- A. Co A, 1st AmTrac Bn. Three LVT's are deadlined to Company Maintenance.
- B. Co B, 3d AT Bn. One platoon is in direct support of each infantry battalion.
- C. Co C, 3d Tank Bn. The M-51 retriever and one gun tank were dispatched at 191300H to positions at BT 433085 to assist two tanks from the second platoon which were stuck. Recovery was completed at 191800H and all vehicles proceeded to Hill 69 where they spent the night. The retriever and tank will return from Hill 69 via the 60 ton raft at 201600H. At 191145H four tanks with Infantry aboard, moved from positions at Hill 69 with two platoons from Company E to blocking positions at BT 432105 to support a sweep by RF. Three tanks are deadlined.



