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PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

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A. INTELLIGENCE

1. The Intelligence Officer continued to hold nightly briefings for the Battalion Commander and Staff during the month of December. The reports consisted of significant events concerning 3rd Engineer Battalion and general administrative remarks from the S-2 section.
2. During the month of December there was a noted decrease in the number of mine and boobytrap incidents reported. A total of 95 mine and boobytrap incidents for December as compared with a total of 116 mine and boobytrap incidents for November. Of the total mine and boobytrap incidents reported, 37 were detonated and 58 were either found and destroyed or disarmed. The highest concentration of incidents was in the Southeast part of Quang Tri Province.

B. Training

1. Training during the month of December consisted of GMS Training outlined in Part II, section B.

2. The 3d Marine Division Landmine Warfare School, conducted by this unit continued operating.

3. During the month of December Tunnel Teams continued to train.

C. Operations

1. General. During December the 3d Engineer Battalion remained operational in general support of the 3d Marine Division. Employment of the battalion was in a dual role of close combat support and combat service support.

2. General Combat Support

a. A total of 282 deliberate/visual mine sweeps were conducted during December for a daily average of 35,300 meters. The following Mine Sweep Road Segments were covered:

b. In addition sweep teams were provided in support of motor transport convoys. A total of 48 sweeps were conducted between PHU BAI, Camp EVANS, QUANG TRI, and DONG HA for a daily average of 107,566 meters.

3. Direct Combat Support

a. Combat support of infantry operations was provided through task organized engineer units from the 3d Engineer Battalion. This support was primarily provided by the three letter companies, with detachments from H&S Company and Engineer Support Company providing communications, medical and equipment support. This support was provided in the QUANG TRI, DONG HA, KHE SANH, COBI THON TON, and PHU BAI areas of operation. The primary work performed was mine sweeping, demolitions, and bunker construction.

b. Company "A" continued to support the 3d Marine Regiment in the northern QUANG TRI Province. 1st Platoon Company "A" is located in KHE SANH and is in support of the 26th Marines.

c. Company "B" continued its support of the 4th Marine Regiment at COBI THANH TAN.

d. Company "C" continued to support the 9th Marine Regiment in the DONG HA and CON THIEN areas.

4. Combat Service Support

a. Roads and Bridges

No major road construction was conducted during December. Elements of H&S Company and Support Company assisted 1st Platoon, 3d Bridge Company, 7th Engineer Battalion in the erection of a 762 feet M-4 floating bridge at SONG HUONG River (VD 756142).

b. Field Fortifications

This organization continued to assist other organizations in the KHE SANH, DONG HA, QUANG TRI, COBI THANH TAN, and PHU BAI areas with material and manpower to improve existing field fortifications including defensive wire and bunker construction. The largest projects were the completion of a 40'x70' communications bunker at Division CP, PHU BAI and a 12'x32' bunker for DASC at DONG HA.

c. General Construction

Completed benches, tables and interior finish of the Division Communications Bunker at PHU BAI. Constructing a potable water distribution point, a rapid sand water filter, and relocating a 60'x120' helipad at Division CP PHU BAI. "A" Company continued work on the 8/4th Arty Gunpads, repaired a water tower at Camp CARROLL, and are constructing a 24'x32' recreation building at DONG HA. "B" Company constructed a maintenance and generator shed at Camp EVANS. Company "C" constructed a generator shed for DASC in DONG HA.

d. The Utilities Platoon, Support Company wired the Communications Bunker at Division CP. The generator section continued to maintain generators at KHE SANH, Camp EVANS, PHU BAI and GIA LE. Ten water points were operated during November. Totals for the month were:

E. Logistics

1. During December 1967 the 3d Engineer Battalion continued to manage and coordinate its logistic support from its Headquarters at the Gia Le Combat Base.
2. This organization is in the process of making arrangements for the receipt of 8,000 cubic meters of hard rock, 5" minus, to be delivered by Mr. Phan DUA and his employees. Mr. Phan DUA, 72 Duy Tan, Hue, Vietnam was granted the contract from the Naval Support Activity, Danang. The contract price is 3,352,000\$VN, another example of the contribution to the economic progress of Vietnam. This money is not granted or donated by American people; it is earned by the Vietnamese.
3. During December this organization nominated items of equipment and motor transport for special priority under the Red Ball system. If the Red Ball system produces the results invisioned it will greatly aid this organization's low percentage of available items.
4. The Supply Officer commenced the end of the quarter inventory of all items held by Battalion Supply. The inventory will assist greatly in determing shortages and excesses which can be resolved at the first of the new calendar year.
5. It has found that this organization's platoons located at Khe Sanh can be more effectively supported logistically from the Parent Command here at Gia Le Combat Base than it can from the letter companies located at Dong Ha due to the relative inaccessability of Khe Sanh from Dong Ha.
6. A more detailed analysis of logistics operations during December is provided in the attached Logistic Summary Report for December.

F. CIVIL AFFAIRS

1. During the month of December two Med-Caps were conducted at CAC H-8 in the Village of Loc Dien. The attitude of the people in the village was friendly.
2. On 7 December a Med-Cap was held at CAC H-8, 80 persons were treated. There were 70 children, 8 women and 2 men. The battalion surgeon, two corpsmen participated.



(3) Major end items on requisition and Major items of Equipment deadline for 3d echelon repairs have been isolated and nominated for the Red Ball system. If the Red Ball program works as it is envisioned the outcome will have a very positive effect on this organizations operational readiness.

(4) The critical shortage of culvert material has been eliminated with the receipt of 36" Culvert. The need for 60" Culvert remains as the 36" Culvert will not serve as a solution to some drainage problems.
