BASE AREA 610

Locations: Laos, XD 711005, XD 717033, XD 743049, XD 760040,
XD 785033, XC 828983, XC 790950, XC 737953.

Terrains: The eastern portion of the area consists of a rugged, steep, heavily dissected mountain range with peak elevations from 750 meters to 1083 meters. The mountains are covered with multi-canopied forest and dense undergrowth with isolated pockets of brushwood. The western portion of the area, a broad, flat valley bisected by the Se La Mang River, is sparsely cultivated and has a number of small settlements along the river. It consists mostly of brushwood with a few small areas of dense forest.

Enemy Activity: During the period of January through April 1967, reports of activity in the area remained of a high level. A total of 25 installations were reported in the area. Of these, 21 were general installations, one base camp and three POL storage areas made up the remainder. Also reported in the area were -- 13 truck parks, 35 bunkers, one trench system, 12 AW positions, 21 foxholes, and four regiment-size unit sightings. There were also 13 reports of ground fire.

Summary: Analysis indicates that this is probably a supply redistribution point and transshipment area. Route 92 and Route 922 junction in this area and supplies are reportedly sent south on Route 92 and east on Route 922 from here.

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BASE AREA 611

Location: Laos, YD 241032, YD 160050, YD 197049, YD 221028,
YD 220002, XD 200988, XD 195970, XD 152962.

Terrain: The area is characterized by low mountains which are rugged, steep and heavily dissected. The peaks range in elevation from 945 meters to 1062 meters with an average slope of 45%. The upper slopes are covered with multi-canopied, dense undergrowth forest while the lower slopes are covered with brushwood.

Enemy Activity: Reports of activity grew in intensity from January thru April 1967. During this time frame, there were reports of seven installations, four general, two base camps, and one food storage. Also reported were one bunker, nine AW positions, 24 foxholes and four concentrations of troops. Eight reports of ground fire were also received.

Summary: Analysis of the area indicates that it is a rear staging area used to support operations in the I CTZ, particularly in the A Chau Valley.

8. What appeared to be the operational area supported by the base?

9. By what means was the base area being sustained? (What were the means of transportation, origin of supplies?)

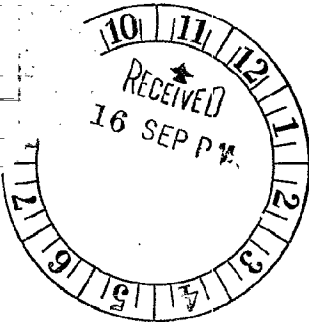

R E S O L U T I O N

(To carry out the above resolutions as stated)

These resolutions must be performed from now until the end of September 1967.

ENEMY:

In the future the enemy will continue using their former plans and tactics. In our area they are using these tactics more and more cruelly. They are going to increase their troops operations, and artillery shelling of our liberated areas. They will combine military operations and psychological war, directed against our revolutionary spirit, to make the people take part in the foolish Presidential and Senatorial elections and to protect their bases and lines of communications, but the enemy can't overcome their main mistake of passive defense.

FRIENDLY:

We must perform the major part of the "Six month and a half success has come slowly, however we are going to complete the plan in the future. Therefore we must overcome all obstacles, to win all missions in the resolution. At the same time we must obey all orders from higher commands. From now until the end of September the current affairs committee Al-11 or Al-U (unable to tell) has decided to launch an attack in three phases: Armed, Political and Military Proselyting. Use guerrilla warfare to size the targets, occupy the countryside and building the countryside as a solid revolutionary base. Bring the guerrilla war are into the cities, districts and enemy bases to motivate the people in a revolutionary spirit. Force the enemy to defend their areas, create conditions to open the liberation areas, help the people to return to their native lands. Harass, before, during and after the enemy's election. Regardless of difficulty, we must carry out the resolution.

Motivate the people; show the people the cruel enemy scheme (especially the scheme of gathering the people). Because of their failures, the enemy is attacking (directing their efforts) towards the people. That is their downfall.

With our great powerful hatred of the enemy, indignation and the power of our cause, we will surely win. Initiate an ideological campaign on a broad front, unite together, work together, don't follow the enemy. The enemy must follow us. If we want to achieve this we must have cadres who can endure the hardships, hold the people, and motivate the populace. They must remember the basic hamlet forces. These forces must improve morals by determined fighting with the enemy, recognize individual success and award them. Carefully carry out regulations regarding wounded.

In the political struggle establish effective leadership committees.

Increase production, struggle, protect the production, counterencircle, conserve and stock the food.

We have lost part of our crop this year and this has affected the people. We must stock the food for the people and for the revolution. Carry out the above resolution. We must motivate a successful harvest of food in all hamlets, like potatoes and vegetables. (The reason for this motivation is to prevent hunger).

Prepare fertilizer and equipment for the next crop. Every cadre must participate in this mission.

Troop mess. Send the men to the hamlets. Stock the food (provisions) in the base same as before. Separate the rice from the people. Hide the rice carefully.

Motivate the people to go to the front lines.

In general, determine to reorganize all branches of all organizations. Determine to reorganize all branches in hamlets. Determine to reorganize the security machine in the hamlets.

All hamlets who received this resolution must study and organize to train guerrilla cadre. They must understand the morale of revolution.

Note: Each man must, through the hardships, achieve a small victory.

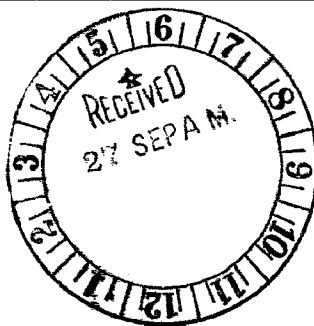
