

### HARRATIVE SUPMARY

During the reporting period, the Battalion remained deployed, in the three separate TACRs, Denang, Hua/Phu Bai and Dong Ha. The volume of cargo handled by the Battalion decreased, due primarily to weather restrictions placed on aircraft. A corresponding increase of tonnage via surface carriers was experienced. The prelonged rainy weather of December created a decided chill, requiring blanks to and heaters for health and comfort of personnel.
