NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the reporting period 3d Shore Party Battalion participated in or supported 3d Marine Division, U.S. Army, and 2nd ARVN unit tactical operations in the Purple Martin, Mái Loc, Maine Crag, Virginia Ridge, Apache Snow, Herkimer Mt., Massachusetts Bay, Cameron Falls, 3d Recon, and 3d Marine Division AOs.

Helicopterborne logistic support was provided by the Battalion's three Helicopter Support Groups to widely deployed infantry and artillery units from LSAs at Dong Ha Combat Base, Vandegrift Combat Base, Quang Tri Combat Base, and Camp Evans. Units supported included the 3d, 4th, 9th, and 12th Marines; 3d Recon Bn, Marine Air Support Squadron II, 6th of the 33d Artillery (USA), MCB 62, 267 Artillery Battery (USA), 3d Engineer Bn, 3d Tank Bn, 11th Engineer Bn, 1st Provisional 155 Btry, 1st of the 61st (USA), 1st of the 44th (USA), and 2nd ARVN Regt. A total of 11,579,513 lbs of all classes of supplies and 6,437 passengers were transported by 3,221 helicopter lifts from the LSAs within the 3d Marine Division AO.

Special rigging teams comprised of Battalion SNCO's and/or Officers were dispatched daily during the reporting period and supervised the rigging of 145 special lifts consisting of artillery pieces, engineer equipment, generators, and other high value or unusually configured end items both to and from LSAs, fire bases, and landing zones throughout the 3d Marine Division AO.

Secondary missions accomplished included providing of security for vital defense sections of the Quang Tri Cambat Base and Dong Ha Combat Base perimeters. Limited engineer equipment assistance was provided to both Division and non-Division units. Marine enlisted personnel from the Battalion were deployed to provide security for 4th CAG units in the field.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- 1. Mission. General support of the 3d Marine Division by:
- a. Operating and maintaining Landing Zones within Logistic Support Areas for movement of equipment, personnel, and supplies to organic and attached units of the Division, U.S. Army, and ARVN Units operating in the Division AO.
- b. Providing Helicopter Support Teams to infantry and artillery units in the field down to the Company/Battery level.
- c. Providing limited engineer equipment support to organic and attached units of the Division and to U.S. Army units in the Quang Tri Combat Base, Dong Ha Combat Base, and to Marine units at CUA VIET.
- d. Providing a Security Platoon and a Command Group for Sector G of the Quang Tri Combat Base perimeter defense and providing security personnel for 4th CAG units in the field.
- e. Providing Special Rigging Teams of Staff NCO's and/or Officers to organic and attached units of the Division to supervise helicopter external lifts and hook ups from LSAs, fire bases, and landing zones within the 3d Marine Division AO.

2. Significant Operations Conducted

- a. Helicopter Support Group ALFA (Company "A" (Rein)) operated landing zones within the Logistic Support Areas at Quang Tri Combat base and Camp Evans and maintained a daily average of fourteen HSTs in support of 3d, 9th, and 12th Marine units in the Apache Snow and Herkimer Mt. AO's.
- b. Helicopter Support Group BRAVO (Company "B" (Rein)) operated a landing zone within the Logistic Support Area at Vandegrift Combat Base and maintained a daily average of eleven HSTs in support of 4th Marines and 2nd ARVN units in the Purple Martin, Herkimer Mt., and Virginia Ridge AOs.
- c. Helicopter Support Group CHARLIE (Company "C" (Rein)) operated a landing zone within the Logistic Support Area at Dong Ha Combat Base and maintained a daily average of six HSTs in support of 3d Marine units in the Virginia Ridge AO.

- e. Special Equipment Lifts. During the month of May, special rigging teams of the Battalion supervised the lifts of 145 special items of equipment from LSAs, LZs, and Fire Support Bases in the 3d Marine Division AO. Items lifted included 155 mm Howitzers, 105mm Howitzers, generators, case 450 tractors, case 580 tractors, air compressors, M151Als, TD-6 tractors, and air track drill.
- 3. Casualties Sustained. Non-hostile: 22; Hostile: 4.
- 4. Command Relations. No significant change.

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6. Civic Action

- a. Medcaps were held in the villages of Nahn Bieu, Nhu Ie, Thon Thoung, and at Quang Tri Hospitol by Battalion Medical personnel. A total of 688 patients were treated.
- b. Equipment and personnel were utilized in the village of NAHN BIEU, coordinates 325527 for widening, leveling and filling of road.
- c. On 11 May 1969 35 children from the Quang Tri Hospital visited the Battalion and were shown movies and served refreshments.

7. Personnel

- a. <u>Transfers and Extensions</u>. Thirteen enlisted extended their overseas tours. Thirty three Marine enlisted were joined and four Marine officers. Twenty two Marine enlisted and three Marine officers were transfered. Two Navy enlisted were transferred.
 - b. Awards. None.
- 8. Weather. Weather conditions during the reporting period did not present any adverse effects on helicopterborne resupply efforts from LSA/LZs to units in the field.
