COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of January the average monthly strength in the III MAF Brig was 264. The average monthly strength for the III MAF Detention Facility was 91. Med Caps were held in the hamlets of Thach Nam, Hoa-Khuong, and Phouc Thuan. The total attendance for the month was 186. Armed Forces Police, in coordination with the Vietnamese Folice, issued 2003 citations as compared to 193 for the Month of January 1968. The lowest accident rate of 74 for the month of January 1969 was also recorded. This was the lowest in the past 13 months.
