At 150245H, Company M departed Airfield in helicopters. At 150256H, Company M was landed in wrong LZ (see overlays). Company I departed battalion area for airfield and commenced heli-lift to LZ. At 0335H, the Command Group departed the battalion CP area inroute to Airfield and commenced heli-lift to LZ. At 0411H, Company L departed the battalion CP inroute to Airfield. At 0535H, Company I had completed tying in with Company M and remained in defensive position until 0738H.

At 0738H Company I commenced sweep through objective area. At 0815H, Company I found a rice cache at YD865260 containing approximately 2,000 to 3,000 pounds of rice. Headquarters, 4th Marines was notified, and rice left intact. At 0915H, Company M found a bloody poncho, 1 1/2 pair of boots (ARVN) at YD863248. At 1022H, Company M reported finding 1 M1 Rifle, 1 M1 Carbine, 1 .45 Cal. Pistol w/belt, holster and magazine pouch. At approximately 1030H, search of assigned area was completed with negative contact with enemy. It was learned from local populace that many VC were in area three days ago. However, no exact figure of VC personnel was obtained.

At 1225H, transportation arrived, and at 1340H, the battalion commenced motor march to battalion rear. At 1435H, the battalion arrived at battalion rear there-by terminating assigned operations.

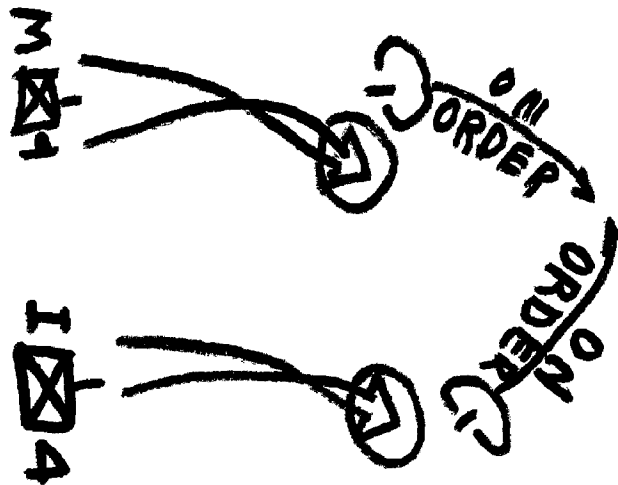

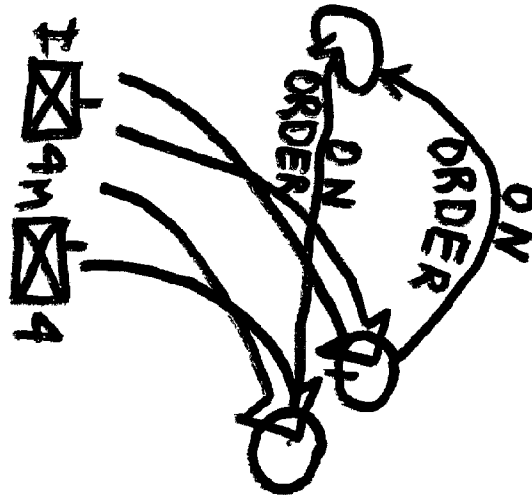
CONCEPT OF OPERATION

Patrol fired approximately 20 rounds S/A at the two (2) VC, but could not physically pursue due to the intervening body of water. It is unknown whether the VC suffered any casualties.
