

COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of August building materials and supplies were delivered to the hamlets of THACH NHAM, HOA KHUONG and PHUOC THUAN in the following quantities, food 250 lbs, clothing 475 obs, soap, 155 lbs, building materials, 2 tons, school kits, 150 kits. MedCap total attendance for the month was 302. One woman was taken to DaNang Hospital for surgery. Escorts were provided for General TOMPKINS, General CUSHMAN, General CHAPMAN, LtGen MILDREN, General ABRAMS, President THIEU, General OLSON and Major General YOUNG. Two meetings of the Combined Rolice Coordinating Committee were held during the month of August. The average monthly strength in the III MAF Brig was 275. A disturbance was experienced in the III MAF Brig from 16 to 18 August, order was restored without serious injury to personnel or prisoners. Average weekly strength of the III MAF Detention Facility for August was 127. Visits to the III MAF Detention Facility were made by Major General PRECHER USMCR, Brigadier General OLSON USMC, Col POND USMC, Lieutenant Colonel IRWIN USA, Major CHERRY USA, Mr. HAUSER and Doctor HAAN M.D. of ICEC. Sgt J. R. CONWAY 2078991. WIA DaNang RVN, Sgt A. T. ANDERSON 2249038, WIA, Con Thien RVN. On August 23, two (2) reaction forces from 3dMPBn were committed into action against NVA Forces at Cam Le Bridge, DaNang RWN, these platoon size reaction forces were combined with a company of ARVN Rangers, one Marine Company (K/3/7), a recon company (Company A 1st Recon Bn), one platoon of ontos and an ARVN company of armored personnel carriers. The entire force was commanded by the Commanding Officer of 3d MPBn, LtCol J. GAMBARDELLA. The allied force engaged an enemy force of estimated Battalion size and killed approximately one hundred (100) of the enemy. The following losses were incurred by this command. Cpl R. D. 


