2. Commander's Narrative Summary of Significant Events

On 6 August the 3d 155mm Gun Battery (SP) displaced from Battery position and moved north of Tam Ky to support Operation Colorado. The position occupied, BT 224320, was the most northern position yet occupied by this battery. During Operation Colorado, excellent support was received from the 9th Engineer Battalion. On 16 August, the battery returned from Operation Colorado. On 17 August the Battery CP was moved from BT 489031 to BT 438098. 3. Detailed Description of Significant Events

- a. <u>Personnel</u> During August, this battery lost 1 officer and 9 enlisted due to administration reasons. It has gained 2 officers and 3 enlisted. Although the battery is at a relatively high percentage of T/O, deployment in three positions creates a strain on personnel resources.
 - b. Administration No significant events in this area.
- c. <u>Intelligence</u> It remains very difficult to obtain surveillances on missions fired in support of 1st Reconnaissance Battalion units.
- d. Training This battery has conducted schools on the section level with on the job training to facilitate training new people in this battery.
- e. Special Operations From the period of 6 August to 16 August 1966, the 3d 155mm Gun Battery (SP) was in support of Operation Colorado. The battery position was located at coordinates 224320 and the principle directions of fire were 3600 and 4000. "C" Platton, 3d 8" HowBtry was attached to the Gun Btry to form a composite Btry. During Operation Colorado support provided by this battery included the following missions:

- f. Command and Control As of 31 August the 3d 155mm Gun Battery (SP) CP is located at BT 438098 with guns laid on azimuth 4200.
 - g. Fire Support Nothing significant to report in this area.
 - h. Air Defense Not applicable
 - i. Combat Air Support Not applicable
- j. <u>Civic Action</u> Since moving the Btry CP, it is expected that the Battery will combine efforts on civil affairs with the 4thBn llth Marines.
- On 31 August 1966, SSgt W. F. MATTINGLY saved the life of a 5 year old Vietnamese boy. The boy jumped on the back of a moving M37 vehicle drivers by SSgt MATTINGLY. The boy fell back, apparently dead from cardiac arrest or shock. SSgt MATTINGLY immediately halted and applied mouth to mouth resuscitation. The boy responded and was taken to "B" Med Co.
