OCTOBER 1965 SUMMARY  
PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

The Battalion's personnel posture continued to improve over that of the previous reporting period. The Battalion reached a peak strength on 31 October of 35 Marine Officers and 743 Marine Enlisted, together with 1 Naval Officer and 15 Naval Enlisted. The Battalion's enlisted strength was very favorable compared to the T/O, however, the Battalion remains 11 Officers short of the T/O. In many cases this shortage has necessitated some officers carrying forth the duties normally performed by two officers, however, this has in no way reduced effectiveness nor the quality of work and there appears to be no problem in the accomplishment of the mission because of it.

The Battalion is presently experiencing an almost critical shortage in the 01 occupational field. The shortage of trained clerks (0141s) has handicapped our administrative effort and this shortage coupled with the time and space factor discussed in the last report has presented no small problems. The accuracy of personnel reports and other administration continues to be satisfactory but only marginally so. Replacements in this field are badly needed, however, none seemingly are to be had in the entire division. A critical problem area is the lack of a trained Legal Clerk (0121).

The Battalion has had within the last month two Summary Courts-Martials, and one Special Court-Martial. The two Summary Courts were inherited from Company "B", 1st Tank Battalion (Joined last reporting period) and involves the wrongful taking and wrecking of a M-54, 6X6 truck. Aside from this, unit discipline has been very good.

Morale remains outstanding. Continued improvement of living conditions was evidenced during the current period. The Battalion Special Services Officer has set up shop in an M-105 trailer and has dispensed a wide variety of items ranging from games to athletic gear. Every Sunday, weather permitting, a softball game has been scheduled and appears well received by the men. To the recreation building established for the men has been added a tape recorder and a record player together with assorted games and magazines. A movie projector has been acquired for evening films.

Religious services were provided for both Catholic and Protestant personnel.

The Battalion Civil Affairs Program was very active this month. Two to three times a week the Battalion Medical Team sends the Doctor and several assistants to the HOA THO Village school house to treat the sick and lame in the Tank Battalion TAOR. In general the people are suffering from lack of cleanliness, improper diet, and such major sicknesses as malaria, impetigo, infection from cuts that have been improperly cared for. Through a continuing medical assistance program we have been able to notice a decided improvement in the overall health standard of the villagers.

With the distribution of goods through the village chiefs, the Battalion has developed a certain rapport with these people. The people are always happy to see us regardless of whether we are bringing them presents or not.

Again this month we have had the problem of no interpreter. This makes it extremely difficult to communicate with the people and much more could be done if an interpreter was available.

## INTELLIGENCE

Throughout the month of October 3d Tank Bn. units operating in parts of the Danang Enclave have been hindered by mines. Generally the mines have been of local type construction and were effective in disabling vehicles, though none were destroyed. Almost all of them contained between ten and fifteen pounds of TNT or black powder and employed the pressure-electrical type detonating system. This system has several variations, but basically consists of two boards held apart by wedge shaped pegs at either end. On the inboard side of the boards there is a woven network of wire generally forming consecutive diamonds, the tops of which are offset slightly from the bottom to insure a good electrical connection.

The boards themselves vary in length from 3' to 10'. Earlier in the month the shorter type boards were being used almost exclusively. In the latter stages of the reporting period the longer boards became more evident. This was probably due to the fact that several of these detonating devices were not tripped by tanks passing over them.

The mines themselves are usually placed just inside the track expected to be taken by the tank. The charge appears to be directed up and outboard so as to apply maximum power against the track and roadwheels. The charge is powerful enough to blow roadwheels off and in one case blew the escape hatch out. No hull damage has been sustained and very little damage has been done to the track itself.

A list of Essential Elements of Information was published and spot reports forms drawn and sent out to all the Tank companies. By reemphasizing the importance of intelligence and the exchange of information between companies and the battalion our efficiency will be improved. We are attempting to achieve timely dissemination to the companies of all information we receive.

As in the past several months this battalion has been greatly handicapped in its operation by lack of an interpreter. Information which may have been extremely beneficial in the execution of operation has been denied due to a lack of communications between ourselves and the Vietnamese people.

**SECRET**Training

In order to maintain the maximum possible degree of combat readiness all sections and subordinate units of the 3d Tank Battalion continued to emphasize realistic and practical general military and technical training related to combat operations in Vietnam. A three week course, designed and supervised by the Battalion Operations Section, was conducted on the duties and procedures employed by Reconnaissance Liaison Teams. Approximately ten percent of the command attended a two day course conducted by the 3d Engineer Battalion on the identification, removal, and destruction of Viet Cong mines and booby traps. The Battalion Medical Instruction Team continued to give bi-monthly instruction on first aid and hygiene to all subordinate units. Vehicle and communication equipment waterproofing instruction was conducted by contact instruction teams from Fleet Marine Force Pacific.

The Battalion continued its procedure of monthly test and range firing of all crew served weapons employed in the command post defense. In addition each company conducted range firing on the caliber 45 submachine gun and individual T/0 weapons.

It has been determined that gunnery instruction is the most important phase of continued and daily training in Vietnam. Accordingly a syllabus on a complete course of tank gunnery is in preparation with initial emphasis being given to crew procedures during the conduct of indirect fire.

**UNCLASSIFIED****Tank Combat Operations**

Again during the month of October 1965 the majority of tank offensive operations were conducted by B Company in the coastal plain southeast of Danang. On 6 October 1965 a platoon from B Company was placed in direct support of the 3d Battalion, 9th Marines operating in the center portion of the southern flank of the Danang enclave. The remainder of the company remained in direct support of the 1st Battalion, 9th Marines.

On seventeen occasions during the month tanks from B Company were assigned missions in support of sweep and clear operations or patrols. On five occasions tank alert forces were committed to actions against enemy forces. During the course of the month over twenty Viet Cong defensive installations were destroyed and approximately thirty-five enemy troops were killed as a result of tank machine gun or main armament fire. On the night of 27-28 October, following an enemy attack on the Danang East Airfield, tanks were committed to action against retreating Viet Cong forces moving in sampans along the coast. Six targets were engaged, three sunk and two others extensively damaged.

A Company remained in direct support of the Third Marines occupying strongpoints along the MLR and providing rapid reaction alert forces. Since the situation in the Third Marines TAOR was relatively stable tanks were committed on only three occasions. A two tank patrol was conducted to the most southwesterly sector of the TAOR to the hamlet of An My (3). No enemy activity was noted. On 30 October 1965 at 0200 a large attack against A Company, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines located at Hill 22 (AT 953667) was launched by the Viet Cong. The tank located on this position was slightly damaged by two 57mm recoilless rounds and a direct hit from a mortar shell. The tank remained operational, fired nineteen major caliber rounds, and killed between six and eight Viet Cong. Concurrently the tank in support of M Company, 3d Battalion, 4th Marines on Hill 41 (AT 934663) directed ten rounds of 90mm High Explosive ammunition, at a range of 1200-1500 meters, against two confirmed enemy mortar positions neutralizing their fires completely. At 2200 on 30 October a tank reaction force at the 2d Battalion, 3d Marines was committed against a substantial probe being launched near the Battalion's Command Post. Three 90mm cannister rounds were directed against the enemy and contact was broken. The 3d Platoon, A Company, attached to the 3d Battalion, 4th Marines at Phu Bai conducted a two day mechanized patrol to the western portion of the TAOR on 5-6 October. There was no enemy activity during this action. During the remainder of the month the platoon provided blocking forces along Highway 1.

C Company, attached to the 4th Marines, continued to maintain defensive positions at strongpoints along the Regimental MLR and to provide one tank platoon as part of the alert force near the Chu Lai Airfield. On 18-19 October one platoon was used as a convoy escort and reserve security force during Operation Triple Play in the far northeastern portion of the Chu Lai enclave. During the enemy infiltration of the airfield on the night of 27-28 October the reaction force was committed for a search and clear operation which resulted in two enemy killed.

B Company, 1st Tank Battalion, attached to the 7th Marines supported sweep and clear operations within the TAOR and continued to provide tanks at the southern road-block on Highway 1 during the hours of darkness. Arrangements were completed to conduct indirect fire into the highground in the southwestern portion of the Regimental TAOR. Initial fire missions will be conducted in early November 1965. The 2d Platoon, B Company, 1st Tank Battalion remained on detached duty with Field Forces, Vietnam at Qui Nhon in the II Corps tactical zone.

Special Operations

During October 1965 elements from Headquarters and Service Company conducted frequent patrols up to eight hundred meters in all directions from the Battalion Command Post. In addition, on 2 October the Battalion provided a twenty-eight man blocking force for a sweep and clear operation by the Vietnamese 11th Ranger Battalion along the northern bank of the Song Cau Do river. Listening posts and ambushes were also established as part of the Battalions perimeter defense.

The Commanding Officer, 9th Marines, within whose TAOR the Tank Battalion Command Post is located, assigned the security and coordinating responsibility of the area formed by the Command Posts of the 3d Tank Battalion, 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion, 3d Anti-Tank Battalion, and 3d Motor Transport Battalion to the Commanding Officer of the 3d Tank Battalion. In this capacity the Battalion Commander is responsible for the tactical integrity of the terrain within effective small arms or automatic weapons range of the barrier wire which is placed in front of the four Battalions. As part of the security system, a joint reaction force is being established which will be capable of employment both within and outside of the area occupied by the four Battalions.

During the period 29-31 October a liaison officer was assigned to assist the Senior Advisor, Vietnamese 4th Armored Cavalry Regiment, during this units operations in the coastal plain from Marble Mountain to Hoi An. The extensive experience of B Company, 3d Tank Battalion in this locality was of considerable benefit during this operation which marked the first use of the M-41 tank in the I Corps area.

Communications-Electronics

A communications bunker was completed to provide protection for the radio central. A 7.4 KW generator has been installed to provide power for the radio central. This greatly reduces battery requirements. Arrangements have been made to procure a generator to provide emergency power for the radio central in the event the main generator becomes inoperative due to enemy action.

A Single Side Band circuit, AN/PRC-47, provides a reliable administrative channel for communications with Co. "C", which is attached to 4th Marines. The range of this circuit is 45 miles. An AN/PRC-41, has been installed inside a tank turret for air and armour coordination. This necessitated the machining of an antenna mounted external on the tank turret.

The LFTU Water Proofing team visited the C.P. and conducted classes on Water Proofing of Communication Electronic equipment. A FMF PAC Contact team conducted classes on SSB and FM radio equipment for the battalion's communications personnel. On 5 different occasions radio operators accompanied short range patrols and good voice communications were maintained.

At the present time, some organic EE-8 and TA-312/PT phones are being used on the perimeter defense loop. Although this decreases the number of phones available for normal internal command post use, it is necessary, for maintainence of maximum practicable defenses for the C.P. A T/E change has been submitted requesting TA-1/PT sound power phones for use on the perimeter loop. Trunk lines between this battalion and several higher headquarters have been down several times for repairs. This has placed a burden on the battalion staff in matters of coordination requiring phone communications.

A general purpose strong-back tent was completed for the message center and off line crypto center.

The Communications SOP has been re-written and up dated. A revision of the Message Center's SOP was also accomplished. In addition, a battalion COI was published.

LOGISTICS

Providing Tank Support for the Division during October was most difficult from a Logistic view point. The ever increasing demand for tank spare parts has resulted in a maximum effort being put forth by the tank maintenance sections, tank crews, and supply personnel. Tank units have been required to operate tanks with extremely worn track and sprockets, unservicable components, and with secondary firing and control systems. As a result many of the tanks can not be operated at their maximum capability. Tank maintenance personnel have utilized all their professional ability and ingenuity to rebuild, fabricate, and jury-rigg parts and systems. Requisitions, tracer action, and red ball procedures have been aggressively pursued on all Priority 02 and 05 requisitions.

B-23 had to be Deadlined due to unservicable and unsafe track and sprockets. End connectors were pulled apart, and rubber was pulled away from all the pads and pins. The sprockets were worn on both sides to a degree that the track would hang up on the teeth causing excessive stress on final drives and torsion bars. It is expected that many more tanks will be deadlined for the same reason unless track and suspension parts arrive immediately.

An example of the availability of supply is the following percentages of fills by priority. Total Documents represent all outstanding requisitions. Tabulation of the fill rate commencing 1 July.

There are no problems concerning our Motor Transport Capability. Between one (1) and three (3) M54, 5Ton are furnished daily for Division requirements. This has imposed no problem on our requirements.

Sanitation and preventative medicine has been actively pursued by our medical section. As a result there have been no problems in these areas. An emergency medical bunker has been completed. This Bunker will be able to accomodate eight wounded and will contain facilities for emergency field medical aid.

The availability of Class I, III, and V materials has been excellent. The preparation of food has been very good and consequently has played an important part in maintaining the high state of morale existing within the organization.

Patrol Order 3-65

1. Situation

a. Enemy Forces. Viet Cong forces are believed to be infiltrating into DaNang area through neighboring villages.

b. Friendly Forces.

(1) Elements of 3d Battalion, 9th Marines occupy defensive positions at Highway 1 bridge (AT 999705).

(2) 3d Tank Battalion, 3d Anti-Tank Battalion, 1st Amph Trac Battalion, and 3d Meter Transport Battalion occupy defensive positions on the ridge line north of Song Cau De River (AT 986699) to (AT 989719).

2. Mission. To conduct a combat patrol east, south, and west of Tank Battalion to prevent infiltration into friendly installations and to kill or capture the enemy.

3. Execution

a. Concept of Operations. COMMAND CHRONOLOGY

1-31 October 65

Section XII

1. Problems encountered and lessons learned by supporting units.

a. On 23 October we brought two tanks across the Song An Ten River by deep water fording. Extensive preparations were made on the tanks and good sound information was obtained about the fording site. Reconnaissance Group Alpha did a ford reconnaissance of the site just two days prior to the fording operation and found the site suitable.

Lessons Learned - During the two days between the reconnaissance and the actual fording operation, both the river bottom and the river channel changed considerably. Due to rapid changes rivers ~~\_\_\_\_\_~~ in this area are poorly suited to deep water fording operations. Present bridges should be reinforced or new ones erected to accomodate tracked vehicle traffic.

b. We fired our flame tank section in the 2nd Battalion Fourth Marines area. The purpose was to provide training for the flame tank crews and to expend napalm which had been in the container for nearly two months. These tanks contain 378 gallons of gasoline in each napalm bottle. We also have an M-51 tank retriever which holds 400 gallons of gasoline. Only one M49C tank truck is held by this company. This truck is presently being utilized for diesel fuel. To procure gasoline in the quantities required for recharging flame tanks or refuleing the M-51 retriever, we must borrow a tank truck from another unit.

Lessons Learned - A medium tank company with a section of flame tanks attached must **EITHER** utilize the inherent capabilities of the M49C tank truck by carrying gasoline in one cell of the fuel tank; or two M49C tankers should be authorized; one for gasoline and one for diesel fuel. During periods of heavy operational commitment, it will be difficult to borrow an M49C tank truck to obtain the necessary gasoline.
