Present officer strength is 41 compared with an authorized manning level of 41. August losses will be seven officers. This represents the brightest picture of officer strength in a year. Enlisted strength is 636 compared with an authorized manning level of 633. The battalion is reinforced by one medium tank platoon representing an additional requirement of one officer and 21 enlisted over manning level. August enlisted losses through rotation will be 75. Though the overall number of enlisted personnel is adequate, there presently exists a critical shortage of effective tank crewmen. The battalion requires 259 effective tank crewmen to man the 62 T/E tanks and five additional tanks which reinforce the battalion. The average number of effective tank crewmen available during July was 260. Furthermore, only 18 SNCO's 1811 are presently on the rolls compared with an authorized SNCO 1811 manning level of 36.

The battalion joined 11 officers and 36 enlisted during July. Losses were two officers and 36 enlisted.

Nine requests for extension of overseas tour were forwarded during July. These extensions bring the total man-months gained through extensions since 1 January 1967 to 486. The major factor in the favorable rate of extension of overseas tour is the special 30-day leave program.

Morale is very high within the battalion. The R&R program continued to be the major factor in this regard. Increased special service activities and expanding PX facilities are contributing factors. Also, increased contact with the enemy and an increasing sense of commitment seemed to increase the morale of the troops. The troops are generally eager to be where there is contact with the enemy and are proud to serve in the battalion.

The battalion sustained 57 casualties during July. Six were KIA and 42 sustained wounds as a result of action against the enemy. Nine non-hostile casualties were sustained.

Three special courts-martial were held during July, of which two resulted in not guilty finding. There were eight instances of punishment under article 15 UCMJ in the battalion.

Battalion level administration and personnel accounting continued to present no major problems. A shortage of five enlisted, in the occupational field 01, would be a major handicap to company level administration, but poses only minor difficulties to battalion level administration. The anticipated loss of two enlisted 0141's during August will adversely effect the accomplishment of some areas of the administrative mission. Personnel accounting errors have decreased

sharply since the institution of battalion level personnel accounting. It is anticipated that the goal of less than 1% error in personnel accounting can be reached by the end of August.

INTELLIGENCE

Weather. Temperatures during July remained within the seasonal mean high and mean low range; however, precipitation was only five percent of the July monthly average of 1.8 inches.

This lack of precipitation caused many tributary streams in Thua Thien and Quang Tri Provinces to drop as much as three feet in depth, thereby increasing 3d Tank Battalion units' mobility.

Intelligence. Third Tank Battalion units participated in seven operations during July. Seventy-five major incidents were reported, of which 46 were NVA/VC initiated. The NVA/VC initiated incidents consisted of three SAF/AWF attacks, 26 artillery/mortar/rocket attacks, 11 RPG/recoilless rifle attacks, and six anti-tank minings. Third Tank Battalion was credited with 30 enemy KIA (confirmed) and 78 enemy KIA (probable).

The employment of RPG-2's by the NVA/VC is of special note. It was found in the Con Thien area that RPG-2 rounds have been command-detonated from ground-mounted bamboo tubes. Also, the NVA/VC units are placing a great premium on anti-tank tactics, which is evidenced by individual tanks having received as many as 10 RPG-2 hits in rapid succession.

The 3d Tank Battalion Command Group and H&S Company at the Gia Le Combat Base had only two engagements with the enemy. An ambush was sprung on 10 to 15 VC, resulting in captured documents and two enemy KIA (probable). One armed VCS was taken under fire trying to enter through the perimeter wire. Results of the encounter were unknown.

OPERATIONS AND TRAINING

An increase in operations during the month of July in the 3d Marine Division TAOR resulted in an increase in NVA/VC contacts. Operation Hickory III during the last week of the month was the major commitment involving platoons from Company "A" and Company "B". There was an increase in the use of tanks to escort "rough rider" convoys in Operation Cumberland and Operation Fremont. The presence of tanks in the convoy columns appeared to reduce the number of NVA/VC attacks on the movements. A section of Company "C" tanks registered good results in direct fire from Hill 51 at targets of opportunity in the Fremont area.

Flame tanks fired a total of eight loads or 2400 gallons. This increase is attributed to Operation Cumberland and efforts to defoliate the MSR in that area.

A one-week tank proficiency and orientation course for new personnel (MOS 1811) was established prior to assignment of personnel to the letter companies. This training was deemed necessary because the line companies felt that new incoming personnel were not thoroughly familiarized with tank operations and maintenance. This program was affected somewhat by casualties sustained by Company "A" in Operation Hickory III and necessitated rapid processing of personnel to that unit as replacements.

Training during July consisted of troop orientation for new personnel and daytime and nighttime patrolling. H&S personnel were fam-fired with the M-16 and re-instructed on care and cleaning.

A bi-monthly briefing has been established for all Battalion person-

nel by the Commanding Officer and staff for the purpose of keeping all hands well-informed on friendly and enemy activities. A special briefing was conducted once a week for all staff non-commissioned officers. The special staff briefings were held nightly.

LOGISTICS

As of 31 July this battalion had a shortage of seven major end items. Four M48A3 Tanks, lost in combat, are on Pri 02 documents 7140-0003 and 7105-0677, one TD-15 Tractor is on Pri 05 document 74645 of 8 November 1966, one M38A1 Truck is on Pri 05 document 7132-0017. Supply functions continued normal. Thirty-five new Xenon lights were received for distribution to those vehicles without. A rebuilt M3 Compressor and an M543A2 Wrecker were received to fill T/E deficiencies. The supply operation is being moved into its new warehouse, conducting a full inventory as it does so. Supply administration personnel are completing a reconciliation of the 708-cards with the pending requisition file to bring the two in balance.

The maintenance sections continued to function adequately. Tank maintenance, in particular, has managed to stay abreast of the situation, making good use of the selective replacement of components policy allowed, when retrograding R&E vehicles. The last FY 67 M48A3 was received, completing the program at 25 M48A3 vehicles, four M67A2's and two M51's. Nominations were submitted for the FY 68 program. At month's end there were 15 major end items on deadline. Seven were ordnance items and eight were motor transport.

There were no significant problems during July pertaining to services support.

Construction on the tropical huts and mess hall has begun with MCB-3 contracting. As of the month's end, none of the new structures was completed although approximately 29 percent of the huts were finished except for doors, steps, and wiring.

Battalion Motor Transport logged 30,435 miles, 1833 of which were in support of Division-assigned commitments.

There were 32 casualties med-evacued from the battalion. There were 17 incidents of enemy inflicted damage requiring repair to battalion tanks. Six were as a result of mines, seven of anti-tank rounds, and three of artillery. All were to M48A3's and all except four were returned to service. Three will be returned to service shortly. The remaining vehicle was a combat loss belonging to an SLF BLT OPCON to Division.

COMMUNICATIONS - ELECTRONICS

During July the Communications Platoon maintained dependable communications, improved defensive positions, and improved preventive maintenance of communication equipment.

Radio circuits remained the same, with a 24-hour net with 3d Marine Division and 3d Engineer Battalion. Radio communications with the letter companies was maintained by four scheduled shots daily. The Battalion OPSTAT was passed to Division via a daily KY-8 covered shot.

The Wire Section was busy in July weather-proofing all phones on the perimeter. This was accomplished by building a covered, wooden receptacle for each phone. A long local was laid to Bulk Fuel POL in July.

The Communications Center continued to pick up traffic from 3d Engineer Battalion, which holds Communication and Crypto Guard for the Gia Le Combat Base. During July the Communications Center processed 486 messages.

The Tech Shop completed drawing diagrams for the AN/VRC-12, lesson plans for the operation of the new series of radios for tankers' instruction, and making new maintenance and modification cards for the AN/VRC-12 series of equipment.

MEDICAL AND DENTAL

Military sick call for July increased over that of June. A total of 304 patients were seen. Immunizations totalled 1523.

Veneral disease cases for July totalled six, an increase of three over last month's total. All six cases were diagnosed as gonorrhea. Two cases were contacted in Hue, RVN. Remaining cases were contacted out-of-country.

MEDCAP activities continued. A Hospital Corpsman is permanently assigned to the CAC unit at Loc Son Village. This corpsman holds daily sick call for the local populace.

Training was conducted on company level, covering self-aid and buddy-aid, with much of the instruction centering on the use of the morphine syrette and recognition and treatment of heat casualties. VD and personal hygiene lectures were also given.

CIVIL AFFAIRS

The 3d Tank Battalion Civil Affairs program slowed down due to a scarcity of labor during July.

The school in Xuan Hoi Hamlet needs only to be painted. It has a capacity for 50 students.

The rice warehouse project is still in progress with the procurement of beams and a temporary labor shortage causing the temporary delay.

The medical dispensary needs only lumber, which is currently being procured, and sheet tin for the roof. The concrete deck has already been laid.

MEDCAPs are conducted twice daily by a 3d Tank Battalion resident corpsman who stays with the CAC H-2 personnel. A total of 2266 patients were treated in July.

22 July 1967: At 221100H an infantry unit of the 4th Marine Regiment observed a VC at (YD 564290). A tank from Company "C" fired one 90mm HE round, resulting in one VC KIA (probable).

23 July 1967: At 231420H two Company "C" tanks escorted a rough rider on Operation Cumberland in the vicinity of (YD 684098). The lead tank was ambushed, receiving two RPG penetrations. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

Present officer strength is 41 compared with an authorized manning level of 41. August losses will be seven officers. This represents the brightest picture of officer ~~xxx~~ strength in a year. Enlisted strength is 636 compared with an authorized manning level of 633. The battalion is reinforced by one medium tank platoon representing an additional requirement of one officer and 21 enlisted over manning level. August enlisted losses through rotation will be 75. Though the overall number of enlisted personnel is ~~xxx~~ adequate there presently exists a critical shortage of effective tank crewmen. The battalion requires 259 effective tank crewmen to man the 62 T/E tanks and five additional tanks which reinforce the battalion. The average number of effective tank crewmen available during July was 260. Furthermore, only 18 SNCO's (MOS 1811) are presently on the rolls compared with an authorized SNCO 1811 manning level of 36.

The battalion joined 11 officers and 36 enlisted during July. Losses were two officers and 36 enlisted.

None requests for extension of overseas tour were forwarded during July. These extensions bring the total man-months gained through extensions since 1 January 1967 to 486. The major factor in the favorable rate of extension of overseas tour is the special 30-day leave program.

Morale ~~xxx~~ is very high within the battalion. The R&R program continued to be the major factor in this regard. Increased special service activities and expanding PX facilities are contributing factors. Also, increased contact with the enemy and an increasing sense of commitment seemed to increase the morale of the troops. The troops are generally eager to be where there is contact with the enemy and are proud to serve in the battalion.

The battalion sustained 57 casualties during July. Six were killed in action and 42 sustained wounds as a result of action against the enemy. Nine non-hostile casualties were sustained.

Three special courts-martial were held during July, of which two resulted in not guilty finding. There were eight instances of punishment under article 15 UCMJ in the ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ battalion.

Battalion level administration and personnel accounting continued to present ~~xx~~ no major problems. A shortage of five enlisted, in the occupational field 01, would be a major handicap to company level administration, but poses only minor difficulties to battalion level ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ administration. The anticipated loss of two enlisted 0141's during August will adversely effect the accomplishment of some areas of the administrative mission. Personnel accounting errors have decreased sharply since the institution of battalion level personnel accounting. It is anticipated that the goal of less than 1% error in personnel accounting can be reached by the end of August.

INTELLIGENCE

Weather. Temperatures during the month of July remained within the seasonal mean high and mean low range; however, precipitation was only five percent of the July monthly average of 1.8 inches.

This lack of precipitation caused many tributary streams in Thua Thien and Quang Tri Provinces to drop as much as three feet in depth, ~~thus~~ thereby increasing 3d Tank Battalion units' mobility.

Intelligence. Third Tank Battalion units participated in seven operations during July. Seventy-five major incidents were reported, of which 46 were NVA/VC initiated. The NVA/VC initiated incidents consisted of three SAF/AWF attacks, 26 artillery/mortar/rocket ~~xx~~ attacks, 11 RPG/recoilless rifle attacks, and six anti-tank minings. Third Tank Battalion was credited with 30 enemy KIA (confirmed) and 78 enemy KIA (probable).

The employment of RPG-2's by the NVA/VC is of special note. It was found in the Con Thien area that RPG-2 rounds have been command detonated from ground-mounted bamboo tubes. Also, the NVA/VC units are placing a great premium on anti-tank tactics, which is evidenced by individual tanks having received as many as 10 RPG-2 hits in rapid succession.

The 3d Tank Battalion Command Group and H&S Company at the Gia Le Combat Base had only two engagements with the enemy. An ambush was sprung on 10 to 15 VC, resulting in captured documents and two enemy KIA (probable). ~~result~~ One armed VCS was taken under fire trying to enter through the perimeter wire. Results of the encounter were unknown.

CIVIL AFFAIRS

The 3d Tank Battalion Civil Affairs program slowed down due to a scarcity of labor during July.

The school in Xuan Hoi Hamlet needs only to be painted. It has a capacity for 50 students.

The rice warehouse project is still in progress with the procurement of beams and a temporary labor shortage causing the temporary ~~minimum~~ delay.

The medical dispensary needs only lumber, which is currently being **Procured** arranged, and sheet tin for the roof. The concrete deck has already been laid.

MEDCAPs are conducted twice daily by a 3d Tank Battalion resident corpsman who stays with the CAC H-2 personnel. A total of 2266 patients were treated in July.

As of 31 July, this battalion had a shortage of seven major end items. Four M48A3 Tanks, lost in combat, are on Pri 02 documents 7140-0003 and 7105-0677, one TD-15 Tractor is on Pri 05 document 74645 of 8 Nov 66, one M38A1 Truck is on Pri 05 document 7105-0686 and one M49 Truck, Tanker is on Pri 05 document 7132-0017. Supply functions continued normal. Thirty-five new Xenon Lights were received for distribution to those vehicles without. A rebuilt M3 Compressor and ^{an} M543A2 Wrecker were received to fill T/E deficiencies. The supply operation is being moved into its new warehouse, conducting a full inventory as it does so. Supply administration personnel are completing a reconciliation of the 708 cards with the pending requisition file to bring the two in balance.

The maintenance sections continue to function adequately. Tank maintenance, in particular, has managed to stay abreast of the situation, making good use of the selective replacement of components policy allowed, when retrograding R&E vehicles. The last FY 67 M48A3 was received, completing the program at 25 M48A3 vehicles, 4 M67A2's and 2 M51's. Nominations were submitted for the FY 68 program. At month's end, there were fifteen major end items on deadline. Seven were ordnance items and eight were motor transport.

There were no significant problems during July pertaining to services support.

Construction on the tropical huts and messhall has begun with MCB-3 contracting. As of the month's end, none of the new structures was completed although approximately 29% of the huts were finished except for doors, steps and wiring.

Battalion motor transport logged 30,435 miles, 1,833 of which were in support of Division assigned commitments.

There were thirty-two casualties med-evacuated from the battalion. There were seventeen incidents of enemy inflicted damage requiring repair to battalion tanks. 
