tunnel Teams continued to train.

5. On 30 September and 1 October a contact assistance team from FMF Pac visited the Motor Transport Platoon of this battalion.

C. Operations

1. General. During September the 3d Engineer Battalion remained operational in general support of the 3d Marine Division. Employment of the battalion was in the dual role of combat support and combat service support.

2. General Combat Support

a. A total of 309 deliberate/visual minesweeps were conducted during September for a daily average distance of 31,183 meters. The following MSR segments were covered:

3. Direct Combat Support

a. Combat support of infantry operations was provided through task organized engineer units from the 3d Engineer Battalion. This support was primarily provided by the three letter companies, with detachments from H&S Company and Support Company providing communication, medical and equipment support. The three letter companies provided an average of 484 engineers for close combat support of infantry operations in the QUANG TRI, DONG HA, KHE SANH, COBI THAN TAN and PHU BAI areas of operation. The primary work performed during September was mine sweeping, demolitions, tunnel destruction and bunker construction.

b. "A" Company continued to support the 3d Marine Regiment in northern QUANG TRI Province. One platoon from "A" Company is located at KHE SANH with the general mission of developing and maintaining the base camp.

c. "B" Company continued its support of the 4th Marines at COBI THAN TAN. The 3d Platoon, "B" Company completed operation CUMBERLAND on 15 September 1967. The platoon destroyed all bunkers at the Fire Support Base, D/1/4 position and 1/4 CP before abandoning these areas. CS powder was also spread on the abandoned positions.

d. "C" Company supported the 9th Marines during September in the DONG HA and CON THIEN areas. One platoon from "C" Company was at KHE SANH in support of the 26th Marines.

e. Ordnance and fortification destroyed by elements of the 3d Engineer Battalion during September are listed in Part IV, Section E. Documentation is found in Part IV, Section A.

4. Combat Service Support

a. Roads and Bridges

On 7 September the S-3A led a task group of personnel from H&S Company and Support Company to pioneer and upgrade Route 546 from the GIA LE Combat Base (YD 831140) to the NAM HOA Bridge site (YD 757157) in order to obviate the use of Route 1 and Route 547 south of HUE in order to reach the Operation CUMBERLAND area. Route 546 also would cut the distance and time down required to reach the CUMBERLAND area. After

pioneering the road, the job of upgrading the road by the Seabees was abandoned due to more urgent commitments in northern QUANG TRI Province.

b. Field Fortifications

The 40'x80' COC bunker at the Division CP was completed in September. The bunker was occupied on 28 September. Work began on the 40'x80' communication center bunker at the same site.

c. General Construction

The Division CP building was completed and occupied in September. Remaining to be completed on the over-all project are the road system, drainage and sodding.

d. Utilities

The Utilities Platoon, Support Company completed the wiring and plumbing for the Division CP building. Ten water points were operated during September. Totals for the month were:

e. Drafting and Surveying

The drafting and surveying section continued to support the Division with a drafting, surveying and layout capability.

D. COMMUNICATIONS

1. Communications were maintained with Engineer units located at DONG HA and Camp EVANS.
2. Provided Communication Center guard for all units located at GIA LE Combat Base.
3. Buried existing telephone line to eliminate overheading.
4. Laid telephone lines to 155mm Gun Platoon, MCB-10, Bridge Platoon, Support Company Officers Quarters.
5. Modified telephone terminal board to provide easier access.
6. Replaced all telephone lines in Battalion Headquarters.
7. Relocated several telephones as tents were vacated and wooden huts occupied.
8. Provided radio communication with all units within Gia Le Perimeter during hours of darkness.
9. Provided radio communication for detachment upgrading Route 546.
10. Provided radio communication for medical evacuation of three personnel from 1st Battalion, 4th Marines employed in security element for upgrading of Route 546.
11. Provided radio communication for Construction Platoon detachment working at CAC A-7 command post.
12. Conducted two-day Radio Operators Course for non-communication type personnel within the Battalion.

E. LOGISTICS

1. During September 1967 the 3d Engineer Battalion continued to manage and coordinate its logistic support from its headquarters at the Gia Le Combat Base.

2. September was a relatively quiet period of normal logistics operations. A brief synopsis of significant logistic activities follows:

a. Substantial effort was again devoted to the further improvement of the Battalion's logistic posture, in terms of both external and internal support. Representatives from Division Headquarters inaugurated a continuing review to determine means of improving this organization's supply and equipment readiness as reported in the OPSTAT. Conclusions reached by Division representatives are similar to those expressed by this organization in previous reports and Chronologies, that the solution to existing material deficiencies is now dependent upon external agencies. Further exploitation of a unit Critical Items Program was undertaken with the same goal of improving logistic readiness, and excellent support was received from Division Headquarters in pursuing this program.

b. The primary means of resupply of organic units in Dong Ha was by overland convoy. This is steadily becoming more problematic as VC interdiction of bridges becomes more persistent with the approach of the monsoon. Resupply to engineer platoons in the Khe Sanh area became increasingly difficult because the only access is by air. This rules out any significant heavy engineer support in that area.

c. Some relief from shortage of lumber was experienced with receipt of about 95,000 board feet. Although this organization received an initial shipment of bunker material from the Advance Base Functional Components program, timber for the construction, replacement, and repair of bunkers and bridges remained in seriously short supply, and most construction of this nature is held up. Small reserves of heavy lumber are held for the repair of bunkers in CAC areas, inasmuch as probes of these units have increased in frequency and intensity.

d. The S-4, acting as a Division representative, attended a New Equipment/Material Seminar held by the Commanding General, III MAF. Topics included special in-country requirements for new and modified equipment, the Research and Development program, and participation in field testing by III MAF. The most urgent requirements presented for the engineer field were a sturdier version of the P-153 mine detector and new one and two-man chain saws. A recurrent topic in all phases of discussion was the need for insuring supportability and maintainability of any new item introduced into III MAF, whether for testing or for general use.

e. Elements of MCB-10 began arriving at the Gia Le Combat Base from Okinawa on 26 September and were billeted by this organization. Headquarters elements will operate from Gia Le, while other detachments are committed to special projects in Quang Tri Province and to other tasks in the Phu Bai area.

E. LOGISTICS

3. A more detailed analysis of logistic operations during September is provided in the attached Logistics Summary Report.

F. CIVIL AFFAIRS

1. During the month of September two Med Caps were conducted. The Army Psy Ops Team was not available for the second Med Cap due to prior operational commitments. The attitude of the people in the Village of Loc Dien remains friendly.

2. On the 10th of September 1967 a Med Cap was held in the Village of Loc Dien. With the Battalion Surgeon participating, there were a total of 57 people treated: 31 children, 20 women and 6 men. An Army Psy Ops Team was employed to entertain the people, by showing movies.

3. On the 21st of September 1967 the final med Cap for the month was held in the Village of Loc Dien. With the Battalion Surgeon participating, there were a total of 89 people treated: 76 children, 9 women and 4 men.





1. SUPPLY SITUATION

a. This organization holds approximately 1000 requisitions for which status has not been received. This means only that there is a modest improvement in FLC records keeping. As may be seen below, receipt of status means only that a vast number of obligations are backordered.

b. The following represents requisition status as of 25 September:

c. It is impossible to discern any trends in the above data because of the vagaries in supply response.

d. This organization is happy to report receipt of substantial stocks of lumber; however, the documents against which the lumber is being issued for the most part are those cancelled at the direction of higher authority. This serves to indicate that FLC is no better organized in their lumber management now than they ever were. Documentary proof of this was delivered to the Division Supply Officer.

e. Enemy action in Quang Tri province has had no appreciable effect on this organization's supply situation, except to inhibit the flow of supplies north in support of organic units operating out of Dong Ha.

f. It is noted that after several months of intense effort a good monsoon package was put together for the Division. However, two questions present themselves:

(1) How is the Division going to facilitate the movement of tons of these supplies northward from Phu Sai for those organizations headquartered in Phu Sai? Transportation northward is already critical without these additional quantities of supplies.

(2) Does FLC intend to provide status on monsoon requisitions? None has been received.

g. A slight improvement in critical items can be reported:

- (1) Body armor, upper torso - not critical
- (2) Receipt of a few 6TN batteries
- (3) Receipt of a few 900x16 tires and tubes
- (4) Receipt of some oxygen and acetylene
- (5) Receipt of a grader
- (6) Receipt of lumber
- (7) A satisfactory situation with regard to clothing

However, the above gains have not served to improve the reported readiness posture of this organization. To accomplish this there must be substantial gains.

h. It seems to this organization that the problem in evacuating equipment from FLSG/FLST to higher echelon for exceeding repair time frames is that a replacement is placed on requisition for each item evacuated. However, the evacuated equipment can at some point be expected to be returned to III Marine Amphibious Force units since all items evacuated are repairable. Resulting T/E deficiencies could be on requisition against non-existent assets unless it is planned to use repaired equipment to fill the requisitions. If this were the case, there should be no need for 3d Force Service Regiment to pass the requisitions to Marine Corps Supply Activity Philadelphia as is being done at this time. There does not appear to be any system for matching unit requisitions with like items which have been repaired.

i. Commanding General, 3d Marine Division message 150929Z September indicates Commanding General, Fleet Marine Force Pacific feels an excessive number of TD-15 are in deadline. This may be, but it is felt that CG, FMF Pac should also realize that an excessive number on requisition is also indicated. All TD-15's dropped from the accounts of this organization were dropped, not because they were beyond economical repair, but because they met the criteria for evacuation contained in Fleet Marine Force Pacific Order 4710.2. If these tractors had been repaired and returned to field use, this organization might not have the T/E deficiencies that presently exist.

6. MAINTENANCE SITUATION

a. NORS requisitioning to date has not proved any more effective than any other high priority program in relieving repair parts deficiencies.

b. It is recommended that some inquiry be made into the effectiveness of the FLSU-1 maintenance program. Maintenance support at Dong Ha has never been more than marginal, yet in spite of the input of additional tools and equipment into FLSU-1, the level of support has hardly changed. This organization has not had a single motor transport item repaired since May. It has been observed that in Communications/Electronics Maintenance shop, the same individual performs the repairs and inspects his work. There have been instances where equipment has been returned to using units without completion of the requested repairs. Finally, shop supervision and management leave much to be desired.

c. This organization presently has 66 items of equipment deadlined at second echelon and 31 at third echelon. Although this is a reversal of the trend previously noted, it is also pointed out that this organization also has on requisition 54 major items of equipment. Most of these requisitions resulted from T/E deficiencies created by the evacuation of equipment exceeding allowable repair time promises. See paragraph 1i.

d. Repair parts for multifuel vehicles are still not available. The lack of multifuel parts will be even more acutely felt during the monsoon.

e. The situation with regard to AN/MRC-83 radio sets is critical. This organization has one on requisition, one operational, and four deadlined (two for radio repair, and two for vehicle repair). Presently this organization has no radio contact with its units at Dong Ha and must rely on land lines.

9. SERVICES SITUATION

a. Property Disposal. Letters of unserviceable property were received for 10 major items of equipment.

b. Laundry. All laundry service is provided by indigenous concessionaires and has been satisfactory. Work on the new Korean Laundry has not been completed yet. Major cause of delay is the drilling of a well by MCB-3.

c. Bath Units. Shower points were operated in accordance with the T/O mission.

d. Bakery. Bread continued to be the only bakery product available from FLSO-A and was satisfactory in quantity and quality. All other bakery products were prepared internally; however, stocks of such staples as flour and sugar became exhausted late in the month, eliminating most of the baking.

e. Ice. Quantities from authorized sources in Hue were adequate for basic needs.

f. Food Services

(1) An average of about 550 men were fed daily at the Battalion messhall in Gia Le. Companies "A" and "C" share operation of a messhall in Dong Ha.

(2) Toward the end of September, serious shortages of dry stores, fresh produce, and eggs, began to have a deleterious effect on the menu. Shortages of eggs, flour, sugar, coffee, potatoes, etc., are hard to explain, and even harder to compensate for. FLSO-A was unable to give a satisfactory explanation. The impact of these shortages was aggravated by the arrival of advance elements of MCB-10, hosted by this organization commencing 27 September. This organization was hard pressed to provide an adequate menu.

g. Mortuary Services. This organization had 4 KIA as of 27 September.

h. Graves Registration. Not Applicable.

1. Potable Water. Ten Battalion water points produced a total of about 9,400,000 gallons of potable water during September in support of Division units.

13. TRANSPORTATION: SIGNIFICANT PROBLEM AREAS

a. It is felt that significant improvement can be worked in helicopter air freight operations by MAG-16. At present, MAG-16 priorities for movement of personnel and freight:

Priority 1- MAG-16 personnel
 Priority 2- MAG-16 cargo
 Priority 3- Other personnel
 Priority 4- Other cargo

Thus, service support, which should come first, comes last. Even when special lifts have been fragged, the option to carry the cargo or personnel rests with the pilot. There is no guarantee that when cargo is properly manifested, it will be flown. It is only with great difficulty and excessive staff action that this organization has been able to move supplies by CH-53. Where resupply to Khe Sanh is concerned, this is a matter of utmost sensitivity.

b. In addition to the engineer effort, there are four factors which spell the success or failure of operations in Vietnam: Sealift, Airlift, Overland lift, and Materials handling. III MAF is inadequately supported in all of these areas. Merely doubling the number of LCU's, transport aircraft, semi-trailer combinations, and forklifts would enormously enhance the flow of materials in all operating areas. Compared to the overall daily cost of III MAF operations, the investment would be minimal.
