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Part II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the reporting period 3d Shore Party Battalion participated in or supported 3d Marine Division, U.S. Army, and 2nd ARVN unit tactical operations in the Purple Martin, Mai Loc, Maine Crag, Montana Mauler, Ellis Ravine, Virginia Ridge, 2nd ARVN Regt, 3d Marine Division, 4th Marine, and 9th Marine AOs.

Helicopterborne logistic support was provided by the Battalion's three Helicopter Support Groups to widely deployed infantry and artillery units from LSAs at Dong Ha Combat Base, Vandegrift Combat Base, and Quang Tri Combat Base. Units supported included the 3d, 4th, 9th, and 12th Marines; 1st and 2nd Provisional 155 Btrys, 3d Recon Bn, 3d Engineer Bn, 11th Engineer Bn, 3d Tank Bn, 3d of the 5th (USA), 6th of the 33rd Arty Bn (USA), 1st of the 77th (USA), 26th Arty Bn (USA), 1st of the 61st (USA), and the 2nd ARVN Regt. A total of 13,384,360 lbs of all classes of supplies and 6,246 passengers were transported by 3,575 helicopter lifts from the LSAs within the 3d Marine Division AO.

Special rigging teams comprised of Battalion SNCOs and/or Officers were dispatched daily during the reporting period and supervised the rigging of 149 special lifts consisting of artillery pieces, engineer equipment, generators, and other high value or unusually configured end items both to and from LSAs, fire bases, and landing zones throughout the 3d Marine Division AO.

Secondary missions accomplished included providing of security for vital defense sectors of the Quang Tri Combat Base and Dong Ha Combat Base perimeters. Limited engineer equipment assistance was provided to both Division and Non-Division units. Marine enlisted personnel from the Battalion were deployed as part of a provisional rifle company and in support of 4th CAG units in the field.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Mission. General support of the 3d Marine Division by:
 - a. Operating and maintaining Landing Zones within Logistic Support Areas for movement of equipment, personnel and supplies to organic and attached units of the Division and to U.S. Army and ARVN Units operating in the Division AO.
 - b. Providing Helicopter Support Teams to infantry and artillery units in the field down to the Company/Battery level.
 - c. Providing limited engineer equipment support to organic and attached units of the Division and to U.S. Army units in the Quang Tri Combat Base, Dong Ha Combat Base areas and to Marine units at Cua Viet, and to ARVN Units located at Charlie-T and ALFA-2 Sectors.
 - d. Providing a Security Platoon and a Command Group for Sector G of the Quang Tri Combat Base perimeter defense and providing personnel for provisional rifle companies and 4th CAG units.
 - e. Providing Special Rigging Teams of Staff NCOs and/or Officers to organic and attached units of the Division to supervise helicopter external lifts and hook ups from LSAs, fire bases, and landing zones within the 3d Marine Division AO.
2. Significant Operations Conducted
 - a. Helicopter Support Group ALFA (Company "A" (Rein)) operated a landing zone within the Logistic Support Area at Quang Tri Combat Base and maintained a daily average of eight HSTs in support of 3d, 9th, and 12th Marine units in the 9th Marine, Maine Crag, Virginia Ridge, and Montana Mauler AOs.
 - b. Helicopter Support Group BRAVO (Company "B" (Rein)) operated a landing zone within the Logistic Support Area at Vandegrift Combat Base and maintained a daily average of thirteen HSTs in support of 3d, 4th, 9th Marine and 2nd ARVN units in the Purple Martin, Maine Crag, 4th Marine, and Ellis Ravine AOs.

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c. Helicopter Support Group CHARLIE (Company "C" (Rein)) operated a landing zone within the Logistic Support Area at Dong Ha Combat Base and maintained a daily average of nine HSTs in support of 3d Marine units in the Maine Crag AO.

e. Special Equipment Lifts. During the month of April, special rigging teams of the Battalion supervised the lifts of 149 special items of equipment from LSAs, LZs and Fire Support Bases in the 3d Marine Division AO. Items lifted included 155mm howitzers, 105mm howitzers, generators, backhoes, case 450 tractors, TD-6 dozers, Ontos, bunkers, air compressors, Radio Vans, CH-34 Helicopters, M-107 water trailer, and power plant for a M-108 howitzer.

3. Casualties Sustained. Non-hostile: 12; Hostile: 0.

4. Command Relations. No significant change.

5. Geographic Disposition of Units. During the reporting period, units of the 3d Shore Party Battalion were geographically dispersed as follows:

6. Civic Action

a. Medcaps were held in the villages of Nanh Bieu, NHU LE, Thon Thuong and at Quang Tri City Hospital by Battalion medical personnel. A total of 561 patients were treated.

b. Two TD-18 tractors were utilized for five days and one 550 Grader was utilized for one day to rehabilitate the Quang Tri City garbage dump, coordinates 334538. The project consisted of burying garbage, leveling new areas, and rough grading the entire dump area. One new pump with cover for a recently constructed well was donated to the villagers of Thon Thuong, coordinates 379498.

7. Personnel

a. Transfers and Extensions. Five Marine enlisted extended their overseas tours. Thirty two Marine enlisted were joined and four Marine Officers and twenty eight Marine enlisted were transferred. One Navy enlisted was transferred.

b. Awards. Bronze Star Medal W/V (1), Navy Achievement Medals W/V (4), Purple Heart Medal (1), Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry W/silver (2), Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry W/bronze (2).

8. Weather. Weather conditions during the reporting period did not present any adverse effects on helicopterborne resupply efforts from LSA/LZs to units in the field.

9. Significant Engineer Effort. None

10. Other Significant Events. During resupply operations on 9 April 1969 a CH-53 Helicopter experienced flight control difficulties and crashed on the Vandegrift LSA LZ. This resulted in massive fires that detonated ammunition being staged for the next days resupply operations. The landing zone matting, control tower and TACLOG Bunker as well as material handling equipment were destroyed. Support operations were shifted to the old Vandegrift LSA LZ on 10 April 1969 and the old LSA LZ was fully operational on 11 April 1969.

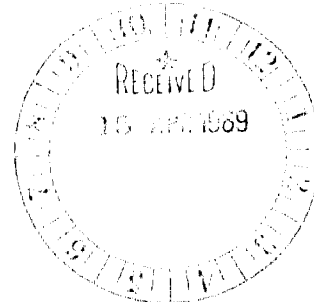
