3. Sequential listing of significant events:

a. Personnel

(1) Eight (8) USMC officers and four (4) enlisted were transferred to CONUS during the period. One (1) USN officer and four (4) USN enlisted were also transferred.

(2) In addition to paragraph 3.a(1) above, this battalion joined one (1) USMC officer and one (1) USN officer and four (4) USN enlisted during the reporting period.

(3) A total of six (6) enlisted personnel and one (1) USN officer were granted emergency leave during this reporting period.

b. Intelligence

2 November - A total of 30 VC with packs and weapons were reported by Recon Battalion to this unit. All VC were moving east in GS AT 8084. A P.A. team leader working near Le My reported four (4) main force companies from GS AT 8486 to GS AT 8687.

3 November - A report was received from Hoa Minh in the Hoa Vang District that a VC Main Force Company was preparing to attack the Da Nang Air Field and surrounding Marine Corps units.

4 November - A report was received of a VC battalion having the mission of attacking Marine units at Le My between 1 November and 15 November. They were said to be armed with 3 57mm rifles, 3 60mm mortars and 15 Browning automatic rifles. This report was received from the Hoa Vang District.

6 November - A patrol from "E" Company captured two (2) VCS. These were turned over to ITT. A caucasian in Marine Corps uniform and carrying an M-14 rifle was reported in GS AT 8666 by a Recon Battalion unit.

7 November - The Battalion OP was probed by approximately three (3) VC during the night. Last seen running NW from OP position. A report was received of 100 VC in suicide teams and in the Da Nang area with the mission of attacking U.S. offices in the city of Da Nang.

8 November - Twelve (12) VC approached an ambush site near Company "E". VC were fired upon.

12 November - Btry "K", 4th Bn, 12th Mar, reported to this unit that a colored male and a Vietnamese male entered the village of Mieu Bo Hoa at coordinates AT 957777.

c. Communication - Electronics

Communications during the reporting period were employed as they had been in the preceding months. Much time was spent in readiness of the relief of 2nd Battalion, 3rd Marines, by 1st Battalion, 3rd Marines, which occurred on 19 November.

Several key personnel changes took place including the Communications Officer and Communications Chief.

On 9 November an advance echelon consisting of the communications technical chief and another technician left for Okinawa taking with them deadlined equipment which had been at FLSG.

On 19 November 1st Battalion, 3rd Marines, began taking over the existing wire system and radio nets and this section's embarkation preparations and movement were completed.

d. Close Combat

During this reporting period there were no significant encounters with the enemy. The linear defensive pattern was heavily stressed with an average total of twelve (12) listening posts and eighteen (18) local ambushes nightly. Although there were indications of an increase of VC activity in the area during this period there were no significant encounters with the enemy by friendly units. Relief of lines by BLT 1/3 was accomplished on 19 November in accordance with enclosure (2).

e. Logistics

The significant logistic event during this reporting period was the preparation for and embarkation of the battalion for the move to Okinawa. This phase was conducted in accordance with administrative and embarkation orders accompanying enclosure (2).

f. Civil Affairs

7 November - Mr. SCHWAB, free lance writer for the Marine Corps Gazette visited Le My to do research for an article on civil action projects of 2nd Battalion, 3rd Marine for the Gazette. Mr. SCHWAB visited the Le My Medical Center, Le My Market, Phu Thuong Orphanage (coord AT 905764) and Hoa Vinh School (coord AT 901794).

Mr. Bob MCCULLOUGH from Newsweek Magazine visited Le My to do a story on Le My. He was accompanied by a representative from CIB. Mr. MCCULLOUGH visited the Hoa Lac school, Market place, and Le My Medical Center.

8 November-- Medical Corpsmen from "G" Company set up a temporary aid station in Hoa Vinh (coord AT 902795) to handle sick call on a daily basis.

Homes for refugees were underway in the villages of Hoa Lac (coord AT 908818) and Hoa Thanh (coord AT 907784). The majority of the work is being done by the refugees and villagers through the Self Help Program, although limited help was given by Marines of the battalion.

9 November - Mr. MARTIN, Congressman from Alabama visited the school at Hoa Vinh (coord AT 901794). He was accompanied by two administrative aides - Mr. MARLATT and Mr. MARLONE. They were briefed on the battalion's Civil Affairs Program by LtCol CLEMENT, Bn CO; Dr. KAAK, Bn Assistant Surgeon; Capt GUGGINO, Bn CAO; and Lt OSTER, Assistant Bn CAO. Mr. MARTIN saw the new school of Hoa Vinh in its final stage of construction. Mr. MARTIN was presented a Vietnamese flag and a basket with a stalk of rice, symbolizing the country's agricultural crop.

A dinner was held by Mr. NAM, Hoa Thanh Village Chief (coord AT911784). Members of the battalion present were: LtCol HORN, prospective Bn CO; Major GRAY, Bn XO; Major CASTELLANA, Bn S-3; Capt GUGGINO, Bn CAO; Lt KRULAK, "G" Co CO; Lt STUMP, "F" Co CO; GySgt WHITE, 2ndBn, 9thMar, S-2 Chief; Sgt TOMASZEK, Bn Civil Affairs NCO; and special guest, Capt SILVA, S-2, 2ndBn, 9thMar.

A three hour English class was held at Phu Thuong Orphanage (coord AT 905764) by members of "F" Company

13 November - Deputy Commander, U. S. Military Assistance Command, Vietnam, visited the Le My area. Included in the visit was Le My School, Market Place, and Medical Center. Briefings on the battalion's Civil Affairs Program were given by Capt GUGGINO, Bn CAO; and Dr. KAAK, Bn Assistant Surgeon.

16 November - Members of "E" Company and "F" Company distributed the below listed items to refugees in the village of Hoa Lac (coord AT908818) and the hamlet of Tung-Son (coord AT894782).

19 November - up until the time of this Battalion's departure to Okinawa approximately 120 persons were being treated daily at the Le My Medical Center, with assistance from the nurse trainees and midwives from the

various villages. Medical corpsmen from the battalion also treated personnel at Tung-Son hamlet.

The refugee homes in the villages of Hoa Lac (coord AT908818) and Hoa Thanh (coord AT907784) and the hamlet of Tung-Son (coord AT 894782) were still under construction at the time of this Battalion's departure.





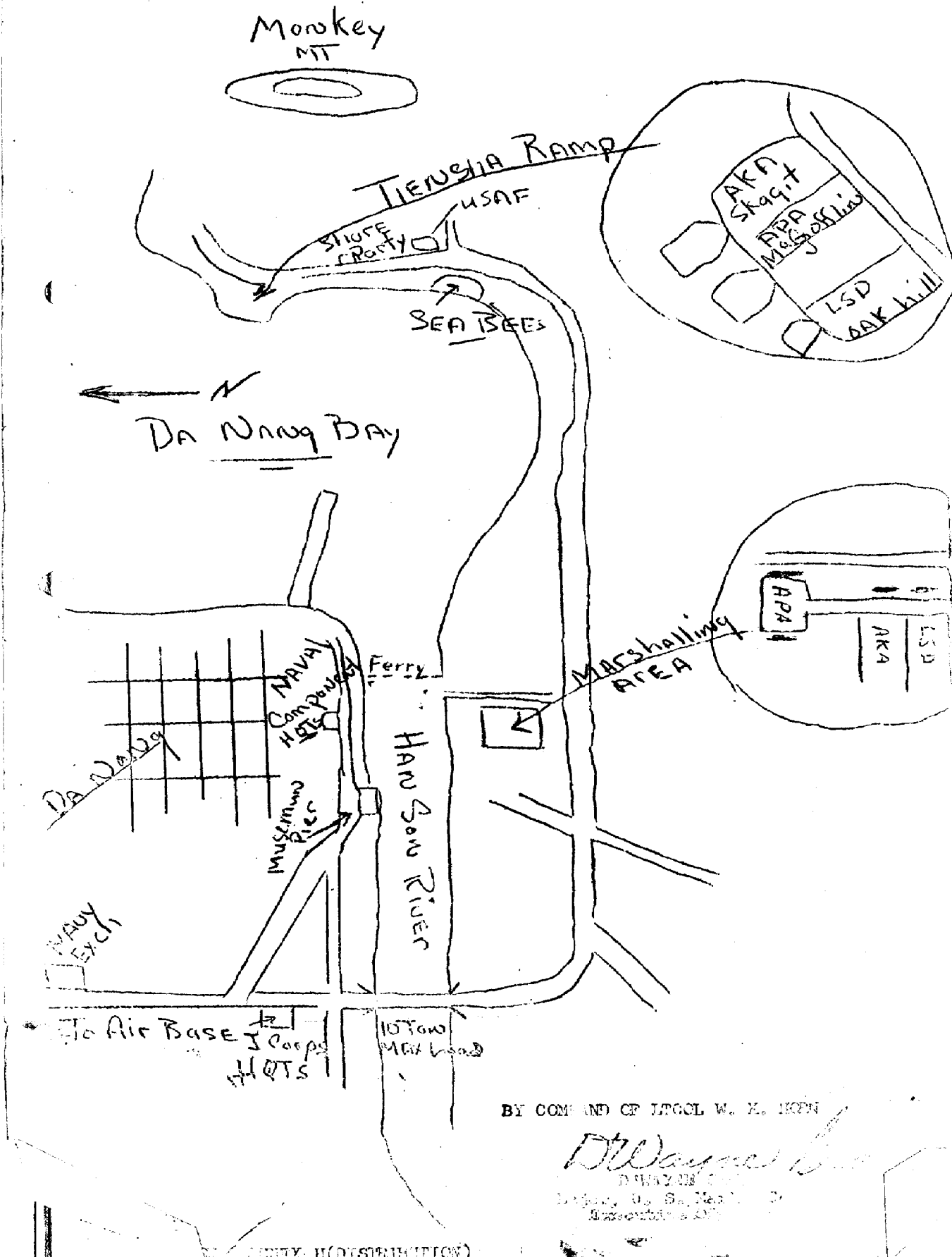

Appendix 1 (Enemy Situation) to Annex B (Intelligence) to

1. MISSION

- a. As defined by Operation Order 347-65.

2. SITUATION

- a. Weather. See Appendix 6 to Annex B to Operation Order 347-65.
- b. Terrain. Terrain within the northeastern portion of the TAOR is generally low lying rice paddies surrounding small mounds of brush and trees. Moving South the area 2000 meters in from the coast becomes hilly, particularly in the area of hills 282 (AT 934781) and 364 (AT 933761). The areas in the western and northern sections of the TAOR are primarily mountainous. Foot traffic can move throughout the entire area but vehicles are generally limited to the two roads shown on reference (a). Observation by the enemy is possible from the high ground in the western section of the TAOR.
- c. Population. The civilian population is governed by the military commander for the district. Authority is delegated to village and hamlet chiefs who are appointed officials. Agriculture and livestock are the primary means of economic income for the areas population. Transportation is generally by foot, supplemented by a few bikes and scooters and a few local buses that carry passengers and goods during daylight hours. The overall religion of the population is Roman Catholic; however there are a number of Buddhist hamlets within the TAOR. Vietnamese is the basic language; however many of the older citizens can also converse in French. In general the attitude of the population is very friendly toward Americans.
- d. Enemy Forces
- (1) Current enemy activities are contained in daily ISUMS issued by higher headquarters.
- (2) As a general rule the enemy can be expected to make use of the hours of limited surveillance before launching any attacks. The Viet-Cong possess only a limited crew served weapon fire support capability. To neutralize our advantage they can be expected to attack only on those nights without a moon and on nights of heavy rain. Generally attacks will end by 0300 to permit the enemy time to regain the protection of the

mountains before dawn. Viet-Cong attacks will usually be planned as raids. They will not attempt to hold ground taken. Their primary objectives will be to inflict casualties and seize equipment and material.

- (3) Enemy activity has increased within the TAOR since mid-October. These reports have come from both higher headquarters and from local intelligence sources. The reports are consistent with indications of a major Viet-Cong push against all Marine positions in the Da Nang TAOR. Many of the units sighted have been "Main Force" units, well armed and trained.

3. POSSIBLE ENEMY COURSES OF ACTION

- a. Continue present course of avoiding contact.

Enumeration. At present reports indicate that numerous Viet-Cong agents are at large within the TAOR. Because of the emplacement of Marine positions within the areas of heavy population density and because of constant contact between the Marines and the civilian population, it is reasonable to assume that this TAOR has been a source of intelligence for the Viet-Cong.

- b. Launch a concentrated attack on Marine positions within the TAOR.

Enumeration. It can be assumed that the Viet-Cong are aware of the impending relief of lines. Recent ISUMS indicate increased Viet-Cong strength in this area. Local intelligence sources indicate that the Viet-Cong are determined to destroy Nam-O Bridge. Recent reverses, particularly during the rice harvest increase the need for an impressive Viet-Cong victory to regain lost prestige. November is one of the last months during which heavy rain can be expected. During the period from 21-25 November there will be no moon.

- c. Adapt tactics of harassment and terroristic attacks.

Enumeration. The civilian population in this area has been friendly toward American forces. Particularly village and hamlet chiefs have made determined efforts to work with American forces. The main service roads are now travelled freely by American and ARVN forces. An attitude of mutual trust has been created. Because of the Viet-Cong's need to separate the people from government authority and because of the widely dispersed nature of the Marine forces a program of mining, assassination could be successfully implemented by the Viet-Cong.

- d. Withdraw from the Tactical Area of Responsibility.

Enumeration. Since the population in this area has been generally pro-government and Marine defensive positions are well established the Viet-Cong might decide to employ their "Main Force" units in an area where their chances of success were greater.

4. CONCLUSIONS. The Viet-Cong more than likely will launch an attack in Battalion (4) strength against Marine positions in this TAOR between 21 and 25 November. This attack will probably be launched against positions in the northern section of the TAOR. It will include an attempt to destroy Nam-O Bridge. If these attacks fail the Viet-Cong will adopt tactics of terrorism and assassination against Marines and loyal government officials within the TAOR.



1. The Viet-Cong rely very heavily on the collection of intelligence before planning any type of attack or harrassment of friendly forces. The employment of young women and small children is a widely used means of intelligence collection.
2. Within the perimeter of all friendly forces, Vietnamese personnel are to be admitted only upon approval of the Battalion Commander and with written permission from I Corps Headquarters. Vietnamese will be kept from loitering near all perimeter wire. Special attention will be paid to water buffalo boys, and other indigenous personnel on apparently innocent missions.
3. During the relief of units on line, care will be taken to keep all Vietnamese clear of areas of observation. This policy must be applied with common sense. It does not mean that Vietnamese will be removed from their normal living and working areas.
4. Any necessary discussion of military matters will be done within Marine defense locations. Viet-Cong agents are placed within all Vietnamese markets to collect intelligence.
5. All military documents will be hand held when stopped in all types of vehicles. Documents will not be taken into Vietnamese markets or shops.
6. Military matters are not to be discussed with Armed Forces of Viet-Nam personnel.
7. Within the Da Nang TAOR personnel working with Viet-Cong units have been noted to be Negroid and Caucasian as well as Oriental. At times they will wear friendly unit uniforms. Care will be taken to identify unknown personnel within the company positions.

1. Weather. The average rain fall for the month of November is 14.2 inches. During this month the average number of days with rain fall is 20. So far this year rainfall during November has been below average.

The average temperature is 75° with a maximum of 90° and a minimum of 56°.

Surface winds prevail from the North with an average speed of 9 knots and a maximum speed of up to 40 knots.

Fog does not prevail during the month of November though low cloud cover exists 52% of the time.

2. Water Supply. Within the TAOR of 2/3 drinking water is plentiful. Small patrols have no need for water resupply due to the many streams flowing throughout the area.

3. Trafficability. Two roads within the TAOR are classed as all-weather roads. Route #1 running from Da Nang towards Nam-O-Bridge (Grid Square AT 9284) is hard surface and not affected by weather. The second road extends from Route #1 (Coordinates AT 956786) to the fork at coordinates AT 909784 and then goes North and West within the TAOR. (The Northern branch becomes National Route 14.) This road may be traveled during heavy rains at very slow speeds. Even in dry seasons it is rough, pitted and severely limits speed. Though the road at Bridge locations floods up to six inches above the road surface, it remains passable.

1. Viet-Nam is divided into provinces, districts, villages and hamlets. To provide a rule of thumb to judge the role played by these subdivisions, it is easiest to compare them with the following political structures within the United States:

The province is similar to the state; the district is comparable to the county; the village can be compared to the township; and, the hamlet is similar to the American village or to a suburb around a city (Vietnamese village).

2. The TAOR for this Battalion falls completely within Quang Nam Province. Primarily the TAOR includes two districts; Hoa Vang and Hieu Duc. These districts are not completely within the TAOR; but the TAOR is composed completely of parts of these two districts.

3. There are six villages within Hoa Vang province that are within the Battalion's TAOR: Hoa Hiep, Hoa Khanh, Hoa Thanh, Hoa Vinh, Hoa Lac, and Hoa Minh. There are several villages within Hieu Duc district that are included in the TAOR but are outside the area of current tactical consideration.

(6) Det. Logistic Support Unit. Provide back-up motor transport support as directed.

5. PERSONNEL. See Annex B (Personnel)6. MISCELLANEOUS.a. Uniform and Equipment for Embarkation and Debarkation.

(1) Uniform. Utilities w/field boots.

(2) Equipment. Normal arms and equipment, helmet w/cover, green side out, field marching pack (blanket roll).

CONFIDENTIAL(3) Baggage

(a) Officers and SNCO's. One trunk locker, one suitcase, centerfolding. (Trunk locker to be placed with hold cargo and unloaded during general unloading)

(b) Sergeants. One trunk locker or seabag, and one handbag. (Trunk locker stored as above)

(c) Corporals and below. One seabag to be carried aboard ship.

(d) All trunk lockers, seabags, and suitcases will be clearly marked or tagged with man's name, rank, service number, organization and RUC.

b. Ship's Platoon. See Embarkation Plan 347-65

c. Special Instructions.

(1) All Encampment Garrison items will remain in place and will be turned over to 1/3. Only T/E allowances of encampment garrison items will accompany 2/3 to Okinawa.

(2) All Class I, III, IV and V will be turned over to 1/3. Class V handled in accordance with Prescribed load above.

(3) All items obtained as a special allowance for RVN will be turned over to 1/3. These items include the 60mm mortar and Seismic Intrusion Devices.

(4) All supplies and equipment embarked will be boxed or crated and properly tack-marked. All boxes will be palletized, all pallets will be banded.

(5) Body Armor - Sufficient No. 10 boxes will be provided to each rifle company for the securing of all body armor. It is intended that body armor will be the last commodity that will require packaging for the front line companies. After the retrograde from the relief of lines body armor will be collected, boxed/banded and placed in assigned Amtracks, who will accompany the battalion to Camp Schwab. For battalion supply and H&S Company, sufficient boxed pallets will be provided for the storage and shipping of body armor. All H&S Co. attachments to the rifle companies will store their body armor with the rifle company.

(6) Galley/Messes - The battalion and company messes will secure operations after the noon meal on 16 November. All galley equipment will be cleaned and made ready for shipment on the evening of 17 November.

(7) Water Cans - All water cans will be turned into battalion supply for packaging and shipping. During the relief of lines, personnel from 1/3 will provide sufficient water cans to enable early withdrawal of all 2/3 water cans.



(8) Gas Cans - Gas cans will be recovered in the same manner as prescribed for water cans.

(9) Inspection prior to embarkation - Unit commanders will conduct inspection of their personnel immediately following the recovery of ammunition at Museum Beach to insure that all weapons are clear, magazines are empty and no ammunition is carried aboard.

(10) The security of weapons is paramount. Pistols will be carried aboard by the individual, however, immediately after embarked, all companies and attached units will collect all pistols and secure same within the organizational pistol chests. Maximum security will be provided to insure that rifles and crew served weapons are safeguarded.
