COMPANY DENTAL FACILITIES LOCATIONS

a. 3D Dental Company Headquarters, 1-31 March 1969
The 3D Dental Company Headquarters, including Mount-Out, Motor Transport, Repair, and Supply Sections are located in the Headquarters Battalion CP area, Quang Tri Combat Base. Facilities include five tropical huts and one floored strong-back tent and one double length REA-in tropical hut.

Supply Section	- Supply Chief and (1) Dental Technician.

b. CP Facility - Quang Tri Combat Base, 1-31 March 1969
Two tropical huts manned by (6) dental officers and (12) dental technicians. One of the two prosthetic facilities with the company is here.

c. 3D Medical Battalion Facility - Quang Tri Combat Base, 1-31 March 1969
One tropical hut manned by (1) dental officer (2) oral surgeons with (2) dental technicians.

d. Battalion Rear Facility - Quang Tri Combat Base, 1-31 March 1969
(1) Tropical hut manned by (1) dental officer (2) dental technicians.
(2) Tropical hut manned by (4) dental officers and (6) dental technicians.
(3) Two Dental Mobile Vans manned by (1) dental Officer and (2) dental technicians.

e. Division CP - Dong Ha Combat Base, 1-31 March 1969
Two tropical huts manned by (3) dental officers and (8) dental technicians. Second of Company's prosthetic facilities is located here.

f. "D" Medical Company - Dong Ha Combat Base, 1-31 March 1969
Tropical hut manned by (1) dental officer and (1) dental technician.

g. Battalion Areas - Dong Ha Combat Base. 1-31 March 1969
Two tropical huts in separate battalion areas, one manned by (1) dental officer and (2) dental technicians and one by (1) dental officer and (1) dental technician.

Tropical hut manned by one dental officer and (2) dental technicians.

i. Vandegrift Combat Base. 1-31 March 1969
Reinforced bunker manned by (2) dental officers and (2) dental technicians.

PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

The 3D Dental Company provides dental support throughout the TAOR of the 3D Marine Division to personnel of the Division. In addition, it provides dental prosthetic treatment and dental repair preventive maintenance services to Navy and Marine personnel of NSA, 1st MAF and MCB units in the TAOR. Assistance to Graves Registration is provided in identification of the dead. Company personnel provide support to the Marine Memorial Children's Hospital at "D" Medical facility, Dong Ha. DENTCAPS were somewhat curtailed during the month due to increased enemy activity and mining incidents of the post-TEP offensive, particularly in the Combined Action Platoons area. Active Fire Support Base support activity was continued with favorable troop response to the program. The Company was inspected by a team from Field Supply Analysis Office twice during 16-18 March. Force Dental Officer, FMEPAC, arrived in-country for annual inspection of III MAF Dental Companies on 31 March. A double length SERVICIA tropical hut was constructed at Quang Tri Combat Base CP area during the month. Upon completion of plumbing, wiring and internal finishing, this building will house an enlarged prosthetics laboratory and two operating rooms. Plans for construction of an additional dental facility at Elliot Combat Base were dropped and the bunker assets were diverted to Vandegrift Combat Base. This additional bunker at VCB will permit expansion of that facility in support of forward maneuver battalions.

A second reinforced bunker is being constructed at Vandegrift Combat Base to permit expansion of the present facility.
