OloSooH Command Group "A" and Companies B, C and D, lst Bn, 3d Marines to OPCON Task Force Delta.

010900H Command Group "B" and Company A, 1st Bn, 3d Marines relieved of responsibility for TAOR by Provisional Battalion, 3d Marines.

011245H Command Group "B" and Company A. 1st Bn. 3d Marines departed DA NaNG to join parent organization with Task Force Delta.

Company H 2/26 conducted search and clear operations along the SONG CA DE vicinity AP QUAN NAM (AT 9082). There were no contacts or significant incidents.

Company E 2/3 provided security for assigned sector. There were no contacts or significant incidents.

CAC 11, 14 and 15 established patrols and ambushes in their assigned sector. One significant incident is noted below.

010900H CAC units transferred OPCON 1/3 to Provisional Bn, 3d Marines.

The battalion employed no scout-sniper teams.

During the period, no squad size ambushes, platoen patrol bases or listening posts were established.

Company E (rein) Chopped to OPCON 1/3 (rear):0010900H OPCON transferred to Provisional Bn, 1/3 sector.

Company F continued to maintain observation south of SONG VU GIA and west of grid line 86. Search and clear operations were conducted in the semi-cleared areas adjacent to Hill #65 (AT 878577). One significant incident noted below.

0113 %H Company F platoon PPB (AT 861572) received S/A fire from (AT 863564). Returned S/A fire with neg results.

Company G continued to provide security for AN MY (3) Resettlement Center with one plt (rein) during the hours of darkness and with one sqd (rein) west of Route 5 during the hours of daylight. Patrols and ambushes were conducted along Route 5. Search and clear operations were conducted in the semi-cleared areas north of the SONG AI NGHIA to grid line 62 and west of the SONG YEN to grid line 90. There were no contacts or significant encidents.

Company H continued to provide security for the Battalion CP and to maintain a river block/ambush on SONG AI NGHIA, north of AI NGHIA Bridge. Search and clear operations were conducted in the semi-cleared areas adjacent to the Bn CP (AT 9158). There were no contacts or significant incidents.

CAC 21 provided daylight security east of Route 5 for AN MY (3) Resettlement Center. Patrols and ambushes were conducted along MSR in assigned sector. Search and clear operations were conducted in semi-cleared village of AN MY (4) (AT 9261).

CAC 22 maintained a river block/ambush along the SONG AI NGHIA south of AI NGHIA Bridge. Patrols and ambushes were conducted in the semicleared areas in the vic of DAI LOC District Headquarters (AT 9157). There were no contacts or significant incidents.

Company E conducted search and clear operations in the semi-cleared areas slong and north of the SONG TUY LOAN to grid line 73 and west of HOA PHU (AT 9272) to grid line 88. There were no contacts or significant incidents.

Company F conducted search and clear operations in the semi-cleared areas northeast of Hill mass (AT 9165) west of the SONG YEN and south of grid line 68. One significant incident noted below.

010906H Company F reported that attached Eng Seeep Team found mined road block (AT 936634). 3 Mines and Road block destroyed by Sweep team.

Company G conducted search and clear operations in the semi-cleared areas north of grid line 68 to the SONG TUY LOAN, west of Route #5 to the vic of DONG BICH (1) (AT 8968). Significant incidents are noted below.

010730H Company G patrol found one mine (AT 913687), during search of area a second mine was set off resulting in 2 USMC WIA. Mine blown in place.

010900H Company H Chopped OPCON 1/3 (rear), OPCON now Provisional Bn. 1/3 sector.

CAC 31, 32, 33 and 34 conducted search and clear operations in the semi-cleared areas adjacent to assigned villages. There were no contacts or significant incidents.

During this period, the company established 16 night defensive perimeter positions, 1 listening post and 4 daylight observation posts. There were no contacts or significant incidents.

Company E OPCON Prov Bn.

Company F contivued to maintain observation south of SONG VU GIA and west of grid line 86. Search and clear operations were conducted in the semi-cleared village of SONG BINH (AT 8758). There were no contacts or significant incidents.

Company G continued to provide security for Bridge #3 and AN MY (3) Resettlement Center with on plt (rein) during the hours of darkness and with one sqd (rein) west of Route 5 during the hours of daylight. Patrols and ambushes were conducted along Route 5 north to AN MY (3) (AT 9260). Search and clear operations were conducted in the semi-cleared area north of SONG AI NGHIA to grid line 61 and west of the SONG YEN to grid line 90. There were no contacts or significant incidents.

Company E continued to provide security for the Bottalion CP and to maintein a river block/ambush on SONG AI NGHIA, north of AI NGHIA Bridge. 021332H AAT received S/A fire from (AT 814556) estimate VC plt, returned Arty fire of 14 rounds HE. Resulted in 5 VC KIA (conf), 3 VC \sim IA (prob), as relayed by VN civilian.

CAD 21 provided daylight security east of Route 5 for AN MY (3) Resettlement Center. Patrols and ambushes were conducted along MSR in assigned sector. There were no contacts or significant incidents.

Company E conducted search and clear operations in the semi-cleared area along and north of the SONG TUY LOAN to grid line 73 and west of THON NINH AN (AT 9171) to grid line 89. There were no contacts or significant incidents.

Company F conducted search and clear operations in the semi-cleared area northeast of Hill mass (AT 9165) west of the SONG YEN and south of grid line 68. There were no contacts. Significant incident noted below:

O2073H Company F patrol found a road block (AT 941643), with 3 mines. Mines blown in place by 7th Engineers sweep team causing secondary explosion; Road block removed.

Company G conducted search and clear operations in the semi-cleared area north of grid line 68 to the SONG TUY LOAN west of Route 5 to the vic of DONG BICH (1) (AT 9868). One Significant incident noted below:

021245H Company G patrol discovered 2 mines (AT 912688). Mines blown in place.






