### APRIL 1966 SUMMARY PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION


The Battalion's personnel posture is at an acceptable level in relation to the strength authorized by the M Series T/O. The Battalion's chargeable strength as of 30 April 1966 was 39 Marine Officers and 686 Marine Enlisted, together with 1 Naval Officer and 15 Naval Enlisted. The loss of Companies "A" and "B" 1st Tank Battalion, who reverted to the 1st Tank Battalion on 1 April 1966 accounts for the large drop from the March Summary.

The Battalion received 56 USMC enlisted and 4 USN enlisted as replacements during this reporting period. Personnel in Occupational Field 3500 continue to be short. At present, the Battalion is short three 3516's and three 3531's. Anticipated losses for the next two months account for eight 3531's. Unless timely replacements are programmed, the ability of our motor transport to support the Battalion will be impaired. Other personnel shortages of note are: One Lieutenant 0150, one 1st Sergeant, and one legal clerk Sergeant 0121.

Two breaches of discipline have occured which have resulted in referral to Summary Courts-Martial. These have been the only disciplinary problems requiring judicial punishment.

Morale continues to be excellent. Softball games are played each Sunday when possible. R&R trips are a major factor in the high state of morale and are looked forward to with enthusiasm. The opening of China Beach for swimming provides a welcome break in the routine and is well received by all personnel. The absence of liberty has had little effect on morale so far but resumption of liberty is anticipated by most personnel.

The Battalion continues to place a high degree of emphasis on the extension of overseas tours. This program is having excellent results. Eight requests for extension of overseas tours were submitted during this month, making the total since arrival in RVN 77.





#### INTELLIGENCE


During the month of April 1966 the 3d Tank Battalion had experienced the same basic enemy employment of anti-tank mines which has prevailed for the past (10) ten months. There was an increase of mining incidents in the Phu Bai area which is related to the increase in operations.

The following is a chronological listing of mine incidents involving tracked vehicles during April:

- 1. On h April a tank detonated a mine south of DaNang at (BT080632) consisting of approximately (40) forty pounds of explosives. Indications are that this mine was activated by a pressure type device of crude construction. The tank incurred moderate damage to its suspension system.
- 2. On 9 April a tank detonated a mine in the Phu Bai area at (YD806168) while operating with an infantry platoon and a second tank. The device appeared to have been detonated by a pressure device normally encountered in manufactured anti-tank mines. The tank incurred extensive damage to suspension system.
- 3. On 9 April a tank detonated a mine in the Phu Bai area at (YD806168) while attempting to maneuver around the tank above which had just detonated a mine, blocking the avenue of advance. The mine also appeared to have been a manufactured type anti-tank device. This tank also incurred extensive damage to the suspension system. This appears to be the first mining incident in which tanks hit mines in pairs, as if a belt had been laid.
- 4. On 13 April a tank detonated a mine south of DaNang at (BT060649). The mine appeared to have exploded directly beneath the engine compartment causing damage to linkage, shock absorber, and engine oil resevoir. Damage to the tank was moderate.
  - a. No crewmen were injured in any of the mining incidents above.

The following is a chronological listing of mining incidents involving wheeled vehicles during April:

- 1. A3/4 ton truck (P.C.) detonated an explosive device while enroute to Hill 55 south of DaNang at (AT982624) described as being (20) twenty pounds of explosives. The charge was detonated by a pressure type device of crude construction. The truck received extensive damage. Two (2) Marines received minor shrapnel wounds as a result of this mining.
- 2. On 16 April an M-54 (6x6) truck detonated a mine in the Red Beach area northwest of DaNang at (AT945813) described as being (20-30) twenty to thirty pounds of explosives. An unknown type of detonator





Was used. The truck incurred extensive damage to its rear end. No Marines received injuries as a result of this mining.

In conclusion it should be noted that the Viet Cong have realized the strength of the M48A3 tank and that charges used in the early stages of operation in Vietnam were not adequate to imobilize it. The Viet Cong have become effective in temporarily imobilizing this tank with (30-60) thirty to sixty pounds of explosives and will continue to use this quantity as long as this material can be obtained.

The following Vietnamese were apprehended in local C.P. area:

- 1. On 12 April in Phong Bac Hamlet at (AT998708) two suspects were apprehended for acting suspiciously toward an approaching patrol. They were evacuated to 3d Interrogator Translator Team and Counterintelligence released them to Hoa Vang District Headquarters.
- 2. On 24 April two (2) suspects, a father and son, were apprehended for having classified CINCPAC Message, wire, batteries, boots, and uniforms. His son was apprehended a short time later, when he arrived on the scene, as a possible accomplice. Both suspects were evacuated to 3d Interrogator Translator Team. Counterintelligence released them to Hoa Vang District Headquarters.

No conclusions will be formed at this time.





TANK COMBAT OPERATIONS

The 3d Tank Battalion continued to provide tank combat support for the 3d Marine Division.

Company A (Rein) remained in support of 3d Marines. The favorable weather continued to improve trafficability in the 3d Marine TAOR, which resulted in increased tank activity.

The 2d Platoon, Company A had a tank section at Le My which fired frequent direct and indirect fire missions in support of infantry operations north of the Song Ca De. This tank section also participated in two search and clear operations north on Route #14 to the entrance to "Elephant Valley" (AT 840855). On these operations the tanks destroyed a total of 17 VC huts. On 21 April, 4 tanks from Company A provided an escort for the mechanized force moving elements of 3/9 to the Operation Georgia area. The tanks provided security from the vicinity of Hill #41 (AT 933663) to Hill #65 on Route #14 (AT 878576). The 1st Platoon, Company C was redesignated as the 3d Platoon of Company A. This platoon remained in direct support of the 3d Battalion, 3d Marines and continued to fire long range indirect fires from Hill #55 (AT 970621).

Company B (Rein) remained in direct support of the 9th Marines and, as in previous months, had most of the tank offensive action and eneary contact. Elements of the company participated in 9 armored patrols, 10 search and clear or search and destroy operations, and were used twice as a mobile reserve. These actions resulted in 12 enemy contacts for a total of 8 VC KIA (BC).

Company C (Rein) remained in direct support of the 4th Marines and provided the battalions with Cp defense and a mobile reserve force. The 1st Platoon was in direct support of the 2d Battalion, 1st Marines while the 2d Platoon supported the 3d Battalion, 4th Marines. The 3d Platoon supported the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines.

During April the following indirect fire missions were fired in the Da Nang TAOR:



#### SPECIAL OPERATIONS

During this reporting period 3d Tank Battalion continued to commit Headquarters personnel organized into provisional infantry units in an effort toward providing maximum support to elements of the 3d Marine Division.

A reinforced squad was organized into a composite infantry platoon in conjunction with squads from Headquarters Battalion and 3d Engineer Battalion. The composite platoon was committed on 6 April to positions adjacent to MCB 8 in Da Nang East to participate in the Da Nang Air Base defense. The squad remained throughout the month.

In the conduct of defense of the 9th Marines Rear Area Defense Zone, 3d Tank Battalion continued local patrolling and the establishment of night ambushes.

An additional infantry squad that had been organized from Headquarters personnel and assigned to a patrol base at the Hoa Tho village office and Thong Bac School continued to reinforce the Popular Force elements in the area.

rersonnel were provided for night defense of an engineer team engaged in well drilling south of the Command Post.

On 24 April a platoon (Rein) conducted a search and clear operation in Phong Bac Hamlet. Four VCS were apprehended. Two were forwarded to Hoa Vang and two sent to ITT.

Upon receipt of 3dMarDivOpO 386-66, 3d Tank Battalion Operation Plan 2-66 was prepared to implement the Division's concept of operation. The operation was not conducted but the plan provides for rapid implementation as required. See OpPlan 2-66, Encl (12).



#### TRAINING

During April, 3d Tank Battalion continued to conduct training as operational commitments permitted.

The Hoa Cam Regional Forces Training Center was utilized weekly to conduct live firing exercises for the individual weapons of Head-quarters personnel and newly joined personnel prior to their assignment to the Gun Companies.

Instruction of the safe and proper handling of pyrotechnics was held.

Particular emphasis was placed on training all personnel of the battalion in the use of riot control agents, individual gas masks, and riot control formations and techniques.

#### LOGISTICS

#### 1. General

- A. The period covered by this report is from 1-30 April 1906.
- B. During the Month of April the over all effectiveness of the Commands Logistic Support has improved greatly.
  - C. The main logistic efforts during this period were as follows:
- (1) An aggressive attempt to procure critically required tank spare parts.
- (2) A reorganization of our tank maintenance platoon to facilitate more proficient tank maintenance.
- (3) A LTI of all tanks to determine candidates for the R&E 66
- (4) Closer control and supervision of Motor Transport 1st and 2nd
  - (5) A camp clean-up and beautification program.
  - (6) Continued development of the cantonement.

#### 2. Supply

- A. Procurement, Availability, and Distribution of Supply.
- (1) The availability and distribution of Class I, III, IV, and
- (2) The availability and distribution of Class II Supply has improved greatly, however problem areas still exist. The lead time involved in the procurement of heavy and bulky tank spare parts is still very lengthy. Another problem is the increase in the requirements for non-supply items. This is due mainly to mines which are damaging parts that normally do not wear out or become unserviceable. At this time there are three tanks deadlined awaiting non-supply items. Two of these tanks have been deadlined since January.

There are 12 Dead-lined for repair.

#### 4. Transportation

- A. The overall effectiveness of the Battalion Motor Transport Platoon continues to be excellent.
  - B. The mileage for the month of April was 20,206 miles.
- C. On 6 April a M-37 Truck, serial 302962 struck a mine on the way to Hill 55. Five men were wounded, two serious enough to be evacuated. The P.C. was a total loss. A replacement vehicle has been received. On lo April a M-51 truck, serial 302289 struck a mine at Red Beach. There were no injuries. The truck was evacuated for 5th Echelon repair. A replacement vehicle has been received.
- D. The command utilized Rough Rider twoce during the month. The first time was to transport two M-54 trucks from Phu Bai to Da Nang and the other time was to transport two  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ton truck loads of supplies to Company "C" in Phu Bai. Both trips were without incident.
- F. Four M=5h, 5 ton trucks were shipped and invoiced to the 1st Tank Bn in Chu Iai. These four trucks were excess to this command's T/O. The overage was caused by the 1st Tank Bn. Returning the rotation Plt from Okinawa with two trucks when this command originally sent them to Okinawa with only one truck.
- F. Stepped up supervision of 1st and 2nd Echelon Motor Transport Maintenance has resulted in excellent vehicle maintenance.

#### 5. Service.

#### A. Tank Maintenance

(1) A reassignment of key tank maintenance personnel, a firm reestablishment of section duties and responsibilities, and closer supervision maintenance, and faster job completions.

- (2) Mi8A3 tank, serial 217838 was subjected to possible submersion on 30 March 1966, on 1 April it was found that it had in fact been submerged. This tank, and Mi8A3 serial 201889 (reported in March Chronology), were evacuated to CONUS on 30 April 1966.
- (3) The lack of non-supply tank spare parts and the scarcity of certain heavy track and suspension parts is the only factor holding up the maint-

#### B. Cantonement

- (1) The improvement to the camp area is continuous.
- (2) A camp beautification program is now underway. A new camp entrance has been put in. Intensified clean-ups and police calls are having a positive effect.
- C. Sanitation Frequent inspection by the Medical Authorities and close command attention to preventive medicine and area police has resulted in no sanitation problem.

#### D. Food Services

- (1) The availability of Class I supplies and the supervised preparation of meals has continued to be one of the prime reasons for the high state of morale which exists in the organization.
- (2) From 10 July 1965 until 15 April 1906 the 3d Anti-Tank Bn. utilized their mess hall. On 15 April 1906 the 3d Anti-Tank Bn. completed their mess hall. It is now in operation and feeding their own personnel.

#### COMMAND AND CONTROL

Operational control of tanks in support of Division continued to be exercised by supported units.

Reorganization and redesignation of tank units required as a result of deployment with BLT's and an interchange of tank platoons with the 1st Tank Battalion was completed. Each of the three tank companies had three 90mm Gun Tank platoons and were reinforced with personnel and equipment of H&S Company of the Tank Battalion.

Company A had a platoon in direct support of each of the two battalions under operational control of the 3d Marines. The 3d Platoon was assigned direct support of the 3d Battalion, 3d Marines under OPCON of the 9th Marines. This assignment was made to provide tank support where most required. 9th Marines with three battalions was assigned four tank platoons. 3d Marines with two battalions was assigned two tank platoons.

Company B (Rein) continued in direct support of 9th Marines.

Company C (Rein) operated in the Hue-Phu Bai TAOR in support of the 4th Marines (Rein).

Command and control of tank elements in both enclaves of the 3d Marine Division continued to be closely supervised and coordinated by 3d Tank Battalion. Every effort was made to have tank unit leaders included in early planning phases of all operations. Command liaison with supported unit leaders continued to be stressed in an effort toward maximum combat support.

#### COMMUNICATION ELECTRONICS

Reliable Communication were maintained during the month of April to support tactical requirements.

Notification of the initial issue of the new family of FM radios was received by this command from Philadelphia Supply Activity. Presently, this command has assets of two (2) AN/PRC-25 and one (1) AN/GRC-125.

The Criti-Pak continues to provide a reliable source of resupply for electronic repair parts that are not available through the regular supply system. FISG "A" Communications Electronics Repair Facility continues to provide the command with a reliable source of repair for evacuated electronics equipment.

This command presently has four (4) AN/PRC-10 radios deadlined and awaiting repair parts at the Electronics Repair Facility of FLSG "A".

#### MEDICAL AND DENTAL

Exttalion sick call for the month of April consisted of 513 subpatients seen and 1 impatient. The majority of the outpatients were treated for upper respiratory infections and skin conditions.

There were 8 cases of veneral disease treated. 5 of these were concerned and 3 were N.S.U.

There were la hours of lectures given to 46 marines of this En. by En. Hospital Corpsmen. These lectures were on V.D., First Aid and Sanitation.

The Civil Action Medical Team from this Bn. has treated patients three times weekly for the month at the Phong Boc Village. They treated 388 patients and gave a total of 396 treatments. The majority of the patients were treated for skin conditions.

Jossons Learned: During the past month the new cases of gonorrhea are being infected with strains of gonococcus which are more responsive to therapy than in previous cases. Reasons for this are not readily apparent without widespread bacteriologic studies.

#### CIVIL AFFAIRS

The 3d Tank Battalion continued to advance its Civic Action work during the month of April 1966. In addition to the numerous programs such as MEDCAP, education, health and sanitation, defense, and relief assistance which the battalion continued to provide as a base for its Civic Action Program, the planning phase of several new programs was completed during April.

The Battalion Surgeon held sick call at the Hoa Tho Aid Station three times a week on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. The MEDCAP team administered 396 treatments to 388 persons during April. The success of the MEDCAP program is demonstrated by the great reduction in sickness with a corresponding decrease in the number of people being treated. When MEDCAP was started in Phong Bac Hamlet as many people were treated in 2 days as are now being treated in a full month. The reduced workload has allowed the MEDCAP Team more time to accomplish the detailed medical work necessary for dental cases, plastic surgery, operations and research on individual and recurrent problem arease

In the area of education the 3d Tank Battalion insured that the students and teachers of the Phong Bac School were kept adequately supplied with school supplies during April. Plans were made for the presentation of graduation gifts to the top students in each class at the May graduation ceremonies. The teachers feel that this added incentive resulted in greater study efforts by a majority of the students.

The battalion's request to III MAF for financial aid for the purpose of building an additional classroom adjacent to the existing Phong Bac school was approved. Construction will commence upon receipt of material. This additional 20'x30' room will allow a total of 250 students from Hoa Tho Village to attend the Phong Bac School. The battalion anticipates supplying equipment and technical aid in the construction. 280 text books for grades 5=2 were ordered through the Vietnamese channels as well as through the USOM channels (to insure results).

After a careful evaluation of additional defense requirements for the Phong Bac Hamlet/eastern Hoa Tho Village areas the battalion decided that the hamlet needed approximately 500 meters of 6-strand barbed wire fence to run from (AT991706) west to (AT988706) then north to (AT986708) where it connects with the 3d Tank Battalion defensive perimeter wire. This plan was designed to seal off the natural avenue of approach into Phong Bac and Eastern Hoa Tho from the southwest. It is known that this route was frequently used by VC infiltrating Hoa Tho Village. 50 people from Phong Bac Hamlet, with assistance and technical advice from the 3d Tank Battalion constructed the fence in 3 days. It was completed on 27 March 66. The Village Cheef then requested additional wire to complete and repair the fence in the north eastern part of the hamlet. This amounted to about 250 meters of new fence and was completed on 30 April 66.

To bolster the defense of the village the 3d Tank Battalion began on a regular basis to supply one T/O rifle squad to support the popular force platoon at the Phong Bac Hamlet School/Hoa Tho Village Office. This has been an extremely successful program accomplishing much more than just defense of the rural school and Village Office. Through this support the PF morale has improved, yielding benefits such as improved aggressiveness, efficiency and respect for their jobs. Operating closely together the Marines and PF platoon have developed a rapport which facilitates joint operations. In the hamlet itself there is an increased realization of the Marines dedication to the cause of Vietnamese Freedom from fear and opporession. This program has greatly enhanced the success of the Civic Action Program.

The battalion's relief assistance program continued to be one of the most effective means of winning friends for the Marines. Each day the Bate talion gives 200 lbs of garbage to 19 families in Phong Bac. This provides feed for their pigs. Questions directed at the farmers concerning results of this program have revealed two things: First, the pigs grow faster and get heavier on the garbage. Secondly, the pigs are healthier after eating this garbage than the material formerly fed.

The second part of the continuing relief assistance consisted of the distribution of soap ammounting to 2,000 bars; 500 lbs of clothes; 80 millinery kits; and 100 lbs of food. All of these items are distributed through the village and hamlet chiefs to insure that they reach the most needy people.

The final part of the relief assistance program consisted of hauling 2,500 lbs of scrap lumber from the FLSG "A" lumber yard to the village office to be distributed as construction material and firewood. With new refugees moving into the village everyday, there is a continuing need for construction materials.

The battalion distributed two athletic kits to the students at the Phong Bac School. The kits consisted of volleyballspevolleyballenets, and soccerballs, all of which made a big hit with the children. Recreational gear is one of the items sorely lacking in rural schools.

The planning phase of the Hoa Tho Village market is complete. Upon receipt of building materials from USOM a ten stall market will be constructed at (ETOO1718). The purpose of the market place is to facilitate barter of local farm products and provide an additional income to the village through the rental of these stalls. The people who are residents of the Phong Bac Hamlet will have first choice on all stalls to maintain the market as a local enterprise wherever possible. Where it may be impossible to obtain such skilled local persons as tailors or barbers, persons from other parts of Hoa Tho Village may rente

Political Administration aid continued for the officials of Hoa Tho Village and Phong Bac Hamlet. The main emphasis of this aid is on eff-

iciency of management, agencies available to support them, and how they can improve the local government. An important facet of government often neglected by the inexperienced rural administrator is face to face contact with the people they govern. Through the encouragement of the 3d Tank Battalion the village and hamlet officials are spending more and more time with the people resulting in greater efficiency of the officials in carrying out their duties and more trust by the people in the officials.

An overall analysis of April's activities shows decided improvements in administration, education, economy; and health the most notable result of the 3d Tank Battalion's Civic Action Program is in the area of personal relations which have been furthered by better security. The people show an increased interest in working closely with the Marines and exhibit a friendly attitude on all occasions. It is worthy of note that the pacification status this month is considered to have jumped 14 points: from 72% in March to 86% by 30 Aprile



- (4) All infantry personnel will carry a minimum of two C.S. hand grenades. A resupply of C.S. grenades will be available aboard the LVT's within each team.
  - b. Supply. Four days! MCI and water will be carried by each team.
  - c. Evacuation
- (1) By helo/vehicle direct to "C" 3d Medical Battalion. Head injuries direct to the Naval Support Activity Hospital, Da Nang East.

- (1) Normal arms and equipment. All personnel will have two canteens of water and will wear upper body armor.
