COMMANDERS NARATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Throughout the month of January Special Escorts were provided for General CUSHMAN, General CHAPMAN, General MURRAY, General OLSEN and Admiral LACY. A Special Escort was also provided for Senator KENNEDY. A Special Escort was provided for Mrs. CALDWELL throughout the month.

Cement was delivered by Chaplin NICHOLS to the Catholic Church in Thach Nham. Major D. E. MILONE, USMC, attended the TET celebration at Thach Nham. Due to the increase in enemy activity, the Battalion went on 100% alert several times this month. The Airfield was rocketed on four (4) different nights. Reaction Forces were dispatched to downtown DaNang to counter any and all terrorist activities.

The MEDCAP Program treated a total of 498 people, only one (1) was hospitalized. Chaplin NICHOLS held services every Sunday at Thach Nham. The prisoner strength at III MAF Brig was 206, an increase of twenty-one (21) over the month of December. The average weekly detained strength in III MAF Detention Facility was 109.
