PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION



INTELLIGINCE


Weather. Temperature during May reached a monthly high of 102 and low of 72. Precipitation was 1.11 for the month.


There was very little rainfall in Northern I Corps. The weather was predominantly warm. Tank operations were not curtailed by weather during the reporting period.

Intelligence. During the month of May, contacts by fire were scattered. Most of the heavy fire was concentrated to the north and west of Dong Ha. There were a number of contacts made on the coast mainly because of the rice harvest. Rice was being taken to the coast for storage and NVA/VC troops would attempt to intercept and sieze the rice.

Enemy movement during the month of May found most of the enemy in the northern sector regrouping due to the heavy losses taken in the battles north and west of Dong Ha.

A 3d Tank Battalion patrol was ambushed on 5 May resulting in 3 KIA and 4 WIA. No contacts have been made since that date in the Chang Tri Combat Base area.





PART II OPERATIONS AND TRAINING

Company A. During the month this Company supported the 3d Battalion, 3d Marines, the 1st and 3rd Battalions, 4th Marines, the 1st and 3rd Battalions, 9th Marines, the 1st and 2nd Battalions, 26th Marines, the 2nd Brigade, 1st Air Cavelry Division and the 2nd Regiment, 1st ARVE Division. The unit participated in Operations Concordia, Loatherneck Square and Mentucky. Support provided included road sweep escort, sweeps and attacks on designated objectives with infantry, destruction of one enemy OP, 90rm fire on enemy troops in open, fire on two suspected tanks, silencing of one artillery and one AA machine gun position and firing several missions against suspected enemy mortar, rocket and artillery positions. The company accounted for 71 MIA (C) during the month.

Company B. Elements of Company B participated in Operations Lancaster and Scotland II in support of Task Force Hotel, the 3rd Dattalion, 1st Marines, 1st Battalion, 4th Marines and the 3rd Battalion 9th Marines. The units were supported with HI fires, suppressive fires for convoys, fires at known and suspected enemy rocket and artillery positions and convoy escort. On 13 May the 1st Platoon completed a move to The Sanh where it replaced the 3rd Pintoon which had been at the base since June 1967. On 19 May the 1st Platoon was escorting a convoy from The Sanh. Approximately 300 meters outside the perimeter the convoy was ambushed. During the ensuing fight all five tanks sustained RPG hits. No tank took fewer than three hits. B15 was destroyed in the action. hundred and sixty five enemy KIA (C) were credited to this action. It is estimated that B-1 tanks accounted for one hundred of these. In other actions Company B accounted for four KIA (C) during the month.

Company C. Company C continued to provide the bulk of the tanks to Task Force Robbie until the organization was deactivated on 29 May. One section continued to operate in the Operation Napolean/Saline AO in support of the 3rd Marines. On 12 May one additional platoon was assigned to the Cua Viet area where it operated in support of B Company, 1st Battalion, 5th Cavalry for several days. It now supports the 3d Marines. The 3d Platoon continues to operate with the 1st Marines in the Scotland II AO. These tanks fired Hell fires, fired at and silenced one mortar position, fired at enemy in the open and in bunkers and participated in offensive actions with the infantry. The Company accounted for 74 KTA (C) during the month.

Company A. 3d Anti Tank Battalion. This Company continued under the operational control of Mask Porce Hotel in Operation Scotland II. The ontos fired at enemy troops and bunkers, provided



preparation fires for infantry and fired at one active rocket site. Action by this unit during the month showed amarked increase in comparison to previous months.

Task Force Robbie. This unit is not an element of this Battalion but since it is composed of tanks from HOS, A, B, and C Companies it is treated as an entity. The Task Force continued in its mission as the Division Reserve. Throughout the month elements were assigned out from the Task Force to support infantry units throughout the Kentucky AO. The operation in the Cam Vu area described in last months, report continued into the early days of May. Tanks operated with the 3d Battalion, 9th Marines along Route 8B against elements of the 52nd MVA Regiment until 2 May. Tanks were credited with four KIA (C) during the period. On 29 May Task Force Robbie was deactivated and all elements returned to the control of their parent organizations except the ontos platoon of BOT 2/h which was placed under the operational control of this Battalion and now supports the 9th Marines.

The Battalion continued to provide on call tank support. On 26 May a requirement for three tanks to support the 3d Battalion 9th Marines was levied by G-3. To answer this, two Company C tanks and one Company B tank, which were in Dong Ha for maintenance, were organized into a provisional platoon under the command of the Company A, Executive Officer.

On 8 May the two gun tanks of H&S Company returned to the Quang gri Combat Base where they are employed in base defense.

The Battalion continued to defend its sector of the Quang Tri Combat Base. On 5 May a patrol from the Command Post was ambushed approximatly 300 meters from the perimeter. The patrol suffered 3 ETA and 4 WTA including the ARVN interpreter assigned to the Battalion. Enemy casualties were unknown. Rapid and decisive action by the Assistant Patrol Leader prevented further assualties and individual action by patrol members saved the lives of wounded men. Four recommendations for decorations resulted from this action.

Training during the month showed a further increase although continued heavy operational commitments were assigned.

A school was conducted by the Division Legal Section on 11 May. Eight officers of HES Company received a one hour lecture on the duties of trial and defense consels.






Three in-country orientations were held during the month with forty two men attending.


The nightly briefing for the Commanding Officer and his Staff continued.

LOGISTICS

The heavy commitment and necessarily rapid maintenance turnaround time mentioned for the past three months as being the primary factor affecting this battalion's overall maintenance situation has finally seen its rightful result. On 24 May 68 the Third Tank Battalion entered Equipment Readiness Catagory 3 and remained in such state until 27 May 68. It is felt that the battalion continued and continues to handle its 2d Echelon responsibilities admirably for during the entire C-3 period a total of only 10 vehicles were deadlined at our 2d Echelon facilities. It stands to reason then that the majority of the problem resided with the 3d Echelon maintenance activity at FLSG-B. This proved to be the case, and is pointed out by the figure of 14 vehicles deadlined at 3d Echelon during this same C-3 period.

There appears to be agrowing, yet hopefully distant problem concerning the availability of tank 2d Echelon repair parts. While spare repair parts continue to arrive, the quantities received are not sufficient to allow the adequate building-up of spare parts reserve. The afore-mentioned problem conters around the circumstances of a fairly rapidly diminishing enhand supply of spare parts without needed replacement parts being received.

Concentrating now on both wheeled and tracked vehicles; there were a total of 14 incidents involving damage to battalien vehicles due to enemy action during May. Of these all but two were returned to use and are currently employed. The two not returned to use are combat losses: one M48A3 Tank and one M54 Truck.

As of 31 May 68 there were 7 tanks, 10 Ontos, 33 motor transport vehicles, 1 communication vehicle, and no ordance items deadlined. Of these 3 tanks, 4 Ontos, 14 motor transport vehicles, 0 communication vehicles, and 0 ordance items are at 3d Echolon maintenance facilities. The overall deadline rates can be attributed to no single factor, but among the elements affecting it are enemy activity, lack of adequate spare parts (this is especially true in the case of the Ontos), and slow turn-around of vehicles turned in for 3d Echelon repairs. The following list of major end items and the length of time they have been at 3d Echelon should be informative:

Motor transport vehicles this month traveled 9519 miles in moving 3901 passengers and 620 short tons.

A listing of the battalion's major T/E deficiencies includes four Mt8A3 tanks, one recovery vehicle, five M38A1 utility trucks, two M37B1 trucks, one TD-15 tractor, two M5th trucks, three mixing and transfer units, and two high pressure cleaning units. There were no major end items received during this month. The Mt22 reported last menth as a suspected combat loss remains in that category as no coding authority has been received from FLSG-Brave. Five M151 trucks were received as replacement vehicles for the organic Mtt2s. An exchange program of one-for-one has been instituted to get these vehicles to the ultimate using units, and should be completed within a short period. The Mt22s will be turned in to FLSG-Brave as they are received.

The Ontos spare/repair parts situation remains a problem area. Early this month couriers were dispatched to FLC, Da Nang to acquire any available Ontos parts. The results were disappointing and as a result, the Ontos deadline rate continues in the vicinity of 50%. Permission was requested and received from Division G-4 to engage in selective interchange with regard to Ontos and it is hoped this will improve the situation. This is viewed as a desperation effort to keep what Ontos we have operational in that

status, and without adequate supply response a continuing increase in the Ontos deadline rate is inevitable. The five Ontos deadlined at FLSG-Brave for lack of OEM were picked up by this battalion on 29 May. Shortages still exist but are being filled via the selective interchange route.

The availability of repair parts required for infrared equipment has not improved. Currently this battalion has a deficiency of 25 Xenon searchlights and 13 M18A1 binoculars. Instructions were received from FMFPac that requisitioning procedures for Xenon would follow normal practice, and the deficiencies were placed on order.

The primary supply activity during this period concerned the compilation of back-order reconcilations for each account held. Additional activities included the implementation of M-16A1 rifle exchange program (chrome barrelled rifles for non-chrome ones), and two activities already mentioned: the procurement of critically needed Ontos repair parts, and the exchange of M151 for M422s.

Services are considered satisfactory. Cantonment inprovement continues, and construction of individual protective shelters progresses satisfactorily.

Medical facilities within the battalion are considered satisfactory. There were 48 Marines requiring medical evacuation during May.

MEDICAL AND DENTAL

Five hundred and ninety-nine patients were seen at routine sick call during May. There was a sharp decrease in the number of diarrhea cases and an increase in dermatologic conditions. This increase stems primarily from the heat.

Venereal disease for the period remained minimal with four cases being reported.


Dental care is now available to members of H&S Company at the 3d Engineer Battalion Aid Station.

Hospital Corps strongth remains adequate.

Sanitation in the Battalion Command Post area is very good and continual improvement is expected as all sections are cooperating fully. The Preventive Medicino Unit of "B" Med is conducting surveys of the area because of the proximity of mosquito breeding areas.

Training of Hospital Corps and Marine personnel is continuing with emphasis on technical subjects for Corpsman and in-country indectrinations for Marines.

ModCap activities were initiated during May. The first MedCap since the Battalion moved to Quang Tri was held on the 16th and a second on the 23d. Both received good respense with over one hundred and fifty patients being treated.





COMMUNICATIONS - ELECTRONICS

During May the Communications platoon relocated operations, updated management and maintenance procedures, and improved general communications support of this Battalion.

On May 11th the Communications/COC bunker was completed. Communication operations now located in this bunker are, message center, radio, switchboard, and S&C files.

The Communications Officer attended a communications Crypto school for ten days (17-26 May 1968), thus providing the Communications platoon with a second qualified crypto operator.

The electronics repair shop constructed an AN/VRC-73 test bench. The test set is a duplicate of the communications arrangement within our tracked vehicles, loss the T-I phone. This system expedites the location of radio equipment failures.

A second ochelon quarterly preventive maintenance inspection was performed on every AN/PRC-25 within H&S Company.

The Communications plateen centinues to maintain 24 hour operational communications. All new personnel have demonstrated a high degree of professionalism and accuracy.



Ref: (a) Div0 3480.1B

1. In accordance with reference (a), the following report is submitted:

- a. Problem. It is common practice for tank drivers to keep their hatches open in close terrain in order to improve their field of vision. Upon contact with the enemy the hatches are buttoned up. Recent encounters between tanks and NVA/VC RPG teams have shown that the enemy has modified his anti-tank tactics. RPG teams now aim their first shots at the front of the tanks in an effort to hit the driver thus stopping the tank and making it vulnorable to further attack.
- b. Solution/Recommendation. In view of the above it is necessary for tank drivers to sacrifice the added visibility resulting from driving with an open hatch when operating in close terrain. Additionally this NVA/VC tactic adds greater importance to the providing of close in security, by the infantry, to the tank.


