INTELLIGENCE

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A. INTELLIGENCE

1. Background investigations requested for eight personnel for the Atomic Demolition Munitions Program submitted for last month returned disapproved. All errors and corrections are being considered and will be corrected and resubmitted.

2. A total of seventeen (17) mine and booby trap reports were received during the month of January. A total of 5 for the Kentucky AO, 1 for the Mai Loc AO, 7 for the Marshall Mountain AO, 1 for the Dawson River AO, and 2 for the Quang Tri Combat Base AO. Eleven (11) mine and booby traps were found by the 3d Engineer Battalion and reported in the Weekly Summary Report.

Agent reports continue to indicate the enemy intention of initiating a Spring offensive while caches found indicate that his resources are at a high level.

3. Seven Fire Support Bases were completed during this month. They were: FSB RAZOR, FSB SMITH, FSB GEIGER, FSB CUNNINGHAM, FSB MAXWELL, FSB LIGHTNING, AND FSB POLO. A team was sent from 3d Engineer Battalion to renovate OP 950. The S-2 Officer was to head this team and upon completion of this renovation would return to his regular duties. The successful complementation of infantry tactical operations by the FSB's has generated a similar FSB program in the Southern I Corps Tactical Area.

4. Two semi-automatic carbines (CHICOM SKS) and one Bolt Action Rifle (USSR) were registered at Division G-2 Collections for War Trophies.

5. The outlook for Engineers is continued construction of FSB's and continued combat support of infantry operations with continued daily mine sweeps in their assigned areas.

c. Tunnel team employment:

1. The second platoon of Company "A", 3d Engineer Battalion, reinforced by 3d Engineer Battalion case tractor personnel, provided direct support to the 4th Marine Regiment in the development of Fire Support Neville located on hill 1103 at 77/575 from 7 December to 18 December.

2. Engineer Task Organization:

2nd Platoon, Company "A", 3d Engineer Battalion
 One heavy equipment operator, 3d Engineer Battalion (VCB)

3. The Engineer Mission Assigned:

a. Provide engineer support as required in the development of Fire Support Base Neville, develop a helicopter landing zone, six 105 gun positions and ammo storage pits.

To accomplish the assigned mission, 2nd Platoon (-) from Company "A" was charged with providing the required demolition support and the heavy equipment detachment of 3d Engineer Battalion located at Vandergrift Combat Base was tasked to provide a case 450 tractor and operator to be heli-lifted into job site when called for.

4. Major Items of Engineer Equipment Employed:

- a. Case 450 Tractor
- b. Four Chainsaws
- c. Infantry pioneer chest

5. Materials Expended (Demolitions)

- a. C-4 620 lbs.
- b. T.N.T. 700 lbs.
- c. Dynamite 1,800 lbs.
- d. 40lb. shape charges- 55 each
- e. 15 lb shape charges - 55 each
- f. 40 lb. cratering charges - 7 each
- g. Sections, bangalore torpedo - 100

6. Chronology (See Enclosure)

7. Engineer Observations:

a. The number of people sent initially to a Fire Support Base should be carefully screened to determine if they are really needed during the initial stage of construction. Blasting was slowed up a great deal trying to get people back a safe distance.

b. The weather was a problem in that on good days supplies were flown in in such quantities that the area became clogged and again delayed demolition work. Close coordination with the S-4 is essential in preventing gear from being flown in early or in excessive amounts.

8. Lessons Learned:

a. During the process of shifting people around to get them at a safe distance from the demo charges someone left an explosive device on the ground. When the charge was ignited this explosive device detonated sympathetically causing a grass fire which burned up 500 lbs. of dynamite and nearly 800 lbs. of line charge.

9. Recommendations:

a. That personnel be informed to take all their gear with them when moving away from demo work.

b. That the engineers take the time to insure that no LAW's or grenades are left near the demo charge that might detonate resulting in injuries or damage to equipment or supplies.

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CHRONOLOGY

7 Dec 68:

- 1400 Arrived on hill 1103 (827575) carrying 500 lbs. of demo. (300 lbs. C-4 and 200 lbs. TNT). The demo. was carried by hand with the assistance of personnel from C 1/4.
- 1410 Started to clear a LZ to accept external loads.
- 1600 An area 30'X50' has been cleared expending all of the demo. Order for more demo has been placed as well as for more hand tools.
- 1630 Setting in while waiting for re-supply.
- 1700 Set in and waiting for resupply but bad weather has set in.

8 Dec 68:

- 0630 No resupply because of bad weather.
- 0700 Starting to clear trees and brush by hand.
- 1530 Resupply has arrived. Received 2,500 lbs. C-4, 300 lbs TNT, 40-15 lb. shape charges, 3,000 ft. detcord, and 250 non-electric blasting caps. Cannot use demo until men and material are cleared from the area.
- 1700 Went to the top of the hill to clear brush for an upper LZ. Received 600 lbs. dynamite, and 1,000 lbs. of line charges.
- 1830 Cleared an area 15'X 10' by hand so that demo can be used on the upper LZ first thing in the morning.

9 Dec 68:

- 0630 Setting up charges to clear upper LZ.
- 1100 Upper LZ enlarged to 30'X 30' to receive external loads. Used 80 lbs. C-4, 218 lbs. line charge, 100 lbs. of dynamite, 1-15 lb. shape charge, 12-40 lb. shape charges. Received instructions to start work on gun pods.
- 1400 The charges were set and blown for the first gun pod. A fire was started that burned up 500 lbs. of dynamite and 782 lbs of line charge.
- 1800 Continued to blow area for gun pads. Cleared 15'X 40' using 4-40 lb shapes, and 200 lbs. of C-4.

10 Dec 68:

- 0630 Continued work while waiting for resupply.
- 0930 Resupply arrived with 210 electric blasting caps, 4 chain saws, 10 gallon gas, 5 gallon of oil, 2,000 detcord, firing reel and hell box.
- 1000 Started work on the upper LZ clearing away brush and trees using the chain saws.
- 1400 Received resupply of 1,100 lbs. TNT, 15-40 lb. shape charges, 1,584 lbs of C-4, 1,900 lbs of dynamite. Continued work on the upper LZ.
- 1830 Cleared an area 100'X 75' using 13 bangalore, 13- 40 lb. shape charges, 2-15lb. shape charges, 7-40 lb. cratering charges, 40 lbs. C-4, and 150 lbs of dynamite. The tractor operator arrived at FSB Neville but the weather closed in again before the case 450 could be delivered.

11 Dec 68: 0

- 0630 Again started working on the upper LZ.
- 0920 Tractor arrived at FSB Neville.
- 1025 Blade for the tractor arrived.
- 1400 The tractor finished one gun pad (105) then was deadlined with a faulty hydraulic line (left cylinder) and two holes in the fuel tank. Requests for a mechanic and replacement parts were made but weather conditions would not allow for there delivery.

1. SUPPLY SITUATION

a. Expendable items are being received at a faster rate by this organization when stock checks are made at FLSC-B. It has been found through these stock checks that items that have been back ordered are in fact in stock and available for issue to requesting units.

b. At the present time this battalion has a T/E of 35 mine detectors with no special allowance. The previous special allowance has been cancelled. Of the present 64 mine detectors held by this organization, 28 are on temporary loan to us from other units of this Division. Battalion Supply has been advised that a special allowance of mine detectors for this organization is being reviewed. Present operational commitments dictate a requirement for a special allowance of at least 35 mine detectors.

c. Water point chemicals for this battalion are in short supply to the point of becoming critical. The 3d Engineer Battalion's operational responsibility for producing potable water encompasses 7 water points throughout the 3d Marine Division's A.O., the largest water point being operated at Quang Tri Combat Base which produces over four million gallons of potable water per month. It is imperative that action be initiated to ensure closer liaison with supporting units at DaNang so that these chemicals be expeditiously routed to using units in the northern I Corps area.

d. Within the next two months 3d Engineer Battalion Supply will be losing the Supply Chief, Warehouse Chief, Formal Accounts Clerk and two administrative clerks. It is suggested that an early replacement be provided for the Supply Chief as this organization has one of the largest supply accounts in the Division.
