## A. INTELLIGENCE

1. Enemy initiated activity ran considerably lower during the month of July as compared with recent months. Much of the cause of the decrease in enemy activity is believed to be as of a direct result of the redeployment of the 9th Marine Regiment. The redeployment has given the enemy opportunity for increased freedom of movement within the Division AO.
2. The enemy forces in Base Area 101 increased with the confirmation of the K-34 Artillery Battalion. These forces now consist of an infantry regiment equivalent supported by two artillery and one sapper battalion. Captured documents indicated food and supply shortages.
3. On the 19th of July, 3d Battalion/2nd ARVN regiment uncovered a major enemy ordnance cache in the Dakrong Valley. The location of this appears to be of particular significance in that it was found within one kilometer of a trail which connects the Dakrong and BaLong Valleys. It is possible that this constitutes a main supply route employed by the enemy in transporting supplies from Laos and North Vietnam through western Quang Tri to the ultimate users in Base Area 101 and the coastal lowlands of Quang Tri and the Thua Thien Province.
4. At 210800H, Battalion Sweep Team 302 was ambushed by an estimated 20-30 NVA using AK-47's and chicom grenades resulting in 2 KIA and 2 WIA from the engineer sweep team.

C. OPERATIONS

1. General. During the month of July 1969 Company "A" and Company "B" remained in direct support of the 4th and 3d Marine Regiments respectively as reported in the June Chronology. Company "C" remained in direct support of the 9th Marine Regiment until 23 July 1969 when the company "stood down" and commenced preparations for embarkation to Okinawa with the 9th RLT. On 31 July 1969 Company "C" embarked aboard ship at the port facility at Cua Viet, RVN. During the month of July the Engineer Support Company and Headquarters & Service Company remained in general support of the Division.

2. General Combat Support

a. A total of 1,337,600 meters of road were covered by 3d Engineer Battalion visual/deliberate route sweeps. The designation of sweeps changed during July as indicated below:

b. In addition, 3d Engineer Battalion sweep teams conducted special sweeps for NMGB units repairing Route #9 in the Ka Ghia Bridge/Camp Elliott area.

c. The following general support projects were completed during July 1969:

(1) Paneling of office buildings, construction of TSFC bunkers and dive bunkers for FLSG-B (Engr Spt Co)

(2) Construction of a 15' high water tower for the FLSG-B ice plant (Engr Spt Co)

(3) Repair and upgrading of Route #561 from Cam Lo to Con Thien (Co "B")

(4) Installation of a power distribution system to include wiring, utility poles, and generator shed at the Cua Viet R&R center (Engr Spt Co)

(5) Construction of concrete slab for Vandegrift water point #2 (Co "A")

(6) Construction of a 145 meter road into the Kit Carson School area in Quang Tri City (Engr Spt Co)

(7) Dust suppression continued in the QTCB area on internal road nets, and Elliott Combat Base roads and the Cam Lo District Headquarters compound had dust suppression applied. (Engr Spt Co).

3. Direct Combat Support

a. During the month of July the Battalion participated in all major operations of the 3d Marine Division to include Herkimer Mountain, Utah Mesa, Williams Glade, Georgia Tar, Arlington Canyon, and Idaho Canyon.

b. Ordnance destroyed is indicated in the Supporting Documents section of this Chronology.

c. The following work was performed on Fire Support Bases:

(1) Work continued on FSB Cates as reported in the June Chronology. All engineer personnel with the exception of a 6 man detachment have departed the position. The remaining engineer personnel will supervise the sand bagging of bunkers, drainage improvements, and perform minor maintenance and repair work.

(2) During the week of 13 July the 4th Marine Regiment re-entered FSB Sandy. Engineers from Company "A" cleared fields of fire and rebuilt ammunition berms.

(3) Company "A" constructed 6-105 pits on FSB Biddle from 7-12 July 1969.

(4) Improvements on FSB Fuller began 1 July. Company "B" installed a counter mortar facility, 2 culvert trash chutes, and leveled the western knoll constructing 4-10'x24' ammunition bunkers and an external resupply LZ for ammunition.

d. Direct support construction projects for the month of July:

- (1) Rebuild 4th Marine Regiment COC bunker (Co "A")
- (2) Fill, grade, level new billeting and motor transport area for Battalion 3/4 at Vandegrift Combat Base (Co "A")

- (5) Construction of concrete slab and sea hut for 4th Marine Regiment
- (6) Construction of fighting trenches and bunker blast walls at Con Thien (Co "B")
- (7) Electrical distribution system for 3d Marine Regiment at Elliott Combat Base (Co "B")

4. Field Fortifications. In addition to those bunkers constructed on Fire Support Bases, the 3d Engineer Battalion continued to assist 3d Marine Division units with materials and supervisory personnel in the construction and improvement<sup>ment</sup> of wire entanglements and bunkers.

## c. Logistics

1. During the month of July, 3d Engineer Battalion continued to conduct logistic and service support operations from Quang Tri Combat Base. Company "C" has gone on Float to support RLT-9 and is operating as part of RLT-9 and is not under the operational control of this organization.
2. (1) 20kw Generator (3) Bath Units (1) M60 Crane (3) TD-15 Tractor (1) MRS-100 Tractor (1) 550 Grader (5) Eimco M64 Tractors (1) 105 Air Compressor and (5) M51 Dump Trucks were sent out with RLT-9.
3. The Battalion water points produced 3,067,000 gallons of potable water in the month of July while supporting the Division. The Battalion has (5) water points in operation at the present time.
4. The Battalion has received a change of allowance on Case 450 Tractors. This command now rates (6) Case 450 Crawler tractors.

CHRONOLOGY

2 July 1969

Operation Utah Mesa Kicked off with the CP, Fox, Golf and Hotel being heli-lifted from VCB about 0700 to FSB Sparks. Golf Company moved about 1800 meters south of FSB Sparks while Fox Company moved about 1500 meters north of FSB Sparks. The 2nd Battalion, 9th Marines were Op-con to Task Force Guadalcanal, 1st Brigade, 5th Mec., USA. Engineers with Hotel cut one barrell in half for a shitter. They used 4 blasting caps, 2 feet time fuze, 2 agents and 2/3 man hours. Engineers with the CP team completed 50% of an ammo burm with one Case 450 tractor and 3 machine hours. All other teams had negative work

3 July 1969

Engineers with the CP team finished the 50% completed ammo burm from the day before and six more ammo burms, size 25' x 7' x 6'. They used one Case 450 tractor for five machine hours. Hotel engineers destroyed one bangalore torpedo containing 18 lbs. TNT, 26 Chi-Coms grenades, 1 - RPG 2, 3 Rifle Grenades. They used 2½ lbs. C-4, 1 cap, 2 agents and one man hour. Engineers with Hotel blew two trash pits, size 12' x 8' x 8', using two 40 lb. shape charges, two 40 lb. cratering charges, 4 caps and two feet time fuze with 2 agents and one man hour.

4 July 1969

Engineers with Hotel destroyed 2 Rifle Grenades and 4 Chi-Coms using 1 lb. C-4, 1 cap, 1 foot time fuze, two agents and ½ man hour.

5 July 1969

Golf engineers destroyed three bunkers, size 8' x 6' x 5' A frame type, 10 large Chi-Coms (unknown use), 42 frag Chi-Coms, 30 concussion Chi-Coms, 17 AK-47 mags, 42 rifle grenades, 2 NVA helmets, 17 gas masks, 9 gas mask canisters, 2 bangalore torpedoes containing 50 lbs. TNT each, 5 bottles pills unknown use, 10 blocks dry chow, size 6" x 4" x 1", 20 pair rubber slippers, 100 lbs. assorted clothing, 6 NVA blasting caps, 62 lbs. TNT, 2 mortar tube sights with leveling bubble, 2,000 AK-47 rounds (7.62mm), 3 machetts, 5,000 feet comm. wire and 8 NVA packs. They used 3 lbs. C-4, 4 blasting caps, 3 boosters, 6 feet time fuze, 4 agents and 2 man hours.

6 July 1969

Engineers with Hotel destroyed one frag Chi-Com and one concussion Chi-Com. They used ½ lb. C-4, 1 blasting cap, 1 foot time fuze, 2 agents and ½ man hour. Engineers with CP, Fox, Golf, and Hotel were heli-lifted from the FSB Sparks area to VCB to terminate their part of the operation.

8. Engineer Observations: Coordination throughout the operation was excellent; each team traveled with the company CP on company movements. However, on various occasions two men in the team would travel with the last platoon in order to destroy ordnance. One dead NVA had charts which gave a detailed description of our M49A1 (trip flare), M2 series (bouncing betty), M18A1 (claymore), and the M6A2 (medium anti-tank mine). The chart had color diagrams of each one and the various component parts named.

The companies used the engineers throughout the operation. The engineers were taken on every platoon size patrol due to the extensive bunker complex of 3,000 bunkers that they patrolled.

9. Lessons Learned: The NVA, on trails that are booby trapped, placed little white plastic balls in the immediate vicinity of the traps. They also mark trees with red paint near trap locations. Engineer teams travelled with the point squad and marked trap position with 3" white tape describing the traps and thus permitted safe passage of the following units.

10. Recommendations: The company commanders don't usually concern themselves with their basic allowance of demolitions. It is up to the team leaders to make sure the company has an ample supply. Communications between teams and the platoon CP can be done easily if the team leader uses radio, usually air or arty, some non-tactical net, and comes up on our company push rather than sending his line message thru the infantry battalion. This facilitates the job of passing the word and any questions can be answered. The Company Commanders had nothing but praise for the engineer teams attached to them. PFC Brooks and PFC Hudson were put up for the Bronze Star. ~~Both are more than deserving of this award and I hope the Battalion makes sure they receive it.~~

24 June 1969

3/9 relieved the 1st Battalion, 9th Marines of Operation Utah Mesa today. India Company went op-con to the army and stayed so on through out the operation. India blew 10 LAAWS, 23M-79 rounds, 2 M-26 grenades, 300 5.56 rounds, 1500-7.62 rounds, using 20 lbs. C-4, 2 caps and 5 feet time fuze. All other teams did negative work. Kilo 3/9 had contact with the NVA; PFC Brooks and PFC Hudson were recommended for the Bronze Star. Our grid for today was XD 878369.

25 June 1969

Engineers with Lima 3/9 used 10 lbs. C-4, 2 caps and 5 feet time fuze to blow 32 LAAWS, 117 M-79 rounds, 600 M-60 rounds, 1100 M-16 rounds, 45 M-26 grenades, 5 smoke grenades, 5-60mm rounds, 1 claymore. All other engineer teams reported negative work. All companies danced to new pos and our present grid is XD 878349.

26 June 1969

PFC Hudson was medevaced today for FUIO. Engineers with India 3/9 used 3 lbs. C-3, 1 cap, and 1 foot time fuze to blow 1 M-72 component to the fire cracker round. Engineers with Lima and Kilo reported negative work, and engineers with Mike had negative report.

27 June 1969

All companies danced to new positions. Kilo 3/9 used 11 lbs. TNT, 2 caps and 5 feet time fuze to blow 30 RPG rounds, 7 M-79 rounds, 32 Chi-Coms, 225 Ak and SKS rounds, and 2 LAAWS. Lima, Mike and India reported negative work. Our present position is grid XD 877335.

28 June 1969

Arrived at pos where we found 750 lb. bomb. Notified 3/9 Alpha Command to call for EOD. All other teams reported negative work. We are presently located at grid XD 868320.

29 June 1969

Engineers from Lima used 1 lb C-4, 2 caps and 2 feet time fuze to blow 1 LAAW. EOD reported to our pos, Alpha Command, to disarm 750 lb. bomb. India, Kilo and Mike reported negative work.

30 June 1969

All companies moved to new positions. Engineers with Kilo 3/9 blew 750 lb. bomb upon leaving pos. They used 13 lbs. C-4, 3 caps and 75 feet time fuze. All other companies had negative work. PFC Harrison was medevaced from Lima for severe headaches.

1 July 1969

Kilo 3/9 ran two patrols with 4 engineers in each one. They found and extensive

C-3, 4 caps, and 6 feet time fuze to destroy 1 A Frame bunker, 8' x 6' x 3' and 19 RPG rounds, 6 packs, 20 RPG boosters, 9 rifle grenades, 78 Chi-Coms, 400 machine gun rounds, 1-61 mm round, 7 hamocks, 9 ponchos, 1 pair hair clippers, 3 E tools, 9 gas masks, 20 pair trousers, 20 shirts, 30 lbs. rice, 2 AK-47 rifles, 4 helmets, 6 AK-47 magazines, 3 pair boots, 1 NVA compass, 1-57mm recoilless rifle round, 230-50 cal. NVA rounds. This was blown after all the intelligence information was extracted. Our present grid is XD 864309.

2 July 1969

All companies moved to new positions. Engineers with Kilo used 4 lbs. C-4, 2 caps, 10 feet time fuze, and 1000 feet det cord to destroy: 1 RPG booster, 18 Chi-Coms, 10 RPG rounds, 60-60mm rounds, 6 claymores, 2 rifle grenades, 250-50 cal. rounds, 8 packs, 70 lbs. rice, 20 trousers, 4 hamocks, 148-81mm WP rounds.

3 July 1969

Kilo 3/9 and Mike 3/9 sent out patrols with 4 engineers in each one. Mike engr's. used 20 lbs. C-4, 2 caps, and 2 feet time fuze to destroy 6 boxes of NVA 50 cal. rounds, 5-82mm rounds, 5-61mm rounds, 2 RPG rounds, 1 gas mask, 6 gas mask canisters, and 1 booby trapped M-16 rifle. Kilo's engineers used 5 lbs. C-4, 2 feet time fuze, and 2 caps to blow: 1 plastic anti-tank mine, 2 Chi-Coms, and 1-61 mm round. Our present grid is XD 853309

4 July 1969

The CP team made an LZ, 75' x 25'. Engineers with Mike 3/9 used 1 lb. C-4, 1 cap and 1 foot time fuze to destroy one booby trapped M-16 rifle.

5 July 1969

Lima's engineers used 2½ lbs. C-4, 1 cap and 4 feet time fuze to 6 M-26 grenades, 18 M-79 rounds, and 3 LAAWS. Mike 3/9 engineers built a LZ, 200' x 150', using 5 lbs. C-4, 4 caps and 4 feet time fuze.

6 July 1969

All engineer teams reported negative work

7 July 1969

Lima 3/9 engineers used 3 lbs. C-4, 2 caps, and 3 feet time fuze to destroy 2-81 mm rounds, 2 Chi-Coms. All teams came back to VCB with the exception of India who is still op-con to the Army at FSB Sapper.

c. Significant Problem Areas. The major problem confronting this unit on chain saws is that there is a high percentage that are deadlined for the repair parts outlined in paragraph 10b.
