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

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PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. OPERATIONS/TRAINING

a. During the period of this report the 3d Combined Action Group continued to participate in action against the Communist Aggressors in Thua Thien Province, Republic of Vietnam. In accordance with III Marine Amphibious Force Order 3121.4B a total of 6,800 man hours of formal training were conducted for USMC elements of the CAPs and 6,315 man hours of formal training were conducted for the Popular Force Soldiers. During the month of December the Group accounted for 15 VC/NVA KIA, 2 POW, 162 Detainees, 11 Infrastructure, 5 Hoi Chanh, and 20 weapons captured while suffering only 10 USMC WIA(N/E), and 3 USMC WIA(E).

2. LOGISTICS SECTION

a. Prepared and submitted Phase I of the budget for the current year (FY 1969) and the budget year (FY 1970). Due to the growth of 3d CAG and the many changes in operations, there were some significant changes to the budgetary requirements.

b. During the month of December, all serialized and other custodial property was inspected and inventoried. An ordnance maintenance team plus the Group armorer conducted an inspection and LTI of all weapons held by 3d CAG.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. On 010050H Dec68 at coord YD791243 CAP 3-1-6 received approximately 10 rounds small arms. Returned fire, swept area at first light.

RESULTS: 2 USMC WIA (N/E)

2. On 011835H Dec68 at coord YD832237 CAP 3-1-8 spotted an enemy column and set up a hasty ambush. Small arms were exchanged. Moved to make contact with second group of enemy again exchanging small arms. Swept area.

RESULTS: 1 NVA KIA, 1 PF KIA

3. On 022000H Dec68 at coord YD835235 CAP 3-1-8 spotted 5 VC. Moved into position and ambushed them. A mutually supporting ambush from the CAP joined with first ambush when 12 NVA were spotted. Combined ambushes moved to attack the 12 NVA when heavy small arms was received from a pagoda. Began fire and maneuver until small arms and M-79 rounds forced the Marines and PF to form a hasty defense. Approximately 40 NVA started to assault the CAP until USA gunships arrived. Due to supplies running low the CAP was extracted at 020200H Dec68. Swept area at first light.

RESULTS: 4 VC KIA, 1 USMC WIA (E).

4. On 022100H Dec68 at coord YD755288 CAP 3-3-7 picked up 2 persons without ID cards and 1 person who said he was going home.

RESULTS: 3 Detainees, later released.

5. On 042145H Dec68 at coord YD981075 CAP 3-5-4 ambushed approximately 4 VC. Swept area.

RESULTS: 1 VC KIA, 1 M-16, 5 M-16 mags, 1 NVA mag pouch, 1 NVA belt.

6. On 042200H Dec68 at coord YD793323 CAP 3-3-8 spotted 6 boats and fired warning shots as one started to pull away. The boats came to shore. Picked up 14 persons who were taken to Phu Vanh District Hq.

RESULTS: 14 Detainees later released.

7. On 052230H Dec68 at coord YD816185 CAP 3-1-5 fired upon 2 VC loading lumber. One fell; the other fled to a pagoda and returned fire. CAP swept area.

RESULTS: 1 USMC WIA (N/E), 1 Sub-machine gun

8. On 052310H Dec68 at coord YD784265 CAP 3-3-1 was ambushed by approximately 6 VC. Returned fire and swept area.

RESULTS: 1 PF KIA.

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9. On 060100H Dec68 at coord YD775324 CAP 3-3-8 spotted numerous sampans on river. Challenged with illumination, PF voices and warning shots. Picked up 10 detainees. The rest fled.

RESULTS: 10 Detainees, 9 later released, 1 held at Quang Dien District Hq.

10. On 060750 Dec68 at coord YD900113 CAP 3-1-3 based on intelligence received from RD's went to house of a VCS, set up around the house, and picked him up when he returned home. He was taken to Huong Thuy District Hq.

RESULTS: 1 Detainee, still detained 31Dec68.

11. On 071400 Dec68 at coord YD754336 CAP 3-3-8 found 4 bunkers in a pagoda and house foundations.

RESULTS: 4 bunkers destroyed. VC propaganda in English and Vietnamese discovered and taken to Quang Dien District Hq. The propaganda was for period prior to TET 1968.

12. On 082200H Dec68 at coord YD782264 CAP 3-3-1 apprehended 5 VN females stealing JP-4 from pipeline.

RESULTS: 5 detainees turned over to Phu Vang District Chief, later released.

13. On 082100H Dec68 at coord YD754288 CAP 3-3-7 stopped one boat and picked up 11 persons, taken to Phu Vang District Chief.

RESULTS: 11 detainees, 10 released, and 1 turned over to National Security Police for trial.

14. On 082140H Dec68 at coord YD827236 CAP 3-1-8 spotted 2 VC moving down a trail. Fired upon them. Swept area.

RESULTS: 1 VC KIA, 1 M-2 Carbine, 2 satchel charges, 1 M-2 Carbine Magazine, miscellaneous equipment.

15. On 090030H Dec68 at coord YD791244 CAP 3-1-6 heard movement in front of ambush site. Fired S/A and M-79. Swept area.

RESULTS: 1 VC KIA

16. On 091805H Dec68 at coord YD806246 1 VC rallied to CAP 3-1-8.

RESULTS: 1 Hoi Chanh, 1 M-16

17. On 091730H Dec68 at coord YD806246 CAP 3-1-6 was led by Hoi Chanh from 3-1-8 to a cache.

RESULTS: 1 Machine gun 7.62, 2 lbs rice, 80 M-79 rounds 9 B-40 rounds, 9 satchel charges, 1 US claymore, 2 cases of AK-47 ammo, 1 water proof bag, 1 box of medical gear, 1 US cartridge belt, 1 pith helmet.

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18. On 091300H Dec68 at coord YD756326 CAP 3-3-8 found and destroyed 7 old VC bunkers.

RESULTS: 7 bunkers destroyed, 100 lbs rice destroyed

19. On 100930H Dec68 at coord YD754272 CAP 3-3-7 picked up 2 VN persons with improper ID cards and enemy equipment in a second area.

RESULTS: 2 detainees, later released, 1 with M-1 carbine, 1 cartridge belt.

20. On 102140H Dec68 at coord ZD169009 CAP 3-2-3 ambushed approximately 15-20 VC with claymores, S/A and M-79, called for fire mission swept area.

RESULTS: 2 VC KIA, 3 USMC WIA (N/E), 1 M-2 Carbine, 1 SKS

21. On 131030H Dec68 at coord YD807245 CAP 3-1-6 found and destroyed 1 bunker

RESULTS: 1 bunker destroyed, 1 B-40 RKT round

22. On 140600H Dec68 at coord YD693241 CAP 3-4-2 1 VC rallied with rifle

RESULTS: 1 Hoi Chanh, 1 M-16

23. On 140830H Dec68 at coord ZD192018 CAP 3-2-3 1 VC rallied with weapon.

RESULTS: 1 Hoi Chanh, 1 SKS

24. On 141100H Dec68 at coord YD799234 CAP 3-1-6 picked up 2 detainees one of which led the patrol to a weapon. Detainees taken to Huong Thuy District Hq. and confirmed VCI.

RESULTS: 2 VCI, 1 M-1 rifle, 1 M-16 mag, 8 rds 30 cal, 60 rds AK-47.

25. On 142030H Dec68 at coord YD818190 CAP 3-1-5 spotted 2 boats with VC in them. Opened fire killing one, the rest fled.

RESULTS: 1 VC KIA, 5 detainees later released.

26. On 141300H Dec68 at coord YD884288 CAP 3-3-4 found 1 5" rocket which had been rendered ineffective as a booby trap by elements.

RESULTS: 1 5" rocket, 60 lbs TNT.

27. On 151000H Dec68 at coord ZD188020 1 VC of Local Force Company "C" rallied with a weapon to CAP 3-2-3.

RESULTS: 1 Hoi Chanh, 1 CKC.

28. on 181925H Dec 68 at coord ZC145985 CAP 3-2-5 PF's accidentally set off a claymore mine wounding 2 Marines who were setting up trip flares in front of it.

RESULTS: 2 USMC WIA (E)

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29. On 182138H Dec68 at coord ZD086015 CAP 3-2-1 acting upon information from PF's, surrounded sampans, swept area.

RESULTS: 1 detainee, later released.

30. On 190615H Dec68 at coord ZD139022 CAP 3-2-2 acting upon information from PF's picked up 3 VN persons who were said to be passing information to the VC.

RESULTS: 3 detainees one female, later released, 50 lbs of rice, cans of fish and noodles, 1 pack of cigarettes.

31. On 191750H Dec68 at coord YD693243 CAP 3-4-2 found 1 B-40 RKT rd.

RESULTS: 1 B-40 RKT rd. blown in place.

32. On 200735H Dec68 at coord YD958067 CAP 3-5-3 swept area of previous contact while on a joint operations w/USA picked up 4 VN persons who the Village Chief states are the parents, wife and friend of one of the VC KIA due to the operation.

RESULTS: 4 detainees as of 31 Dec68 2 still being held at Phu Loc District Hq. 2 released.

33. On 202245H Dec68 at coord YD223788 CAP 3-3-2 spotted 1 VC in a tree line who threw a grenade. 3-3-2 returned fire with S/A. Swept area.

RESULTS: 2 USMC WIA (N/E)

34. On 211245H Dec68 at coord ZD150994 CAP 3-2-5 spotted a VC leading 10 others who were approximately 100 meters behind. The VC point spotted the CAP patrol and ran. The patrol opened fire, called gunships. Swept area.

RESULTS: 2 VC KIA, 1 POW, 2 AK-47, miscellaneous equipment 1 personal letter with no significant information.

35. On 222240H Dec68 at coord ZD155011 CAP 3-2-2 ambushed approximately 10 VC who fled when opened fire on them, swept area.

RESULTS: 1 VC KIA, 1 pack, 10 lbs rice, 5 lbs wheat, 2200\$VN, personal letter.

36. On 221530H Dec68 at coord YD793247 CAP 3-3-5 found a bunker in a house, searched bunker and house.

RESULTS: 1 detainee, 1 mine MDH-7

37. On 242230H Dec68 at coord YD842169 CAP 3-1-4 1 PF accidentally detonated a claymore mine, killing himself.

RESULTS: 1 PF KIA.

38. On 242010H Dec68 at Coord YD724217 CAP 3-4-1 based on intelligence report ^{on} a Patrol picked up 1 VCS who was turned over to Huong Tra District Hq.

RESULTS: 1 detainee, later released to ARVN's as a deserter.

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39. On 251030H Dec68 at coord YD835232 CAP 3-1-8 found, searched and destroyed 1 spider trap with PRO-25 serial# 6202^S belonging to 3rd CAG. It had been captured on 16Sept68 while in the possessions of 4 persons from CAP 3-3-5 who were also captured and later killed.

RESULTS: 1 spider trap destroyed, 1 PRO-25 with accessories

40. On 250500H Dec68 at coord ZD144006 1 VC from Vin Loc (D) rallied with a weapon to CAP 3-2-2.

RESULTS: 1 Hoi Chanh, 1 SKS, 1 cartridge belt.

41. On 251430H Dec68 at coord YD836234 CAP 3-1-8 found searched and destroyed 1 spider trap.

RESULTS: 3 rds 3.5 RKT (M28A2)

42. On 252230 Dec68 at coord YD852309 CAP 3-3-4 picked up 1 VCS whose name was on the Black List. He was taken to Phu Vang District Hq. and confirmed a VC.

RESULTS: 1 VC POW.

43. On 261200H Dec68 at coord YD850310 - YD862304 CAP 3-3-4 led by a VC who was captured on 252230H Dec68 picked up 5 VCS detainees who were taken to Phu Vang District Hq. These 5 then led the CAP to 5 more persons who were picked up even though their names were not on the Black List. These 5 VCS then led 3-3-4 to 11 More VCS.

RESULTS: 21 detainees, 7 VCI, 14 later released.

44. On 262300H Dec68 at coord YD680289 CAP 3-4-4 spotted 1 VC moving into a village. 3-4-4 engaged the VC with S/A wounding him.

RESULTS: 1 AK-47

45. On 271715H Dec68 at coord YD779257, 1Km N of Hue, CAP 3-3-1 was informed of 1 VN person with an M-26 grenade on his person, patrol picked up this individual.

RESULTS: 1 detainee turned over to National Police, 1 M-26 grenade.

46. On 271745H Dec68 at coord YD806256, 3Km NE of Hue CAP 3-3-5 spotted 1 VN person in a cemetery acting suspicious. Elements were sent to investigate. When the VN started to run one warning shot was fired. VC threw 1 grenade. VC then was taken under fire and killed.

RESULTS: 1 VC KIA, 1 M-26 grenade.

47. On 272030H Dec68 at coord YD840179, 2Km NW of Phu Bai CAP 3-1-4 spotted 1 female they believe to be a VC. She was taken to Huong Thuy District Hq.

RESULTS: 1 detainee, later released.

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48. On 291600H Dec68 at coord YD825240, 5Km NE of Hue, USA personnel turned 2 VN children over to CAP 3-3-8, who ^{was} believed to be standing watch for the VC. Children were taken to Phu Vang District Hq.

RESULTS: 2 Detainees later released

49. On 281920H Dec68 at coord ZD143018, 7Km E of Phu Loc District Hq. CAP 3-2-2 ambushed approximately 8 VC. S/A were exchanged swept area.

RESULTS: 2 USMC WIA (N/E), 1 SKS, 1 hand grenade.

50. On 290015H Dec68 at coord YD762334, 7Km N of Hue CAP 3-3-9 picked up 38 VN. Curfew violation.

RESULTS: 38 detainees, later released.

51. On 290915H Dec68 at coord ZD185019, 8Km E of Phu Loc District Hq. CAP 3-2-3 was informed by civilians of the whereabouts of a VC. Patrol was sent to this location and encountered 2 VC who refused to Chieu Coi. USMC fired one M-79 rd wounding 1 VC.

RESULTS: 1 VC POW

52. On 291415H Dec68 at coord YD850195, 1 Km N of Phu Bai CAP 3-3-1 spotted and fired upon 1 person who fled, Patrol searched the area. ~~Found~~ searched and destroyed 2 spider traps. ^{AREA}

RESULTS: 1 M-2 Carbine, 1 AR-15, 2 AK-47 mags, 1 M-16 mag, 2 bangalore torpedoes, miscellaneous clothing and equipment.

53. On 292030H Dec68 at coord ZD185005, 10Km E of Phu Loc District Hq., CAP 3-2-3 apprehended from a boat 1 VN male who stated he was a VC guide.

RESULTS: 1 detainee, later classified VCI.

54. On 281800H Dec68 at coord YD716219, 2 Km SW of Hue a VN civilian turned over 1 AK-47 to CAP 3-4-1.

RESULTS: 1 AK-47

55. On 292105H Dec68 coord YD773324 7Km N of Hue CAP 3-3-9 spotted a boat, picked up all persons in the boat and searched it. Detainees taken to Quang Dien District Hq.

RESULTS: 13 detainees, 23 viles of streptomycin, 23 viles 5% glucose solution 250 lbs of rice.

56. On 301200H Dec68 at coord YD848195, 1Km N of Phu Bai CAP 3-1-1 saw smoke coming from a spider trap. Searched the spider trap.

RESULTS: 1 list of VC sentries in Huong Thuy District, 1 personnel letter,

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57. On 301200H Dec68 at coord YD689238, 5Km W of Hue, a civilian found and turned over to CAP 3-4-2rd Ordinance.

RESULTS: 8 rds. 60mm mortar, VIP payment made.

58. On 301600H Dec68 at coord YD872298 CAP 3-3-4 8Km NE of Hue received information from PF of VC living on sampans. Patrol was sent to pick up these people.

RESULTS: 32 VCS detainees held at Phu Vang District Hq.

59. On 310350H Dec68 at coord YD838280, 7Km NE of Hue, CAP 3-3-7 spotted approximately 6 boats moving on the river. Challenged and fired warning shots. One boat came to shore, the rest fled.

RESULTS: 3 detainees
