

A. INTELLIGENCE

1. The Intelligence Officer continued to hold nightly briefings for the Battalion Commander and Staff during the month of November. The reports consisted of significant events concerning 3rd Engineer Battalion and general administrative remarks from the S-2 section.
2. During the month of November there was a noted increase in the number of mine and boobytrap incidents reported. A total of 116 mine and boobytrap incidents for November as compared with a total of 78 mine and boobytrap incidents for October. Of the total mine and boobytrap incidents reported, 54 were detonated and 62 were either found and destroyed or disarmed. The highest concentration of incidents was in the Southeast part of Quang Tri Province.

B. Training

1. Training during the month of November consisted of GMS Training outlined in Part II, section B.

2. The 3d Marine Division Land Mine Warfare School, conducted by this battalion continued operating.

3. During the month of November Tunnel Teams continued to train, and "B" Company sent one four man tunnel team to support "C" Company on Operation KENTUCKY.

C. Operations

1. General. During November the 3d Engineer Battalion remained operational in general support of the 3d Marine Division. Employment of the battalion was in a dual role of combat support and combat service support.

2. General Combat Support

a. A total of 305 deliberate/visual mine sweeps were conducted during November for a daily average of 27,190 meters. The following MSR segments were covered:

3. Direct Combat Support

a. Combat Support of infantry operations was provided through task organized engineer units from the 3d Engineer Battalion. This support was primarily provided by the three letter companies, with detachments from H&S Company and Engineer Support Company providing communication, medical, and equipment support. This support was provided in the QUANG TRI, DONG HA, KHE SANH, COBI THAN TAN, and PHU BAI areas of operation. The primary work performed was mine sweeping, demolitions, and bunker construction.

b. Company "A" continued to support the 3d Marine Regiment in the northern QUANG TRI Province. One platoon from Company "A" is located at KHE SANH with the general mission of developing and maintaining the base camp.

c. Company "B" continued its support of the 4th Marine Regiment at COBI THAN TAN.

d. Company "C" continued support of the 9th Marine Regiment in the DONG HA and CON THIEN areas. The 1st Platoon from Company "C" is at KHE SANH under OPCON 1/26. This platoon provided little support to 1/26 during this period. $\frac{1}{2}$ hour daily sweeps and small demolition projects were all the work accomplished.

4. Combat Service Support

a. Roads and Bridges

No major road construction was conducted during November. The road network around the Division CP was completed. Elements from H&S Company and Support Company assisted 1st Platoon, 3d Bridge Company, 7th Engineer Battalion in repair of M-4 floating bridges at (ZD 098006) and (YD 926102), and M-6 at (YD 913118).

b. Field Fortifications

This unit continued to assist other units in the KHE SANH, DONG HA, QUANG TRI, COBI THAN TAN, and PHU BAI areas with material and manpower to improve existing field fortification including defensive wire and bunker construction. The largest project was a 40'x70' communications bunker at Division CP, PHU BAI.

c. General Construction

The road network at Division CP was completed but work continued on the drainage and sodding. "A" Company continued construction of gun pads for 8/4th Artillery. "C" Company continued general constructing jobs in the DONG HA area. "B" Company is constructing a generator shed and continued general construction in the Camp EVANS area. Construction platoon, Support Company completed construction of 20'x20' water tank and began construction of a rapid sand filter at the PHU BAI Public Works Water Point.

d. Utilities

The Utilities Platoon, Support Company started wiring of Communications Bunker at Division CP and took over generator operations in the Division TAOR. A total of 22 generators have been invoiced to the battalion and we have assumed responsibility at KHE SANH, Camp EVANS, PHU BAI, and GIA LE. The number of MOS 1141's on board are not sufficient to satisfy requirements at present. Ten water points were operated during November. Totals for the month were:

The drafting and surveying section continued to support the Division with a drafting, surveying, and layout capability.

1. COMMUNICATIONS WERE MAINTAINED WITH ENGINEER UNITS LOCATED AT DONG HA AND CAMP EVANS.
2. PROVIDED COMMUNICATION CENTER GUARD FOR ALL UNITS AT GIA LE COMBAT BASE.
3. PROVIDED RADIO COMMUNICATION WITH ALL UNITS WITHIN GIA LE PERIMETER DURING HOURS OF DARKNESS.
4. PROVIDED RADIO COMMUNICATION WITH OBSERVATION POST DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS.
5. PROVIDED 24-HOUR SWITCHBOARD WATCH AT BATTALION HEADQUARTERS.
6. INSTALLED AIR HORN ALERT SYSTEM.
7. INSTALLED TELEPHONE TO GENERATOR PAD.

E. LOGISTICS

1. During November 1967 the 3d Engineer Battalion continued to manage and coordinate its logistic support from its Headquarters at the Gia Le Combat Base. Relief of the Battalion Commander as a result of transfer was effected on 6 November 1967.
2. This organization must now provide at least 12,000 gallons of raw water daily to supplement its own water production. Current requirements of raw water exist in the Army 515 Transportation area and the 3d Shore Party area for showers. With only one 6,000 gallon water tanker and only a 5-Ton tractor serving as a prime mover it was necessary to decrease the distance which the water had to be transported to insure fulfillments of the daily requirements. Raw water had been transported from Phu Bai but because of the distance involved only two trips a day were being made. By coordinating with MCB-3 this organization is now transporting water from the MCB-3 water station located near Gia Le Combat Base and has increased its raw water capability and is currently fulfilling all requirements for raw water.
3. The second increment of M-16 rifles was received by this organization. The rifles are currently being issued to all companies. The remoteness from this parent organization of some of the elements of this command has created somewhat of a problem in the issue of rifles. The inaccessibility of the Platoon at Khe Sanh has delayed the planned in service date of the new rifles.
4. The opening of the Korean Exchange Laundry at the Gia Le Combat Base was greeted with much enthusiasm by all but the indigenous personnel who were operating laundries aboard the base. Some relief has been rendered the Vietnamese working in this organization's area as trash agreements were arranged to take the place of the laundry business which the Vietnamese were doing before the opening of the exchange laundry.
5. Logistic support rendered to the engineer companies continued to be overland convoy shipments. The heavily over committed motor transport section provided the necessary vehicles to support our units at Dong Ha, and Camp Evans.
6. A more detailed analysis of logistics operations during November is provided in the attached Logistic Summary Report of November.

F. CIVIL AFFAIRS

1. During the month of November two Med-Caps were conducted at CAC H-8 in the Village of Loc Dien. The attitude of the people in the village was friendly.

2. On 2 November a Med-Cap was held at CAC H-8, 92 persons were treated. There were 76 children, 11 women and 5 men. The battalion surgeon, two company and an Army PsyOps team participated.

3. On 9 November a Med-Cap was held at CAC H-8, 102 persons were treated. There were 77 children, 13 women and 12 men. The battalion surgeon and two company participated.

4. The Battalion S-2 attended the Civil Action Orientation course in Da Nang from 28 November till 1 December.



(2) With the opening of the Korean laundry the Battalion mess Officer assumed the responsibility of consolidating the meal sheets from the other messhalls in Gia Le and providing the Division Exchange officer with the number of meals the Korean personnel have consumed during the month so he can effect a one time collection at the end of the month.
