



COMMANDERS NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

On the 9th of July, Armed Forces Police provided special escorts for Mr. Robert McNAMARA, the Secretary of Defense, and his entourage. The following day another special escort was provided for General WHEELER, Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, Col. GIBSON, PM, MACV, Saigon visited Armed Forces Police and was briefed on overall operations and mission with the I Corps Area on 11 July. Civil Affairs operating in the village of Thach Nham, began construction of additional Classroom space for the hamlet school. On 14 July construction was begun on the first two (2) concrete wells and on 21 July the second two (2) wells were begun. On the 24th of July the first two (2) wells were completed and a dedication ceremony was held which was attended by the Battalion Commanding Officer, LtCol C. H. SULLIVAN, the Battalion Executive Officer, Major C. C. GIFFORD, JR., the S-5 Officer 2ndLt A. C. NELSON and the village chief. The MEDCAP Program in the village treated 506 people for the month of July. The prisoner strength for the month of July hit an all time high of 204. The month of July saw an average POW strength of 199. 1stLt J. W. PERRINE was assigned duties as Battalion S-3, vice Capt. D. G. KRAVITZ who was relieved. On 31 July a change of Command Ceremony was held relieving Capt M. W. WYDO as Commanding Officer of "D" Company and Capt D. G. KRAVITZ assumed command on 1 August. Security Forces in the DaNang TAOR have only made limited enemy contact with no friendly casualties incurred.
