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

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Part II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of February helicopterborne logistic support was provided by the Battalion's four Helicopter Support Groups from LSAs at Dong Ha Combat Base, Vandegrift Combat Base, Quang Tri Combat Base, An Hoa, and Camp Evans. Units supported included the 1st, 3d, 4th, 5th, 7th, 9th, 11th, 12th, 20th Marines, Det 1, MASS-2, 3d Tank Bn, 3d Engineer Bn, Division Comm Company, 3d Antrac Bn, 1st and 3d Provisional 155 Btrys, 1st of the 5th (USA), 1st of the 44th (USA), 26th Arty Bn (USA), 2nd ARVN Regt, 62nd ARVN Arty Bn.

3d Shore Party Battalion participated in or supported 3d Marine Division tactical operations in the Marshall Mountain, Dawson River, Scotland II, Hai Loc, Kentucky, Dewey Canyon, and Purple Martin AOs. In addition one Helicopter Support Group of the Battalion participated in operation Taylor Common within the 1st Marine Division AO in support of the 3d Marines (-).

Personnel, equipment, multiclass supplies were transshipped from LSAs to widely deployed infantry and artillery units. A total of 12,042, 703 lbs of all classes of supplies, 4,037 passengers, and 5 medevacs were transported by 2,427 helicopter lifts from the LSAs within the 3d Marine Division AO. In addition, Helicopter Support Group DELTA, located within the 1st Marine Division AO at An Hoa, assisted in the operation of an LSA in cooperation with Company "B", 1st Shore Party Battalion. A total of 4,261, 594 lbs of all classes of supplies and 3,409 passengers were transported by 1,680 helicopter lifts from the An Hoa LSA.

Special rigging teams comprised of Battalion SNCOs and/or Officers were dispatched daily to supervise the rigging and lifts of artillery pieces, radar equipment, engineer equipment, bunkers, and other high value or unusually configured end items both to and from LSAs, fire bases, and landing zones throughout the 3d Marine Division and the Taylor Common AOs. Battalion SNCOs/Officers performed 117 of these special lifts.

Secondary missions accomplished included providing of security for vital defense sectors of the Quang Tri Combat Base and Dong Ha Combat Base perimeters. Limited engineer equipment assistance was provided to both Division and Non-Division units. A company commander and Marine enlisted personnel from the Battalion were deployed as part of the Quang Tri Provisional Rifle Company.

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Part III

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Mission. General support of the 3d Marine Division by:
 - a. Operating and maintaining Landing Zones within Logistic Support Areas for movement of equipment, personnel and supplies to organic and attached units of the Division and to U.S. Army and ARVN Units operating in the Division AO.
 - b. Providing Helicopter Support Teams to infantry and artillery units in the field down to the Company/Battery level.
 - c. Providing limited engineer equipment support to organic and attached units of the Division and to U.S. Army Units in the Quang Tri Combat Base, Dong Ha Combat Base areas and to Marine units at Cua Viet.
 - d. Providing a Security Platoon and a Command Group for Sector G of the Quang Tri Combat Base perimeter defense and providing personnel for provisional rifle companies as required.
 - e. Providing direct support to the 3d Marines (-) participating in Operation Taylor Common within the 1st Marine Division AO. Helicopter Support Group DELTA (Detachment (Rein) Company "C") was deactivated on 181200H February 1969 and has returned to their parent unit at Dong Ha Combat Base.
 - f. Providing Special Rigging Teams of Staff NCOs and/or Officers to organic and attached units of the Division to supervise helicopter external lifts and hook ups from LSAs, fire bases, and landing zones within the 3d Marine Division AO.

2. Significant Operations Conducted

- a. Helicopter Support Group ALFA (Company "A" (-) (Rein)) operated a Landing Zone within the Logistic Support Area at Quang Tri Combat Base and deployed a detachment to LZ Wyoming at Camp Evans to provide logistic support for elements of the 12th Marines. Also an average of twelve HSTs were deployed in support of 9th Marines and 2/12 units in the Dewey Canyon AO.

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b. Helicopter Support Group BRAVO (Company "B" (-) (Rein)) operated a Landing Zone within the Logistic Support Area at Vandegrift Combat Base and maintained an average of fifteen HSTs in support of 3d, 4th, 12th Marines and 2nd ARVN Units in the Scotland II, and Purple Martin AOs.

c. Helicopter Support Group CHARLIE (Company "C" (-) (Rein)) operated a Landing Zone at Dong Ha Combat Base and maintained an average of three HSTs in the field in support of 3d Marines and 3d Engineer Bn Units in the Kentucky, Dewey Canyon, and Mai Loc AOs.

d. Helicopter Support Group DELTA (Detachment Company "C" (Rein)) operated in cooperation with Company "B", 1st Shore Party Battalion at the LSA at An Hoa and maintained an average of eleven HSTs in the field in support of elements of the 3d Marines (-) on Operation Taylor Common.

f. Special Equipment Lifts. During the month of February, special rigging teams of the Battalion supervised the lifts of approximately 117 special items of equipment from LSAs, LZs and Fire Support Bases in the 3d Marine Division AO, and Operation Taylor Common in the 1st Marine Division AO. Items lifted included 155mm howitzers, 105mm howitzers, bunkers, TD-6 tractors, generators, case 450 tractors, countermortar radar

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units, CH-46 Helicopters, 122mm guns (captured) and a trailer.

3. Casualties Sustained. Non-hostile: 2; hostile: 4.

4. Command Relations. No significant change.

5. Geographic Disposition of Units. During the reporting period, units of the 3d Shore Party Battalion were geographically dispersed as follows:

6. Civic Action

a. MedCaps were held in the village of Nanh Bieu and the Quang Tri City Hospital by Battalion Medical personnel. A total of 445 patients were treated.

b. One TL-16 scooploader was utilized on 7 days to load sand to be used for the Chieu Hoi Center in Quang Tri City. Also one MRS-100 was utilized for leveling at the Chieu Hoi Center.

c. Candy, cookies and small toys were distributed to children at the Quang Tri City Hospital for the Tet New Year.

d. One 550 grader was used to improve and grade $\frac{1}{4}$ mile of road into the Quang Tri City Chieu Hoi Center.

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e. On 3 days during the reporting period Shore Party personnel assisted in the construction of a protective wire entanglement for perimeter defense of the Chieu Hoi Center at Quang Tri City and at the Chieu Hoi Hamlet, coordinates 346512. Also one RKF-060 forklift was utilized for unloading and transporting barbed wire to the area of its use at the Chieu Hoi Hamlet.

7. Personnel

a. Transfers and Extensions. One enlisted Marine extended his overseas tour. One Marine Officer and twenty seven Marine enlisted were joined. Four Marine Officers and twenty two Marine enlisted were transferred.

b. Awards. Purple Heart Medal (2), Navy Commendation Medal (1), Navy Achievement Medal (1).

8. Weather. Monsoon type weather conditions prevailed throughout the reporting period but there was no overall adverse effects on helicopterborne resupply efforts from ISAs to units in the field.

9. Significant Engineer Effort. None

10. Other Significant Events. On 16 February 1969 a detachment from HSG ALFA was deployed to LZ Wyoming at Camp Evans to provide support for elements of the 12th Marines in support of Operation Dewey Canyon. In addition, a reinforced HST of 22 men was formed to develop a small field ISA for the 9th Marines and to provide additional support for exceptionally active artillery batteries located at LZ Cunningham.
