COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of June 120 lbs of oats, 5 lbs of soap, 6 boxes of chalk 600 lbs of lumber, 39 sheets of tin were given to the hamlet of Hoa Khuong. The tin and lumber were for the new school being built. 2000 lbs of lumber was given to the hamlet of Phuoc Thuan. The Armed Propaganda Team (APT) in the hamlet of Thach Nham turned in valuable information about VC in the area. The Battalion Chaplain, Lt NICHOLS, held services every Sunday and holiday in the Catholic Church in Thach Nham. The MEDCAP Program had a total of 361 people treated, of this only 1 had to be hospitalized. The average prisoner strength in the III MAF Brig was 260 for the month of June. The average monthly strength for POW's in the III MAF Detention Facility was 158. Visits and or inspections of the facility were held by Colonel GIBSON MACVJ-15, Col BRANDENBURG MACVJ15, LtCol OSSOREO MACVJ-15. Brigadier General WILLIAMS of III MAF also visited the Detention Facility. One hundred (100) Vietnamese children were escorted to the beach for lunch and recreation by Delta Company. The regular meeting of the Combined Police Coordinating Committee was held during the month of June. Twelve (12) special escorts were provided for general officers.
