NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. General Overview. During the reporting period, the 3d Shore Party Battalion supported 3d Marine Division, U.S. Army, and 2nd ARVN Regt. tactical operations in the 3d Marine Division AO. The operations supported included: Arlington Canyon, Iroquois Grove, Idaho Canyon, and Georgia Tar.
- 2. Command Relations. No significant change.
- 3. Missions. General support of the 3d Marine Division by:
- a. Operating and maintaining Helicopter Loading Zones for the movement of equipment, personnel, and supplies to Division, U.S. Army, and ARVN units operating in the Division AO.
- b. Providing Helicopter Support Sections to the infantry and artillery units of the Division down to the Company/Battery level.
- c. Providing limited engineer equipment support to Division and U.S. Army units located at Quang Tri Combat Base and Dong Ha Combat Base. Additionally, like support was provided to Marine units at Cua Viet.
- d. Providing special rigging teams of officers and/or Staff NCO's to supervise the rigging of unusually configured or high value items for lift.

4. Operations

- a. Helicopter Support Team Alpha (Company "A" (Rein)) operated the Helicopter Loading Zone at Quang Tri Combat Base and maintained a daily average of five HSS's in support of 3d and 12th Marine units in the Idaho Canyon operation. On 23 September 1969 this unit assumed the responsibility for providing all HSS's and conducting helicopter resupply operations in the 3d Marine Division AO.
- b. Helicopter Support Team Bravo (Company "B" (Rein)) operated a Helicopter Loading Zone at Vandegrift Combat Base and maintained a daily average of eight HSS's in support of the 4th and 12th Marines, plus 2nd ARVN units in the Arlington Canyon, Idaho Canyon, and Georgia Tar operations. Resupply operations were secured at Vandegrift Combat Base on 22 September 1969 when HST Bravo returned to Quang Tri Combat Base to prepare for embarkation with RLT 3.
- c. Special rigging teams comprised of Battalion Officers and/or SNCO's were dispatched daily during the reporting period and supervised the rigging of 70 special lifts, consisting of artillery pieces, engineer equipment,

generators, counter mortar radar units, and other high value or unusually configured end items both to and from Fire Support Bases and LZ's throughout the 3d Marine Division AO.

5. Results of Operations

a. Lifting Data Recapitulation:

- a. MedCaps were held in the villages of Nhan Bieu and Nhu Le by Battalion medical personnel. A total of 75 patients were treated.
- b. The construction of the Info/PSYOPS Center at Nhan Bieu was completed on 30 September 1969.

7. Personnel and Administration

a. Transfers and Extensions. No Marines extended their overseas tours. Three Marine Officers, 21 Marine enlisted, two Navy Officers, and five Navy enlisted were joined, while two Marine Officers, 25 Marine enlisted, no Navy Officers, and one Navy enlisted were transfered.

- 1. 1-2 September 1969, Battalion cantonment suffered damages as a result of Typhoon Doris.
- 2. 22 September 1969, operations at Vandegrift Combat Base Helicopter Loading Zone terminated. *B** Company relocated to Quang Tri Combat Base.
- 3. 23 September 1969, received official warning order on the redeployment of the remainder of the Battalion. Helicopter resupply operations commenced at Quang Tri Combat Base by *An Company (Rein).
- 4. 28 September 1969, the Battalion lost one (1) M-109 Radio Jeep and one (1) M-151 Jeep as a result of enemy rockets. No personnel casualties resulted.
