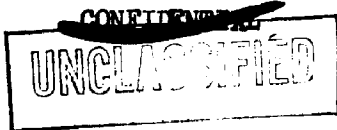

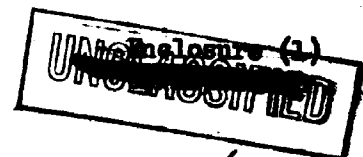

~~CONFIDENTIAL~~COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of October the average monthly strength in the III MAF Brig was 212. The average weekly strength in the III MAF Detention Facility was 121. Visits to the III MAF Detention Facility were made by Col BELOW III MAF, Col RADCLIFFE III MAF, Brigadier Generals OLSON and FEELEY, FLC, Maj TOMLINSON XXIV Corps, Capt FERNANDEZ XXIV Corps, Col HURROUGHS III MAF and Col JOENS III MAF. MEDCAP total attendance for the month of October was 151. Escorts were provided for General RASMUSSEN, General CUSHMAN and General TOMPKINS. Two meetings of the combined police coordinating committee were held during October. On October 29, a search and clear operation was held in coordination with 1st Military Police Battalion, Kilo 3/1, ARVN Rangers and National Police in East DaNang (BT070820) resulting in capture of 1 VC (confirmed) and two (2) VCS. Sgt J. A. YOUNG 1861836, WIA shrapnel wounds in back, legs and right arm, Quan Hieu Nhon Province, 25 October 1968. LtCol W. E. CHEATHAM assumes command of 3d Military Police Battalion on 22 October 1968.
