9. Civil Affairs.

a. During the month of May the Battalion Medical Team treated 3,060 patients at the hamlets of Dong-Phuoc and Dong-Bau. Soap distribution to the two hamlets amounted to 2,888 bars during the month.

b. Thirty sections of 36" diameter galvanized culvert were donated and delivered to the hamlet of Dong-Bau for the construction of a community well at the school. Eight truck loads of scrap lumber were donated and delivered to the hamlet of Dong-Phuoc for community projects and fire wood. Efforts are also underway to obtain sufficient lumber for the addition of two rooms to the hamlet school. In addition the following items were donated and delivered to the two hamlets during the month.



c. A donation of \$30.00 for Vietnamese Orphans was received from Mr. Ken MORRIS of Peoria, Illinois. This sum plus \$10.00 donated by the Battalion was converted into 4,720 piasters and delivered to the Da Nang Orphanage along with other small gifts.

d. Continued emphasis is being placed on expediting the settlement of foreign claims. Four claims arose during the month as a result of minor traffic accidents and they are presently being processed.
