COMPANY DENTAL CLINIC LOCATIONS

- a. 3rd Dental Company Headquarters. The 3rd Dental Company CP is located in the 3rd Shore Party Battalion area. The Commanding Officer, Administrative Officer, Administrative Chief, Company Training Petty Officer, two office clerks and one driver staff the CP.
- b. 3rd Shore Party Battalion site. This Clinic is staffed with one dental officer and two dental technicians. One of the dental technicians does preventive dentistry full-time.
- c. 1st Medical Battalion site. Eight dental officers and 16 dental technicians are assigned to this Clinic. Operative, prosthetic, endodontic, oral surgery, periodontic, and preventive dentistry services are provided at this Clinic. The oral surgeon treats the maxillo-facial casualty injuries. Two dental technicians are assigned to full-time preventive dentistry. Three technicians are working in the prosthetic laboratory.
- d. 7th Engineers site. Two Dental officers and two dental technicians are assigned here. One of the technicians handles the preventive dentistry duties.
- e. Fleet Logistic Support Group site. Two dental officers and three dental technicians are assigned to this clinic. One technician is a full-time preventive dentistry technician. The Company Supply, Mount-Out, and Repair sections are located here also. A Pediatric Hospital for the Vietnamese has been constructed at FLSG. The two dental officers at this Clinic each work one-half day at the hospital.

- f. Khe Sanh site. One dental officer and one dental technician provide dental support for the Marine, Navy, and Army personnel in the area. An extensive civic action program is carried out in the surrounding villages.
- g. Dong Ha site. Three dental officers and five dental technicians staff this Clinic. One of the technicians is assigned full-time to preventive dentistry.
- h. Camp Carroll site. A Dental/Surgical Van is in this area with one dental officer and one dental technician assigned.
- i. Phu Bai site. Five dental officers and nine dental technicians staff this Clinic. Operative, prosthetic, oral surgery, and preventive dentistry services are provided. Two technicians man the prosthetic laboratory and one technician is assigned to full-time preventive dentistry. The oral surgeon treats the maxillo-facial casualty injuries.
- j. 7th Motor Transport site. One dental officer and one dental technician are assigned here.
- k. Hill 55 site. One dental officer and one dental technician are assigned here.
- l. III MAF site. One dental officer and two technicians provide the dental support which includes preventive dentistry.

PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

The 3rd Dental Company furnishes dental support to Marine Corps personnel in the Danang, Hué Phu Bai, Dong Ha, and the Khe Sanh areas of RVN. There are eleven 3rd Dental Company Clinics. The Commanding General has approved the construction of a new seven dental operating room clinic in the 3rd MARDIV CP area at Phu Bai. An additional hard-top clinic in the Dong Ha area has also been approved. The 3rd Dental Company personnel assist in Mass Casualty Care when additional personnel are needed and are active in the civic action program.

2. Administration. The Administrative Officer meets daily with the supervisory personnel to discuss problems and disseminate information.
3. Training. The weekly training program for enlisted personnel (E-3 through E-6) is comprised of a weekly study assignment of subjects in military and professional fields followed by a test covering each assignment. A one-hour weekly class in leadership is held for all personnel. Troop indoctrination is accomplished in compliance with Force Bulletin 1700 of September 1965.
4. Command and Control. The Commanding Officer maintains liaison with Clinic Directors by periodic visits and telephone calls. The Commanding Officer and the Administrative Officer confer daily concerning Company operations. The Commanding Officer confers frequently with his professional staff in regards to both military and professional subjects.
