

#### COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of May special escorts were provided for General CUSEMAN on three (3) occasions. The average weekly strength of the III MAF Detention Facility was one hundred and fifty eight (158). The III MAF Brig had an average prisoner strength of two hundred and forty-two (242) for the month of May. Visits to the III MAF Detention Facility were made

by Pajer HAMMASER, HQ, MACV and Mr. WILLIAMS, GS-12, from the Army Picture Service. The Civic Action Team distributed 600 pounds of clothing, ninety (90) pounds of scap and seven (7) pieces of tin to the hamlets of Thach Nham, Hoa Khuong and Phouc Thuan. The Med Cap Team treated a total of four hundred and forty-three (443) people, of these only five (5) were hospitalized. Chaplain NICHOLS conducted services every Sunday at the Catholic Church in the hamlet of Thach Nham. The Armed Propaganda Team in the hamlet of Thach Hnam provided valuable information as to the VC working in the area.

- f. 14 May Combined Police Coordinating Committee, made up of Police representatives from various Military and Civilian Police Agencies in DaNang, RVN, met to discuss joint law enforcement problems.
- g. 17 May 10 lbs of soap were distributed to hamlet of Hoa Khuong.
- h. 20 May 10 lbs of soap and seven (7) sheets of tin were distributed to hamlet of Thach Nham.
- i. 21 May A two (2) vehicle, four (4) man special escort was provided for General CUSHMAN.
- j. 23 May Visits by Maj HAMMASER, HQ MACV, and Mr. WILLIAMS, GS-12, Army Picture Service, of the III MAF Detention Facility.

Capt H.L. CURRIE assumed duties as Battalion S-3. 2ndLt L.F. ANDERSON assumed command of "B" Company.
