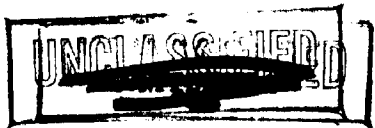

COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of January the average monthly strength in the III MAF Brig was 264. The average monthly strength for the III MAF Detention Facility was 91. Med Caps were held in the hamlets of Thach Nam, Hoa Khuong, and Phouc Thuan. The total attendance for the month was 186. Armed Forces Police, in coordination with the Vietnamese Police, issued 2003 citations as compared to 193 for the Month of January 1968. The lowest accident rate of 74 for the month of January 1969 was also recorded. This was the lowest in the past 13 months. Escorts were provided for Ambassador COLBY, Gen CUSHMAN, Gen YOUNGDALE and Gen STILWELL. Two detainees escaped from the III MAF Detention Facility. One was fatally wounded and the other wounded and apprehended. Cpl Louis S. INDELL, 2082154, WIA, Quang Nam Province, 12 Jan 1969. LCpl Robert D. ARMSTRONG, 2370691, KIA, Quang Nam Province, 16 Jan 1969. Sgt Wilbur A. AUSTIN, 2252103, WIA, Quang Nam Province, 26 Jan 1969. Cpl Robert E. WATSON, 2326818, WIA, Quang Nam Province, 22 Jan 1969. Cpl Robert J. QUELLOS, 2263800, WIA, Quang Nam Province, 30 Jan 1969. 2ndLt PFELFFER, 0105616, WIA, Quang Nam Province, 19 Jan 1969. All of the above, with the exception of 2ndLt PFELFFER, at the time of their injury, were serving in the capacity of either a Scout or Sentry Dog Handler attached to Marine Units throughout I Corps.
