

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PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

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A. INTELLIGENCE

1. The Intelligence Officer continued to hold nightly briefings for the Battalion Commander and Staff during the month of January. The reports consisted of significant events concerning 3d Engineer Battalion and general administrative remarks from the S-2 section.
2. During the month of January there was a noted decrease in the number of mine and boobytrap incidents reported. A total of 79 mine and boobytrap incidents for January as compared with a total of 95 mine and boobytrap incidents for December. Of the total mine and boobytrap incidents reported, 26 were detonated and 53 were either found and destroyed or disarmed.
3. It should be noted that box mines were once again found in the Phong Dien area. Approximately 7 of this type homemade VC devices were found between 4 January and 9 January 1968. All were found around Phong Dien.

B. Training

1. Training during the month of January consisted of GMS Training outlined in Part II, section B.

2. The 3d Marine Division Landmine Warfare School, conducted by this unit continued operating.

a. PHU BAI LMWS

3. During the month of January Tunnel Teams continued to train.

C. Operations

1. General. During January the 3d Engineer Battalion remained operational in general support of the 3d Marine Division. Employment of the battalion was in a dual role of combat support and combat service support.

2. General Combat Support

a. A total of 304 deliberate/visual mine sweeps were conducted during January for a daily average of 38,456 meters. The following Mine Sweep Road Segments were covered:

b. In addition sweep teams were provided in support of motor transport convoys. A total of 80 sweeps were conducted between PHU BAI, Camp EVANS, QUANG TRI, and DONG HA for a daily average of 110,567 meters.

3. Direct Combat Support

a. General support of infantry operations was provided through task organized engineer units from the 3d Engineer Battalion. This support was primarily provided by the three letter companies, with detachments from H&S Company and Engineer Support Company providing communications, medical and equipment support. This support was provided in the QUANG TRI, DONG HA, KHE SANH, Camp EVANS and PHU BAI areas of operation. The primary work performed was mine sweeping, demolitions, and bunker construction.

b. Company "A" continued to support the 3d Marine Regiment until 15 January when it began to support the 4th Marine Regiment. One platoon from "A" Company supports 26th Marines in KHE SANH with the general mission of developing and maintaining the base camp and providing combat support.

c. Company "B" continued its support of the 4th Marine Regiment at Camp EVANS until 15 January when it began support of 3d Marine Regiment in QUANG TRI.

d. Company "C" continued to support the 9th Marine Regiment in the DONG HA and CON THIEN areas. One platoon from Company "C" supports 26 Marines in KHE SANH with the general mission of developing and maintaining the base camp and providing combat support.

4. Combat Service Support

a. Roads and Bridges

No major road construction was conducted during January. Elements of H&S Company and Support Company assisted 1st Platoon, 3d Bridge Company, 7th Engineer Battalion in the completion of a 762 foot M-4 floating bridge at SONG HUONG River (YD 756142).

b. Field Fortifications

This organization continued to assist other organizations in the KHE SANH, DONG HA, QUANG TRI, Camp EVANS, and PHU BAI areas with material and manpower to improve existing field fortifications including defensive wire and bunker construction. Emphasis was placed on developing defensive fortifications in KHE SANH.

c. General Construction

Continued work on rapid sand filter at 4/12 area. Built water tower at 3d Med Battalion, rewired and relocated outlets in Division COC Bunker. Constructed mount out boxes for 3d Division units. Installed culverts and graded 3d Motor Transport staging lot. Relocated sea huts (2) at Headquarters Battalion - delivered 15 yards rock and prepared gun site for 155 Gun Battery. Graded road and installed culverts at GIA LE 3d Anti-Tanks Battalion Area. Pre-cut 5 bunkers for KHE SANH AREA and made general preparation to move the 3d Engineer Battalion to QUANG TRI.

d. The Utilities Platoon, Support Company wired the Communications Bunker at Division CP. The generator section continued to maintain generators at KHE SANH, Camp EVANS, PHU BAI and GIA LE. Nine water points were operated during January. Totals for the month were:

e. Drafting and Surveying

The drafting and surveying section continued to support the Division with a drafting, surveying and layout capability.

D. COMMUNICATIONS

1. 3rd Engineer Bn. ceased communications guard for Gia Le Combat Base.
2. Wire lines were provided for A Co. 1st Shore Party Bn., A & C Cos. 1st Eng. Bn.
3. Communications were maintained with Engineer units located at Dong Ha, Quang Tri, and Camp Evans.
4. 5 PRC-25's and 5 operators were provided for the provisional company at Quang Tri.
5. Communications were provided for bridge construction M4T6 at Nam Hoa.
6. Provided radio communications and relay link for Bridge Plt. repairing bridges on Rt. #1.
7. A 24 hour switchboard was maintained at Bn. Hdqts.
8. Sound Equipment was provided to support USO show presented at Gia Le.
9. A 24 hour radio watch was provided on the Bn Control Frequency and on the Base Control Frequency.
10. Provided wire communications for perimeter defense.

E. LOGISTICS

1. During January 1968 the 3d Engineer Battalion continued to manage and coordinate its logistic support from its Headquarters at the Gia Le Combat Base.
2. Mid-January the Battalion received notification of cancellation of approximately 3,500 requisitions. The massive cancellation is an attempt to purge the MILSTRIP system of invalid documents. Many of the documents remain valid, but much valuable lead time will be lost as a new requisition must be initiated for each valid document. No provisions has been established to reinstate a valid document to the last known holder.
3. The office supply picture was brightened somewhat with the receipt of a "CRITIPAC" containing the majority of the blank forms that would have caused the Battalion administrative management problems. If the "CRITIPAC" program continues, substantial benefits will be realized.
4. January was a very routine month from the supply standpoint. Normal receipt of supplies was realized and less than normal requisitions were initiated due to the reconciliation of all documents.

F. CIVIL AFFAIRS

1. During the month of January two Med-Caps were conducted at CAC H-8 in the village of Loc Dien. The attitude of the village was friendly.
2. On 4 January a Med-Cap was held at CAC H-8 and 120 persons were treated. There were 98 children, 13 women and 6 men. The battalion surgeon and two corpsman participated. The civil affairs officer discussed possible projects with the village officials and personnel from CAC H-8.
3. On 18 January a meeting was held at Division G-5 of all the 3d Marine Division Civil Affairs Officers. At this time each unit gave a recap of its civil affairs areas and activities in preparation for Task Force X-Ray assuming civil affairs responsibility in Thua Thien Province.
4. On 23 January a Med-Cap was held at the request of CAC H-8. At this time 73 people were treated, 69 children, 3 women, and 1 man. The battalion surgeon and two corpsman participated.
5. On 27 January a TET celebration was held with the contractors and Vietnamese workers aboard Gia Le Combat Base. At this time gifts were given to the workers children including TET envelopes and money, and toys.







1. SUPPLY SITUATION

a. Requisition cancellations decreased this organizations outstanding requisitions from 5,000 to approximately 1,400. Complete results of the large number of requisitions cancelled is undetermined at this time. Obvious results of the cancellations will be marked increase in available funds, high percentage of Ø2 requisitions outstanding as these were not cancelled, and heavy volume of requisitions to be submitted in the coming month.

b. The most critical problem confronting this organization this past month is the resupply of Engineer units at Khe Sanh. Bunker construction materials, water purification chemicals and equipment, and other items of combat essential engineer equipment have been prepared for shipment but have not been shipped even though there is sufficient justification for a priority 1 classification. Some means of shipment must be made available as the shortage of water supply equipment and chemicals at Khe Sanh is critical.

c. Receipt of supplies this month has been satisfactory except for certain items of equipment essential for continuing close combat support to the Division. Individual Demolition Equipment sets, blasting cap boxes, blasting cap crimpers, barb-wire gloves, and wire cutters have been on order for over six months and this organization has received none of these items through normal supply channels.

d. A critical shortage of 1½" banding material is present with this organization. The large quantity of 1½" banding material expended on materials being shipped to Khe Sanh and Dong Ha has exhausted the stock of this material. The weight of materials, i.e. culvert, lumber, and wire, necessitates banding only with the 1½" material.

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(d. cont.)

In event of movement of this Battalion the lack of this size banding material would create serious embarkation problems due to pallet bands breaking and loose gear being scattered throughout the area. The shortage of 1 1/2" banding material appears to exist throughout the Division.

e. Receipt of office supply "Critipac" was outstanding. If the Critipac program continues there will be few problems with shortage of office supplies.

3. CLASSES II AND IV

a. Summary

(1) Engineer heavy equipment items deadlined and on requisition seriously hamper the successful accomplishment of this organizations mission. Allowance deficiencies remain the largest single problem with Class II supplies.

(2) Receipt of engineer and communication/electronic items have been minimal this past month. One Bath Unit, four Chain Saws and two Mine Detectors were received by this organization.

9. SERVICES SITUATION

a. Property Disposal. Letters of unserviceable property were received for (4) major items of equipment.

b. Laundry. Gia Le Combat Base receives laundry service from the Korean Laundry and the Vietnamese Laundrys. Excellent service is provided to all organizations located at Gia Le Combat Base.

c. Bath Units. Shower points were operated in accordance with the T/C mission. One bath unit received shrapnel and is presently deadlined. One new bath unit was received through the supply system.

d. Bakery. With the exception of bread, all other bakery products were prepared internally. Bakery goods are sufficient to meet the needs of the organizations fed by the Battalions Food Service Section.

e. Ice. Quantities of ice received were adequate for the basic needs; however, with the recent increase in personnel being fed there will be a shortage of ice.

f. Food Services.

(1) The food services section is in the process of holding a complete inventory of all equipment, preparing mount out boxes and embarkation information.

(2) An average of 750 men were fed daily at the Battalion mess hall at Gia Le Combat Base.

i. Potable Water. Battalion water points produced a total of approximately 4,646,400 gallons of potable water during January in support of Division units. MCB-121 finished a 210' deep-water well which is currently putting out 27 to 30 gallons of water per minute. The new well will help tremendously in solving the water problem for the Gia Le complex. The Battalions water tanker, 3,000 Gal, is currently deadlined for 2d echelon repairs.

a. The critical shortage of refrigeration equipment and the inability to store quantities of fresh produce is the largest problem area to the food service program.
