4. Average menthly strength:

a. Third Motor Transport Battalien, 14 Officers and 250 Enlisted personnel. Ten (10) U. S. Navy Enlisted. Attached: Company "C",, 1st Motor Transport Battalion, three (3) Officers and 71 Enlisted. One (1) U. S. Navy Enlisted. Company "A" (-), 1stMTBn (Unk) Officers and (Unk) Enlisted. (Unk) U. S. Navy Enlisted.

5. Personnel.

a. Division initiated an early rotation program for the month of April, May and June. This helped level out the spread of RTD's for three months in commection with the Battalion program.

6. Administration. None

7. Training:

a. An-operator training and first echelon maintenance course for the M-76 Otter was conducted during the period 19 - 21 January 1966. Twelve personnel were licensed to operate this vehicle.

8. Operations:

a. A detachment of 3d Motor Transport Battalion is participating in operatien " Double Eagle" with other personnel and equipment (etc.) Truck Company plus Otters) on standby.

9. Civil Affairs:

- a. The medical Contact team of this command dispenced a total of 1982 medical treatments in the Hea-Khanh hamlet complex. Emergency medical assistance was rendered to three Vietnamese nationals one of whom was evacuated to the civilian hospital, Da Nang. Ceneral health and cleanliness of the village continued to improve tremendously.
- b. A total of 400 pounds of asserted foodstuffs, 100 pounds of candy, 2000 bars of soan and \$2,000.00 worth of toys were distributed to an estimated 3000 contacts in Hoa-Khanh, Dong Phouc hamlet complex, USOM hospital Dououg, relocation center at Le-My, and the Orphanage at Le-My.
- c. The 14 year eld girl "Adepted" by this command in November will seen be ready to be returned to her village in Quang-Tin prevince. Her wounds are healing well and she should be walking again in the very near future.
- d. Continued emphasis is being placed on the expeditious and efficient handling of civilian claims. A total of three claims were processed during this reporting period and there are currently no outstanding claims.
