NARRATIVE SUMMARY

a. Intelligence Summary

- 1. Notable enemy contacts include a large scale enemy attack on C-1 on the 16-17 of June. Units from 1/2 Arvn and 3/3 Marines along with supporting units accounted for 124 enemy KIA during the engagement.
- 2. Operation Utah Mesa commenced with the mission of clearing the area around Kha Sanh. Through interrogation of POWs and captured documents, it has been confirmed that the 24th Regiment of the 304th NVA Division is infiltrating South Viet Nam along Route #9 from Laos. The AO consists of Army, Marine Corps and Arvn Forces.
- 3. Mining incidents along Route #9 included an ambush on 230825H June 1969 in which the sweep team encountered 5-7 command detonated Claymore mines covering a 100 meter area, resulting in 2 KIA and 9 WIA(E).
- 4. It is anticipated that the enemy will refrain from any major offensive until the withdrawal of the 9th Marine Regiment and Supporting UNITS.





B. OPERATIONS

c. Operations

1. General. During the month of June 1969, Company "A" (Rein), Company "B", and Company "C" remained in direct support of the 4th, 3rd, and 9th Marine Regiments respectively. One platoon of Company "C" is retrograded with 1st Battalion, 9th Marine Regiment. The remainder of the Battalion was in general support of the 3rd Marine Division.

2. General Combat Support.

a. A total of 1,178,670 meters of road were covered by 3d Engineer Battalion visual/deliberate route sweeps. The areas and units remain the same as reported in the May Chronology.

b. In addition, 3d Engineer Battalion units conducted sweeps for NMCB units in the Cam Lo area and for Marine infantry units on the old Camp Carrol access road and the Khe Gia bridge area on an "on Call" basis.

c. Company "A" performed the following General Construction:

(1) Consruction of seahut for D-1-4.

(2) Construction on bunker for water point at VCB.

(3) Construction of seahut for HQ 4th Marines.

(4) Supervised laying wire on signal hill.

(5) Cleared fields of fire at VCB.

d. Company "B" performed the following general construction:

- e. Engineer Support Company performed the following general construction:

- f. Recon team from operations section completed reconnaisance of FSB Shepard for the purpose of constructing a road from Shepard to Route 9.

3. Direct Combat Support.

(a) The 3d Engineer companies of the 3d Engineer Battalion continued to support the infantry regiments of the Division as reported in the May Command Chronology. During the month of June the Battalion participated in all major operations of the Third Marine Division to include Herkimer Mountain, Virginia Ridge, Utah Mesa, Cameron Falls.

(b) Company "A" completed the following work on Fire Support Bases:

c. logistics

- 1. During the month of June, 3d Engineer Battalion continued to conduct logicalic and service support operations from Quang Tri Combat Base. Companies "A" and "C" have also preformed support activities from Vandequel't combat base while Company "b" has been providing support from Dong-le combat base.
- 2. (3) 1.51 pumps were exchanged on the R&E program, (1) 5D-15, (3) Bath Units and (1) chain saw were coded off the Battalions records in the month of Jume. The Battalion received (1) 30KW Generator and (1) TD-15 during the past month
- 3. The Dattalion rater points produced 3,308,000 gallons of potable water in the month of kay while supporting the Division. The Battalion has (6) water points in operation at the present time.
- k_t . The Estalion has received a change of allowance on mine detectors. This command rates 89 detecting sets under the new allowance.

COMMUNICATIONS-ELECTRONICS

D. COMMAND CHRONOLOGY

- 1. This month the Communications section spent a considerable amount of time in the location and reconciliation of mine detectors and the associated records. A complete record has been completed and all detectors are accountable with their respective units.
- 2. The AN/MRC-83's allocated to this section were completed in operational and mechanical standards this month. Further deployment of this equipment is being planned for future operations.
- 3. The Communications section gave its first monthly radio procedure class to Engineer personnel this month. The Officers, Staff NCO's and subordinate members of the Support Company of 3rd Engineer Battalion received this class on 9 June 1969. This section continues its normal training of handling and using classified materials and regular operational and maintenance instruction within the section.

CIVIC ACTION

e, Civil Affairs

- 1. The Civil Affairs has gotten off to a good start this month. A total of 6 MEDCAPS have been held and will continue to be held twice a week, one at Ai Tu and one at Giang Hien. Materials have been supplied for the building of one well in each village. Also plans are being made to build a small dispensary in each village.
- 2. The drawing of the 3d Marine Division Childrens Hospital Raffle was held on Sunday, 22 June 1969 at the site of the new hospital. Total contributions turned in by the 3d Engineer Battalion was \$ 1407.00 for a per capita sales of \$ 1.94. Sgt. D. M. KLAUSMAN from H&S Company was one of the lucky winners of a Yashika camera.

PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

This Battalion operates on the Company level Administrative System. There are five Companies within the Battalion with the following present strength breakdowns: H&S Co: 123, Support Co: 217, & Co: 143, B Co 136, C Co: 129, giving the Battalion a total strength of 728, with an average non-effective rate of 80.

During the month of June 1969, there were a total of 56 PFC's promoted to the rank of LCPL, effective date being 27 June 1969 and the date being 1 June 1969. Also, there were a total of 37 LCPL's promoted to CPL, effective date was 12 June 1969 and the DOR was 1 June 1969. A total of 35 personnel were joined to this Battalion during June. A total of 31 transfers were effected with two (2) drops recorded: on an Honorable Discharge for immediate reenlistment and the other was a KTA.

- 8. Engineer Observations: Good co-operation between the infantry units and the engineering teams prevailed. Engineer performance for the operation was excellent. While on the operation, at grid XD 861354, south of the Sahn, 4 new plastic anti-tank mines were found around an enemy bunker complex. These mines, dark green in color and weighing about 20 pounds apiece, were unarmed and in no way booby trapped when found. The mines were completely plastic and had a green plastic carrying handle. The mine can be detonated by a round pressure plate on the top of the mine. The mine also has 2 holes in it for booby traps, I on the

top and 1 on the side of it. Writing on the bottom and inside of the mine was in a foreign language which looked like Chinesse or that type of script. One of the mines was sent to the 0-2 section of Regiment and another was kept by "C" Company, 3d Engineer Battalion for training purposes. The other two mines were blown by "C" Company engineers.

CHRONOLOUT

12 June 1969

Operation Utah Hees kicked off with the CP, Brave, Charlie, and Delta being helilifted from VCB about 0800. The CP and Delta Company were helilifted to FSB Cates while Brave and Charlie landed at XD988642, north east of FSB Cates and were to move to Cates in approx. five days. Engineers with A 1/9 were op-ecned to 4th Harines and were standing lines at FSB Sheppard. Engineers with the CP constructed two living howhes and rebuilt one field senatation unit (chitter) on FSB Cates, which took 26 mhs to scaplete. All other elements repoted negative work.

13 June, 1969

Engineers with A 1/9 used 1 lb. 0-6, 1 foot time fuse and 1 cap to blow one friendly claymore (with 200 feet of wire and 2 electric blasting caps attached), 150 K-60 rounds, and 2-60 mm mortar rounds. All other engineer teams had negative reports.

14 June 1969

Engineers with D 1/9, who are now moving toward Khe Salm, used 8 lbs. C-4, 2 feet time fuze and 2 caps to blow 1 IAAW, 5-60 mm morter rds, 1 N-26 grande and 1 tree for an IZ at XD 296406. The IZ was 100% complete. A total of 4 mhs were needed to blow the ordinance and help elear the IZ. A 1/9 left the op-com of the 4th Marines and started moving from FSB Shappard to Khe Salm. All other teams had negative work.

15 June 1969

Engineers with C 1/9 used 7g lbs. C-4, 1 cap, and 1 foot time fuse to blow two trees for an LZ near FSB Cates. All other engineer teams had magazine work.

16 June 1969

ingineers with D 1/9, using Army mine sweeping gear, sweet route 9 from IZ Hawk to the trail junction at XD 923406. This weep was to prepare the way for Army Armour Units coming to Khe Sahn on Route 9. The sweep took 6 mhs to complete. From this date to the end of the operation D 1/9 was under the Army's epecin. All other engineer teams reported negative work.

17 June 1969

The CP, Bravo and Charlie Companys were helilifted from FSB Cates to Khe Sahn where they were joined with Alpha, who had humped there from FSB Sheppard. Wegative work was reported from all engineer elements.

C-4, 2 feet time fuse and 2 caps to blow 6 Chi-Coms, 1 RFD round, 1-82 mm mortar round, 5 fuses for 82 mm mortar rounds and two plastic anti-tank mines. Engineers with C 1/9 used 3 lbs. of C-4, 1 cap and two feet time fuse to blow 4 LAAMS, and 2 M-26 granades.

23 June 1969

The CP with all 1/9 letter companies were helilifted from the Khe Sahn area back to VCB to end its portion of the operation.

- 8. Engineers of 2nd Plt., "C" Company were notified two days before operation Cameron Falls began. There was no visual reson since no new FSB was echeduled to be built.

Artillery personnel requested a Case 560 Backhee to be used in the re-opening of FSB Whismain, they were advised against it by #0# Osmpany engineer persojnel but they insisted on it and the 560 was sent to FSB Whisman. It proved unsatisfactory and was ultimately replaced by the Case 450 tractor, which finished the job very well.

When the move to FSB Henderson was made, the engineers were notified one day in advance. Coordination was effected and a Case 450, accompanied by the #0* Co. XO, w.s heli-lifted to FSB Henderson just prior to the time the 2/9 GP moved from FSB Whisman. There was a lack of coordination here in that almost immediately after the tractor started work, so many externals came in around the work site that the tractor had difficiulty maneuvering and the use of demo was greatly hindered.

The demo team with H 2/9 and E 2/9 encountered a type of greade not previously seen. This was the Hungarian manufactured confuscion greade. This greade was approximately in long and 3% in diameter with a 5% wooden headle. Refer to enclosure (2) for drawing. It was dark green or black in odler with 3 crange bands. There is a safety pin in the center and a safety disk in the bettom of the handle. The striker, with 2 small springs is located in the bottom of the handle. The blasting cap is very large - approx. 2% long and 2% in diameter. The greenede has a 5 to 6 second delay and is detonated by first pulling the pin in the handle and then tapping the greenede against a hard object, activating the striker. A great number of the greenedes were improperly activated by the NVA and failed to detonate. Most of the dude were found with the safety disk intact. Another feature was the presence of threads in the top and bettem, enabling the NVA to sorre several together for greater effect.

The engineers contribution to the operation consisted mainly of blowing captured ordanance and rebuilding two FSB's, thereby allowing employment of the artillarry battery to provide fire support to the infantry units.

9. Lessons Learned: None

10. Recommendations: Deprimation is possibly the most important part of rebuilding an FSB. For this reason, I believe that one man, be it artillery, infantry or engineer should be placed in over all sometral of the project, to include priority movement of resupply etc. The MOS is not as important as centralized control.
