NARRATIVE SUMMARY

A. INTELLIGENCE

1. The Intelligence Officer did not hold nightly briefings for the Battalion Commander and Staff as in the past. Significant events concerning 3d Engineer Battalion and the tactical area around the Gia Le Combat Base were brought to the attention of the Battalion Commander and the S-3 as was necessary to keep them informed of the situation.
2. On the morning of 31 January, Gia Le Combat Base received approximately 35 rounds of 122mm rockets. The rockets were identified by the characteristic nozzels and rocket motors left after detonation. The rockets continued on a more or less sporadic schedule through the afternoon of 1 February 1968.
3. The schedule that the rockets were fired on is of some interest. The night-time attacks characteristically start at or after 0300 and move back one hour each succeeding night that the attack continues. The daytime attacks were timed to hit during meal hours and also move back on succeeding days.
4. Enemy were spotted on several occasions around the Gia Le Perimeter and on at least one occasion a fire mission was called in. The mission was observed to cover the area but a sweep the next day failed to provide any substantial evidence of enemy casualties. Most movements were determined to be units moving to and from Hue City.
5. Due to the displacement of 3d Marine Division to the Quang Tri area and due to the tactical situation comprehensive mine and booby trap incident reports were not received. The reports received indicated a very sharp decrease in incidents reported. This was probably due to three factors; 1) The enemy favored large scale operations and heavy weapons including armor and heavy artillery in lieu of widespread clandestine activities; 2) The enemy brought the attacks to the U.S. bases as opposed to his previous tactics of letting U.S. personnel come to him; and 3) Our movement on roads and overland was severely restricted thus limiting his opportunities for mining.

B. Training

1. Training during the month of February consisted of GMS Training outlined in Part II, section B.
2. The 3d Marine Division Landmine Warfare School, conducted by this unit continued operating.

3. During the month of February Tunnel Teams continued to train.

C. Operations

1. General. During February the 3d Engineer Battalion remained operational in general support of the 3d Marine Division. Employment of the battalion was in a dual role of combat support and combat service support.

2. General Combat Support

a. A total of 216 deliberate/visual mine sweeps were conducted during February for a daily average of 27,052 meters. The following Mine Sweep Road Segments were covered:

b. In addition sweep teams were provided in support of motor transport convoys. A total of 8 sweeps were conducted between PHU BAI, Camp EVANS, QUANG TRI, and DONG HA for a daily average of 23,640 meters.

3. Direct Combat Support

a. General support of infantry operations was provided through task organized engineer units from the 3d Engineer Battalion. This support was primarily provided by the three letter companies, with detachments from H&S Company and Engineer Support Company providing communications, medical and equipment support. This support was provided in the QUANG TRI, DONG HA, KHE SANH, Camp EVANS, and PHU BAI areas of operation. The primary work performed was mine sweeping, demolitions, and bunker construction.

b. Company "A" continued to support 4th Marine Regiment. One platoon from "A" Company supports 26th Marines in KHE SANH with the general mission of developing and maintaining the base camp and providing combat support.

c. Company "B" continued its support of the 3d Marine Regiment in QUANG TRI.

d. Company "C" continued to support the 9th Marine Regiment in the DONG HA and CON THIEN areas. One platoon from Company "C" supports 26th Marines in KHE SANH with the general mission of developing and maintaining the base camp and providing combat support.

4. Combat Service Support

a. Roads and Bridges

No major road construction was constructed during the month of February because of combat conditions. Personnel of H&S and Support was deployed with Provisional Rifle Company in QUANG TRI.

b. Field Fortifications

This organization continued to assist other organizations in the KHE SANH, DONG HA, QUANG TRI, Camp EVANS, and PHU BAI areas with material and manpower to improve existing field fortifications including defensive wire and bunker construction. Emphasis was placed on developing defensive fortifications in KHE SANH.

c. General Construction

None due to combat conditions.

d. Utilities Platoon, The Generator Section continued to maintain generators during February at KHE SANH, Camp EVANS, PHU BAI, and GIA LE. Nine water points were operated during February. Totals for the month were:

1. COMMUNICATIONS WERE MAINTAINED WITH ENGINEER UNITS LOCATED AT DONG HA, CAMP EVANS AND LE VANG.
2. PROVIDED 24-HOUR SWITCHBOARD WATCH AT BATTALION HEADQUARTERS.
3. PROVIDED FIVE RADIO OPERATORS WITH RADIO AN/PRC-25 FOR DUTY WITH "G" COMPANY.
4. 1ST LT R.J. BELL ASSUMED DUTIES AS THIRD ENGINEER BATTALION COMMUNICATION OFFICER.
5. GYSGT BROWN ASSUMED DUTIES AS THIRD ENGINEER COMMUNICATION CHIEF.

E. Logistics

1. During February 1969 the 3d Engineer Battalion continued to manage and coordinate its logistic support from its Headquarters at the Gia Le Combat Base.
2. Due to the current tactical situation and increased enemy activity along Highway one, all land shipments to the Battalion's organic letter companies located at Quang Tri and Dong Ha have ceased. The air transport system is overcrowded and any large shipment of routine supplies to the organic company is unfeasible.
3. The emergency situation for resupply of Khe Sanh has interrupted normal transportation requests to that location and the Battalion currently reacts to "critical resupply" and "emergency resupply" demands placed on it by higher headquarters with little or no advance notice.
4. The overall supply situation looks brighter as the Battalion has been receiving supply status and record jackets on some of the more critical T/E deficiencies, i.e. MRS 100's, Road Graders, Bath Units, and Crawler Cranes.
5. The large material handling requirements placed on this organization has generated an urgent requirement for a fork type loader. The Battalion has the third largest supply account in the Division and handles over 12 tons of palletized supplies weekly; not counting lumber, culvert and other Class IV items. There is no operable fork type loader located at Gia Le to handle the Battalions' routine Supply.

F. CIVIL AFFAIRS

1. During the month of February no Civic Action was conducted due to the tactical situation resulting from the TET Offensive.
2. This Organization was also relieved of its Civil Affairs responsibility by Task Force X-Ray during the month of January on the premise that this organization would be assigned a Civil Affairs Area of Responsibility in the Quang Tri Area. The tactical situation has prevented this organization's displacement North.

1. SUPPLY SITUATION

a. The Supply situation has been improving with the receipt of several end items of equipment and indications are, that more T/E and Special allowance deficiencies will be filled in the near future. This organization has received the equipment record jackets of 10 Bath Units, 1 Adams 550 Grader, 1 M-37 Crawler Crane and the overall supply picture is looking up.

b. With very few items deadlined at second echelon, repair parts placed on requisition by this organization, with the exception of Multi-fuel Vehicle parts, are not a critical problem.

c. The most critical problem confronting this organization at present is the non existence of an operable fork type loader at Gia Le Combat Base. The large material handling requirements placed on this organization has generated an urgent requirement for a fork type loader. This Battalion has the third largest Supply account in the Division and handles an average of 12 tons of palletized supplies weekly, not including lumber, culvert and other Class IV items. Recently, because of Combat Contingency this organization was directed to invoice its only operable TL-16 loader to another organization leaving this organization with virtually no means to handle its receipt of routine supplies.
