



COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of September eighteen (18) tons of lumber were donated to the hamlets of THACH NHAM, HOA KHUONG, PHUOC THUAN. A hot dog reast was held for the hamlet of THACH NHAM with two hundred and fifty (250) people attending. A Vietnamese orientation program for officers and staff was set up whereby they attended a MedCap at a local village. The total attendance for MedCap was two hundred and fifty seven (257), with two persons being hospitalized. The average prisoner strength in the III MAF Brig for the month of September was two hundred and twenty six (226). The III MAF Brig was visited by General OLSON, Commanding General, Force Logistic Command, General BUE Commanding General, FMFPac and General CU SHMAN Commanding General, III MAF. Escorts were provided by Armed Forces Police for the following, Ceneral OLSON, Admiral in Charge of NSA, General CUSHMAN, General TOMPKINS, Admiral OSBORN and Col CARRACIN. Two meetings of the Combined Police Coordinating Committee were held during September. The average weekly strength in the III MAF Detention Facility was and hundred and twenty six (126). Visits to the III MAF Detention Facility were made by the following, Col BELOWS III MAF, Misters RICHARDS and BRINTON of the Quaker Society, LtCol DOWD III MAF and Col SKOTNICKE III MAF. The following WIAs occured during September, LCpl J. R. DAVIS 2355075, Quang Nam Province, Cpl M. F. HOOK 2172315, Quang Nam Province and LCpl H. H. THOMAS III 2333216 Quang Nam Province. The hamlet chief and his assist nt were abducted by the Viet Cong from the hamlet of PHUOC THUA". HN GARRISH H116456 change status from WIA to KIA.
