2. LOCATION: 1 October 1969 to 5 November 1969: Quang Tri Province, Republic of Vietnam

a. 3D Dental Company Headquarters, Quang Tri Combat Base. 1 October 1969 to 5 November 1969. The 3D Dental Company Headquarters, including Mount-Out, Motor Transport, Repair and Supply Sections are located in the Headquarters Battalion CP Area, Quang Tri Combat Base. Facilities include seven tropical huts.

Company Headquarters - Commanding Officer, Administrative Officer, Leading Chief, Administrative Chief, Clerical Petty Officers (3) and (1) Driver.

Supply Section - Supply Chief, (2) Dental Technician, (1) USMC Warehouseman.

Motor Transport - Supervisory Petty Officer, (2) USMC Drivers

Mount-Out Section - (2) Dental Technicians

Repair Section - (1) Dental Technician

b. CP FACILITY - Quang Tri Combat Base, RVN. 1 October 1969 to 20 November 1969. One tropical hut manned by (5) dental officers and (5) dental technicians. One Prosthetic facility with (2) dental officers and 10 Dental Technicians in a double length SEAsia tropical hut until 5 November 1969. (1) Dental Officer and (5) Dental Technicians from 5 November 1969 to 20 November 1969. Prosthetic facility closed on 16 October 1969.

c. 3D Medical Battalion Facility - Quang Tri Combat Base, RVN. 1 October 1969 to 15 October 1969. One tropical hut manned by (2) Dental Officers and (1) Oral surgeon with (2) Dental Technicians.

d. Battalion Rears Facility - Quang Tri Combat Base, RVN. 1 October 1969 to 14 October 1969. (1) Tropical hut manned by (3) Dental Officers and (4) Dental Technicians.

e. Division CP - Dong Ha Combat Base, RVN. 1 October 1969 to 15 October 1969. One tropical hut manned by (3) Dental Officers and (4) Dental Technicians.

f. 12th Marines - Dong Ha Combat Base, RVN. 1 October 1969 to 13 October 1969. One tropical hut manned by (1) Dental Officer and (1) Dental Technician.

g. Detachment #1 Camp Schwab, Okinawa. 1 October 1969 to 5 November 1969. One Dental Clinic manned by (4) Dental Officers, (3) Dental Technicians, (4) Prosthetic Dental Technicians.

3. LOCATION: 5 November 1969 to 31 December 1969 - Camp Smedley D. Butler, Okinawa.

a. 3D Dental Company Headquarters, Camp Courtney, Bldg. 4316, Okinawa. 6 November 1969 to 31 December 1969. The 3D Dental Company Headquarters/Division Staff Dental Officer, including Mount-Out, Motor Transport, Repair and Supply Sections are located in one large typhoon-proof concrete building.

Company Headquarters - Commanding Officer, Administrative Officer, Senior Chief, Administrative Chief, Training Chief,  
(3) Petty Officers and (1) USMC Driver.

Supply Section - Supply Chief, (3) Dental Technicians, (1) USMC Warehouseman

Motor Transport - Supervisory Petty Officer, (1) USMC Driver, (1) Dental Technician.

Mount-Out Section - (1) Dental Technician.

Repair Section - (1) Dental Technician.

b. Camp Courtney Dental Clinic, Bldg. 4319. 6 November 1969 to 31 December 1969. One typhoon-proof concrete building located in the dispensary. It is a 3 DOR clinic with a one man Prosthetic Laboratory, manned by (3) Dental Officers, (4) General Dental Technicians and (1) Prosthetic Technician.

c. Camp Hansen Dental Clinic, Bldg. 2404, Okinawa. 6 November 1969 to 31 December 1969. One typhoon-proof building of modern design with (9) DORs and a prosthetic laboratory manned by (10) Dental Officers, (9) Dental Technicians, (3) Prosthetic Dental Technicians, and (3) Okinawan Civilian Dental Assistants.

d. Camp Schwab Dental Clinic, Bldg. 3426, Okinawa. 6 November 1969 to 31 December 1969. A modern 5 DOR clinic manned by (5) Dental Officers, (10) Dental Technicians, and (3) Prosthetic Technicians. This clinic was secured on 10 December 1969 for 6 weeks of remodeling and replacing of dental equipment. The Dental Officers and Technicians from this clinic are double shifting at Camp Hansen.

e. Camp Foster Dental Clinic, Bldg. 1162, Okinawa. 6 November 1969 to 31 December 1969. A two story concrete building with dental and medical combined. 6 BDRs and a prosthetic laboratory, manned by (3) Dental Officers and (4) Dental Technicians. Camp Smedley D. Butler personnel also man this clinic.

f. MCAP Ryukyu Dental Clinic, Bldg. 106, Okinawa. 15 November 1969 to 31 December 1969. Two (2) Dental Officers and (2) Dental Technicians TAD to MCAP for JAF JAW support.

g. Kue Army Hospital Dental Clinic, Okinawa. 22 October 1969 to 31 December 1969. One (1) Oral Surgeon and (1) Dental Technician TAD to Kue Hospital to treat Marine oral surgery patients.

Training:

Formal In-Service Training has been cancelled within the Company the last months in RVN. On the job training is continuing to receive command attention. During November 1969, the Training Chief started preparing a Training SOP and will have it in effect after 1 January 1970.

PART II1. GENERAL OVERVIEW OF ALL ACTIVITIES.

The 3D Dental Company provided dental support throughout the TAOR (RVN) of the 3D Marine Division to personnel of the Division. In addition, it provided dental prosthetic treatment and dental repair preventive maintenance services to Navy and Marine Corps personnel of NSA, MCB and 1st MAW units in the TAOR. Assistance to Graves Registration is provided in identification of the dead. Support to the 9th RLT in Okinawa was tasked to Detachment #1, 3D Dental Company. Since 6 November 1969, the 3D Dental Company was located in Okinawa and continued its support of the 3D Marine Division. Dental Support is now provided to BLT's afloat 1/9 and 2/9, 3D FSR, MCAF FUTEMA and 1st MAW, MAG 36 at Futema. Dental Care for authorized dependents is also provided as directed by higher authority.

2. Command Relations.

The Commanding Officer, 3D Dental Company, is assigned additional duty as Division Dental Officer on the Special Staff, Commanding General, 3D Marine Division. Commanding Officer, 3D Dental Company was ordered ADDU to Staff I MEF by FMFPAC on 26 November 1969. Direct liaison was effected with Army (1st of the 5th Mechanized) and Navy (Task Force Clearwater) units operating in the TAOR until 5 November 1969. Liaison concerning dental matters in connection with civic action and pacification operations is effected with Government of Vietnam and CONDS personnel through the G-5 section, 3D Marine Division. As of 6 November 1969, liaison was effected with Camp Smedley D. Butler Dental Officer for dental matters.

3. Missions Assigned.

3D Dental Company is responsible to the Commanding General for the dental health of all Marine and Navy personnel assigned to the Division. In addition, it is responsible for maintenance of Company personnel records, submission of all required reports to higher authority, requisitioning of all medical and dental supplies required by the company for operations, maintenance and resupply of all mount-out blocks on the Company's Table of Allowance, 1st and 2nd echelon maintenance of motor transport organic to Navy and Army cordon-and-search pacification operations and Combined Action Group Operations.

4. Logistics.

Medical and Dental supply item requisitioning is effected by the Company's Supply Section through the Headquarters Battalion supply section. Since 5 November 1969, Dental Supplies for the daily operation of all Dental Clinics are requisitioned from Camp Smedley D. Butler, Okinawa.

5. Equipment.

All technical medical and dental equipment used by the Company is ordered, serviced and maintained by the Repair Section.

6. Other.a. Redeployment.

During the months of October and November 1969, the 3D Dental Company was active in the preparation for embarkation. There were no significant problems encountered in Embarkation. 3D Dental was able to comply with all requirements in reports and preparing supplies and equipment for embarkation.

b. Loss of T/E Vehicle M-151A #329064

On 6 October one jeep was stolen from the PX at Quang Tri Combat Base, Republic of Vietnam. An investigation was held in accordance with the JAG Manual and MCO P4400.19 and the Supply Officer was directed to drop the subject vehicle from the accountability records of 3D Dental Company.

c. Excess Dental Equipment

Items of excess dental equipment (dental chairs, cabinets, and units) were turned over to the 1st and 11th Dental Companies for continued use in RVN.

c. 14 October 1969 - Dental Clinic at Battalion Rear, 7th Motors, Quang Tri Combat Base, Republic of Vietnam, closed this date.

d. 15 October 1969 - Dental Clinic at Sub-Unit #2, Dong Ha, Republic of Vietnam, closed this date.

e. 17 October 1969 - Prosthetic Clinic at CP Area Quang Tri, Republic of Vietnam, closed this date.

f. 21 October 1969 - Advance Dental party embarked aboard USS CLEVELAND LFD 7 at Cua Viet, Republic of Vietnam, for Okinawa. 9 Officers, 11 enlisted.

g. 1 November 1969 - Company CP Area secured, all excess ammunition collected and turned in to Armory.

h. 2 November 1969 - All company equipment and supplies palletized and mobile loaded. Vehicles departed for POE at Cua Viet, Republic of Vietnam.

i. 4 November 1969 - All company areas cleaned and prepared for re-deployment.

j. 5 November 1969 - Company CP departed RVN by air. Commanding Officer re-deployment to Okinawa, with the main body of Company.

k. 8 November 1969 - (4) Dental Officers depart RVN. Embarked aboard USS DUBUQUE LPD 8 at Cua Viet, Republic of Vietnam, for Okinawa.

2. Significant events after re-deployment to Okinawa.

a. 6 November 1969 - Company CP established at Bldg. 4318, Camp Courtney, Okinawa.

b. 7 November 1969 - Dental personnel with 9th MAB/15th Dental Detach. passed to 3D Dental Company.

c. 12 November 1969 - 3D Dental Company equipment received from USS CLEVELAND LPD 8.

d. 2 December 1969 - Detachment 3D Dental Company, Command passed from 9th Marines to 3D Dental Company.

e. 2 December 1969 - One (1) Dental Officer and (1) Dental Technician embarked with BLT 2/9 afloat.

## 15 Division Dental

The 3D Dental Company provided dental support throughout the TAOB of the 3D Marine Division personnel of the Division. In addition it provided dental, prosthetic treatment and dental repair preventive maintenance services to Navy and Marine personnel of NSA, 1st MAF and MCB Units in the IAOB. Assistance in Graves Registration was provided in identification of the dead. Dentcap Support to the RVN/3D Marine Division pacification program was secured in October 1st redeployment. Dentcaps with CAGC units of Combined Action Group Four during the month were secured. The Division Dental Officer attended a 11th MAF Force Dental Officers Conference at DaNang on 12 October 1969 and made staff visits to all dental units of the company and Dentshops #1, 3D Dental Company, 9th MAF, Okinawa. On 13 October 1969, the dental clinic at 12th Marines at Dong Ha was closed, 14 October 1969 dental clinic at Bu Rears, 7th Marine closed; 15 October 1969, Dental Clinic at Sub Unit #2 Dong Ha closed; 17 October 1969 Prosthetic Clinic at CH, Quang Tri secured. 21 October 1969 the Advanced Dental Party departed by ship from Cua Viet to Okinawa. On 2 November 1969, the dental equipment was embarked; 5 November 1969, the Commanding Officer, 3D Dental/Division departed RVN.

In Okinawa the 3D Dental Company provides dental support to personnel of the division at Camp Schwab, Camp Hansen and Camp Courtney. In addition to 3D Marine Division personnel the 3D Dental Company also supports the 3D FSB and authorized dependents at Camp Foster. (2) Two Dental Officers and (2) Dental Technicians were assigned to MCAF Futema to support elements of the 1st MAF. One (1) Dental Officer (Oral Surgeon) and (1) Dental Technician assigned to KME Army Hospital to support marine personnel. Two Dental Officers and 2 Dental Technicians are assigned with afloat ELTs 1/9 and 2/9. Supply support for daily operation of Dental Clinics is received through the Camp Smadley D. Butler Medical/Dental Supply system.

On 7 November 1969, 3D Dental received orders on all personnel assigned to 9th MAF Dental. This caused a considerable change in the On Board strength. On 28 November the final draft of dental personnel from the 3D Dental Company arrived from the Republic of Vietnam, completing the re-deployment of this unit from RVN. During the three month period of October, November, and December, 45 personnel joined, 27 dropped making the final On Board Count of 82 as of 31 December 1969.

Historically it should be noted that the 3D Dental Company was the first Force Dental Company to ever deploy with combat Marines and the first to redeploy from combat.

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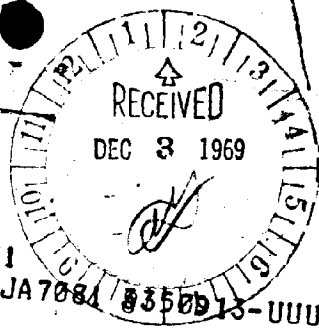
