### 9. Civil Affairs.

- a. During the month of May the Battalion Medical Team treated 5,080 patients at the hamlets of Dong-Phuoc and Dong-Bau. Scap distribution to the two hamlets amounted to 2,888 bars during the month.
- b. Thirty sections of 36" dismeter galvanised culvert were donated and delivered to the hamlet of Dong-Bau for the construction of a community well at the school. Eight truck loads of scrap lumber were denated and delivered to the hamlet of Dong-Phuce for community projects and fire wood. Efforts are also underway to obtain sufficient lumber for the addition of two rooms to the hamlet school. In addition the following items were donated and delivered to the two hamlets during the month.
