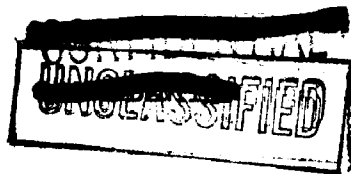

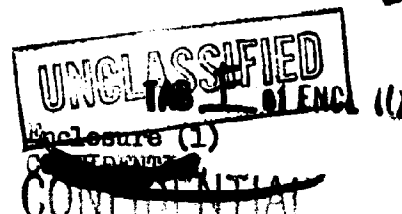

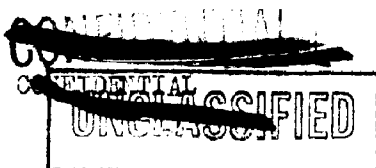

COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of December the average monthly strength in the III MAF Detention Facility was 19. The average monthly strength in the III MAF Brig was 240. Med Caps were provided twice a week in the Hamlets of Thach Nham and Nghi An. Total attendance for the month of December was 819. Medications and immunizations were given to the ill, and the weekly Dent Cap treated 13 patients. Armed Forces Police continued to fulfill its mission of providing Law Enforcement in Danang, RVN, and security for I Corps Advisory Facilities during the month of December. The Combined Narcotics Team conducted thirteen (13) operations which resulted in the confiscation of 9,806 marijuana cigarettes, 5 kilograms of bulk marijuana, 1,159 grams of opium, 159 Binocet tablets, 11 quarts of Obesitol, 3.75 grams of morphine, assorted opium smoking apparatus, 4 MACV Ration Cards and \$86.05 in MPC. An escort was provided for Major General G. S. BOWMAN Jr. LCpl H. F. DORR, 2543847, WIA, Quang Nam Province, RVN, 7 December 1969. LCpl C. W. SHORT, 2489909, WIA, Quang Nam Province, RVN, 11 December 1969. Both LCpl H. F. DORR, 2543847, and LCpl C. W. SHORT, 2489909, received their injuries while serving in the capacity of Scout Dog Handlers attached to USMC units throughout I Corps. Armed Forces Police personnel were provided throughout the City of Danang, RVN, as security for the arrival of Vice President KY on 24 December 1969. On 25 December 1969, the 3d Military Police Battalion provided security and traffic control in support of "Operation Holly" (Bob Hope Show).
